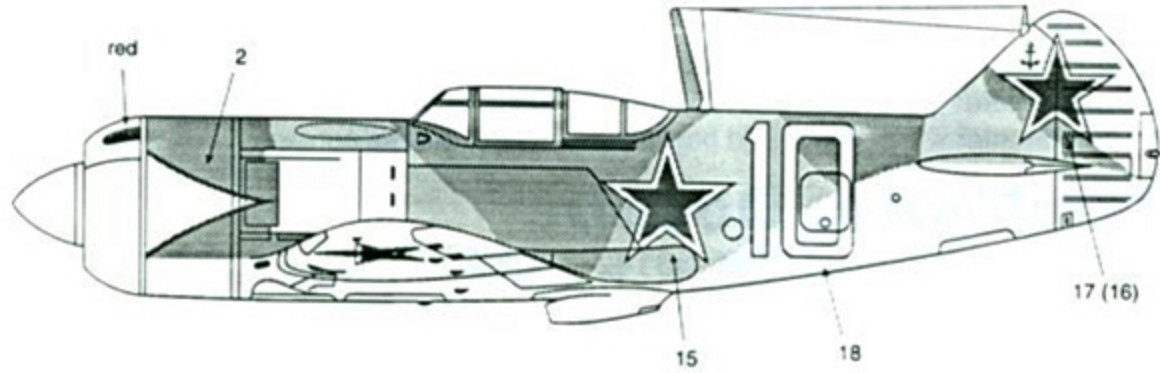
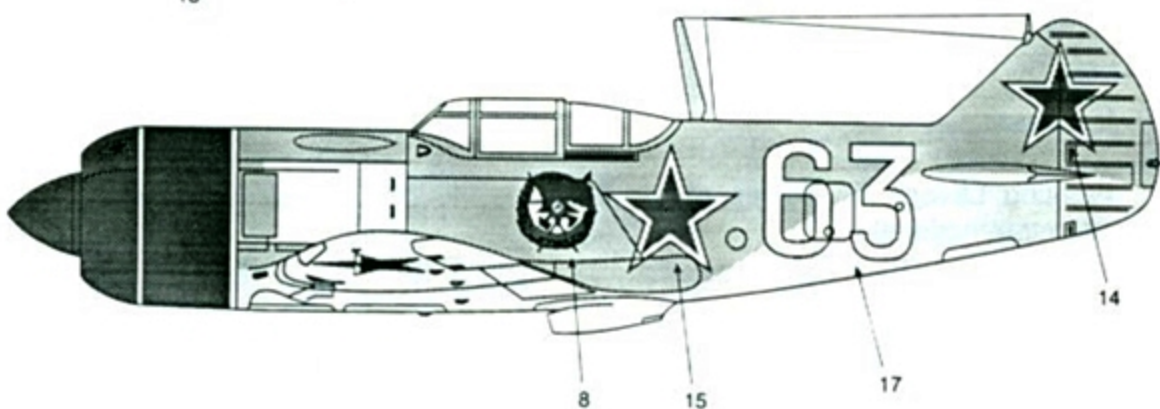
La-5 flown by Francisco Merono, a Spanish volunteer, who flew over 100 missions with the Soviet V.V.S., and was credited with 20 kills. A/C upper surfaces green (F.S. 34201), lower surfaces light blue (F.S. 15200). Natural metal panels aft of exhausts.



Note: F.S. numbers provided for camouflage colors are approximations of what are believed to be the actual shades and are intended to be used only as a general guide.

La-5FN flown by Hero of the Soviet Union Vitali I. Popkov. Upper surfaces gray (F.S. 36270) with green (F.S. 34151) and brown (F.S. 22144) blotches. Lower surfaces light blue (F.S. 15200). Natural metal panels aft of exhausts. Spinner and tip of tail white. Note: use white decal stripes provided for fuselage bands.

La-7 flown by Soviet ace Lt. Dolgushin. Upper surfaces medium gray (F.S. 36270), lower surfaces light blue (F.S. 15200). Spinner and cowl red. Cowl bands and panels aft of exhaust natural metal.



La-7 assigned to Guards Unit, Baltic Front. Dark gray (F.S. 36176) and medium gray (F.S. 36270) camouflage with light blue (F.S. 15200) under surfaces. Spinner, cowl, and rear part of tail white. Forward cowl band and panels aft of exhausts natural metal.
