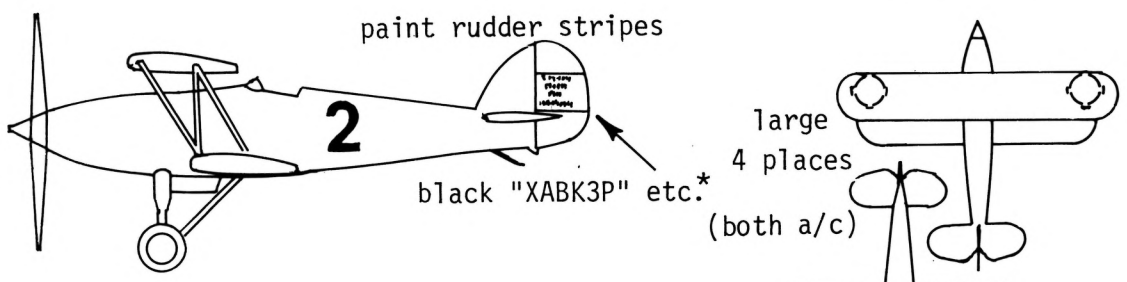
A NOTE ON THE COLORS: There seems to be a bit of confusion on the proper colors for the Royal Yugoslavian Air Force insignia. The colors of the roundel come from the national flag, which hasn't changed, except for the addition of a red star. The red and the lighter blue were matched to the modern flag. The cross comes from the "Cross of Danilo", a Montenegrin symbol. All contemporary sources show it to be outlined in blue (not black) so a blue noticeably darker than the other was selected.

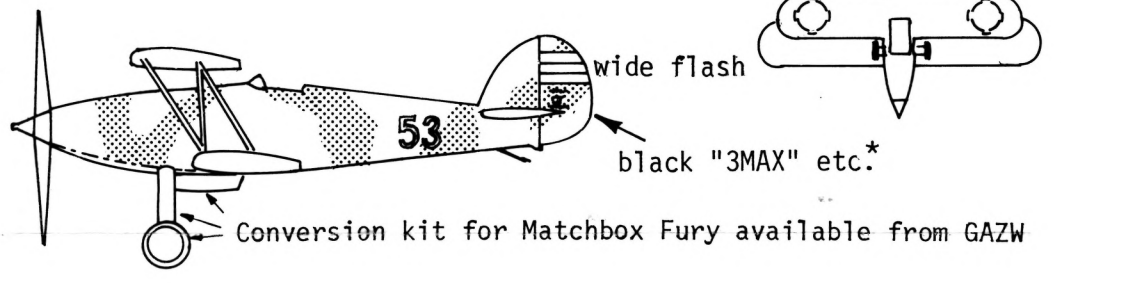

Bare metal/silver dope overall. Wood prop, bare spinner.

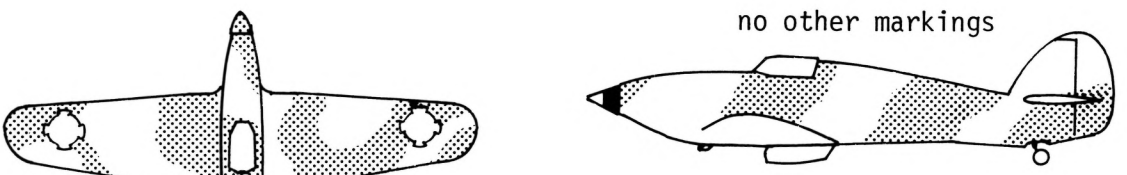


Fury "II", 35th Grupa, 5th Puk, 1941.  
Dk. green, earth brown upper and sides, lt. gray lower. Wood prop, brown spinner.

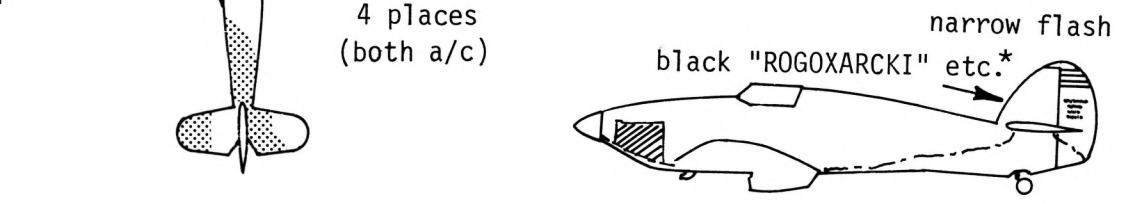

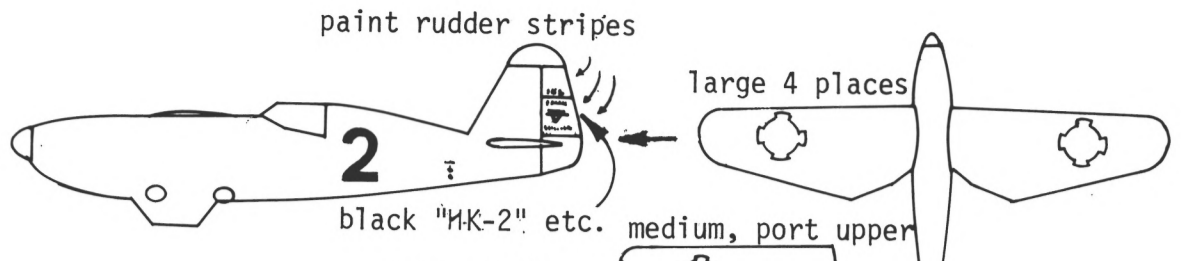
DIRECTIONS: For RYAF insignia: Apply red/white portion first, When applying blue/blue portion, there will be one alignment (out of the four possible) where the red and blue rings are concentric, and the dark blue outlines the white cross properly. (Additional insignia sheets are available at \$.60 (35p) each.)

NOTES: Where camouflage schemes are not completely shown, there is not enough information to specify them. Complete in the same "style".

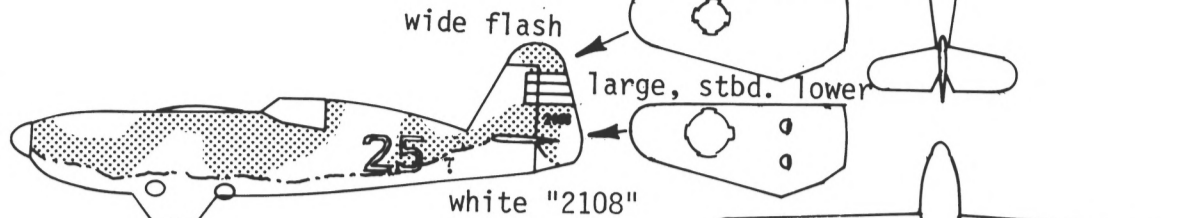
Markings shown with a "\*" are conjectured from RYAF standard methods of aircraft designation and marking.

Blue is uppermost on all rudder striping and rudder flashes. Flashes are approximately twice as long as high.

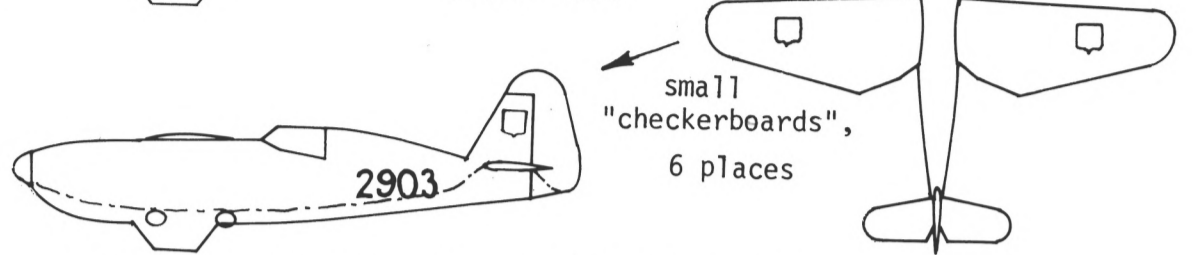
IK-2, 6th Puk, early 1939.

Dk. green, earth brown upper; lt. gray lower, inc. struts and prop.

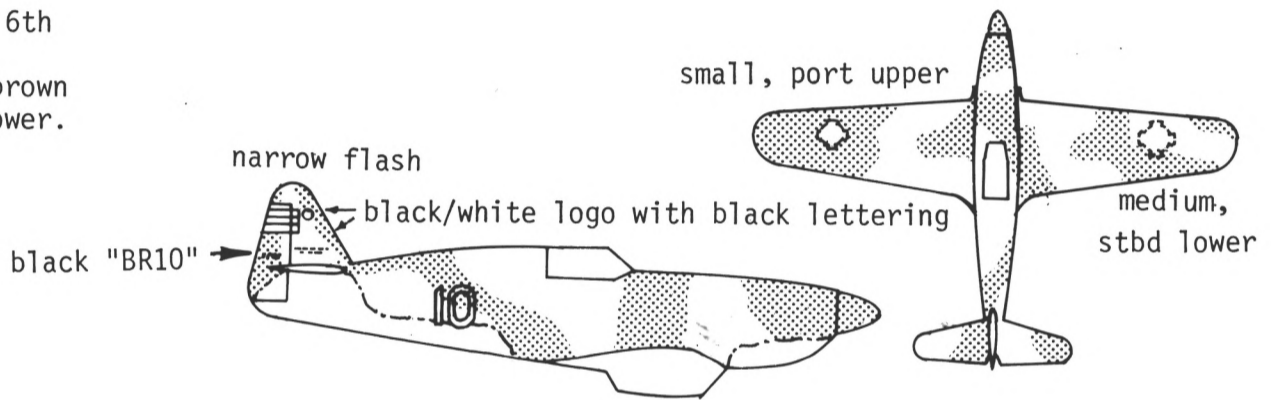


IK-2, Croatian forces, 1942.  
Olive drab upper, lt. gray lower. Spinner olive drab, blades black.

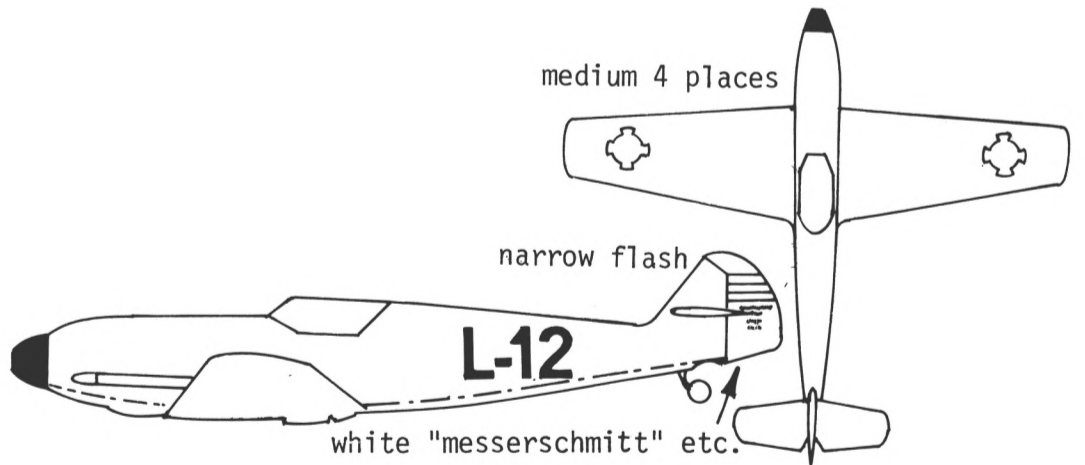

Dk. green, earth brown upper, lt. gray lower. Dark prop blades

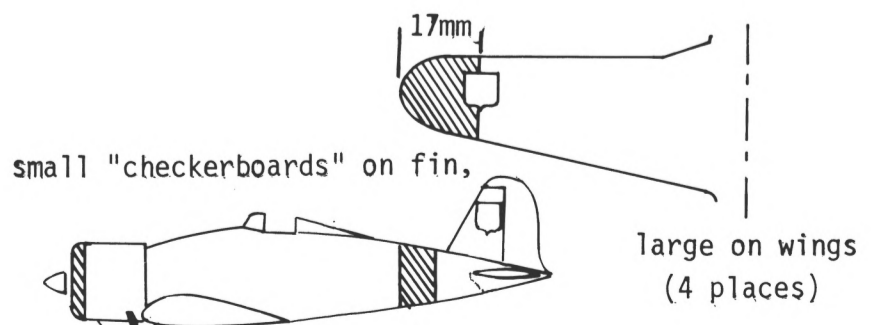


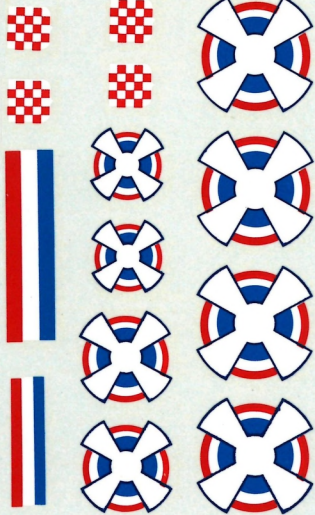
Bf109E-3, 32nd Grupa, 6th Puk, 1940.

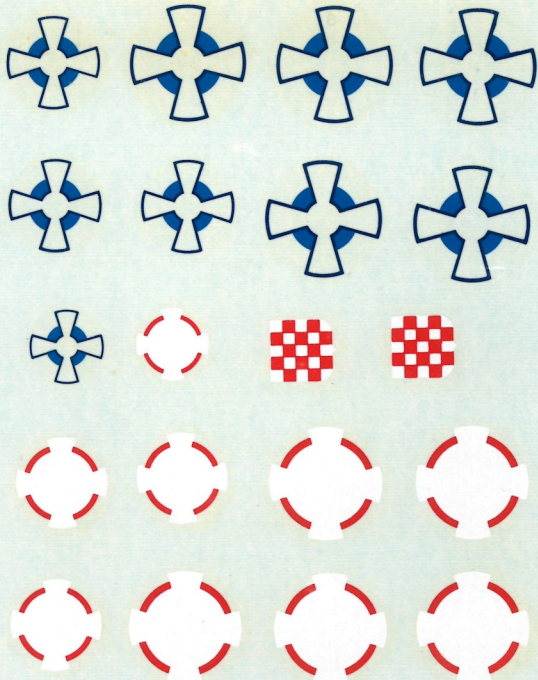

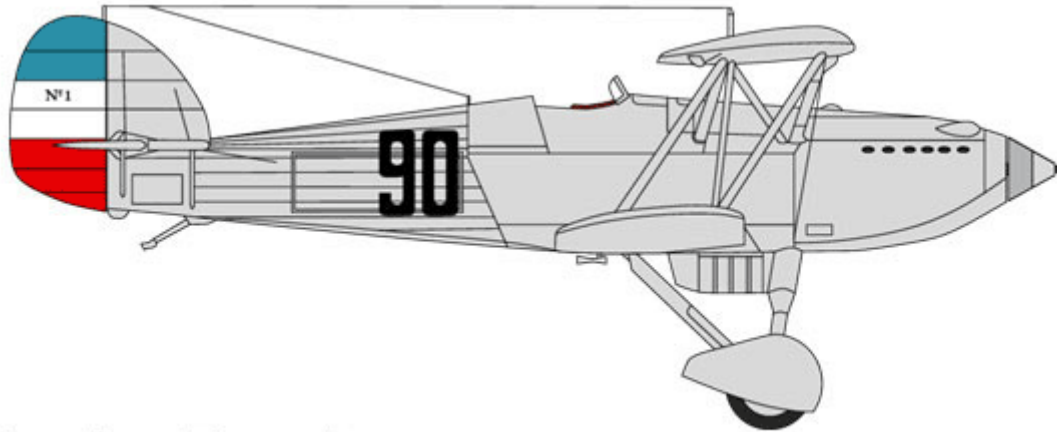

**Hawker Fury Mk.Ia 6 Puk, standard scheme (same as for number „2“)**



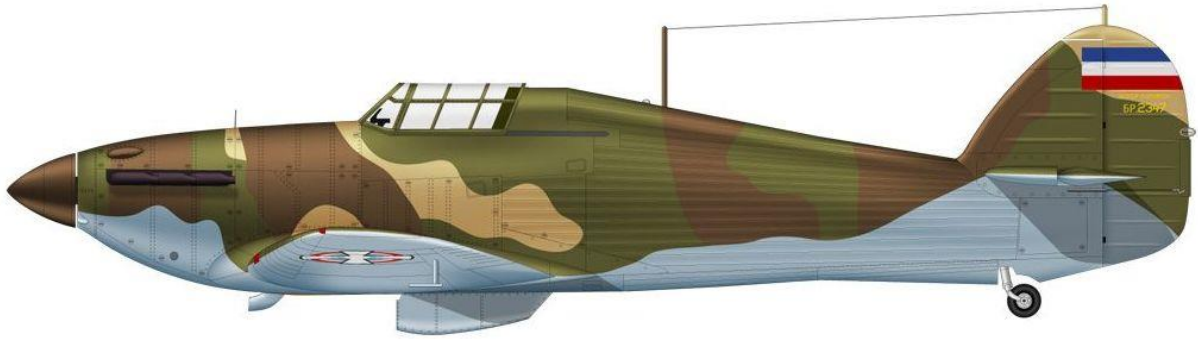

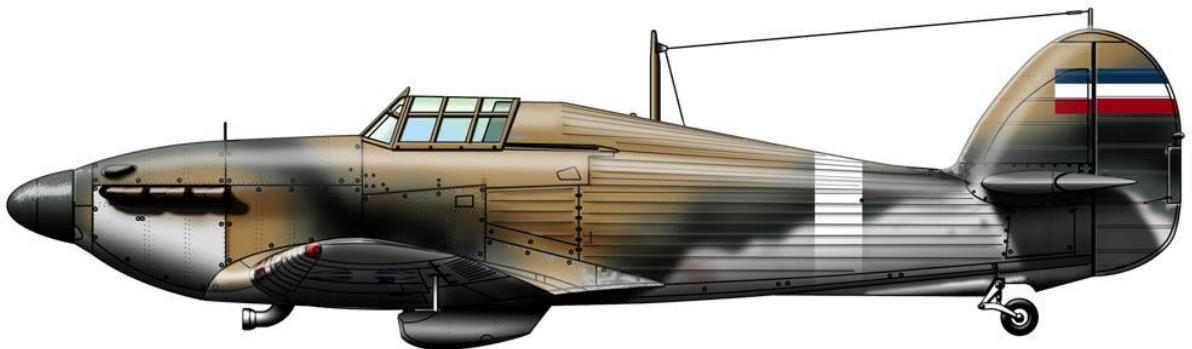

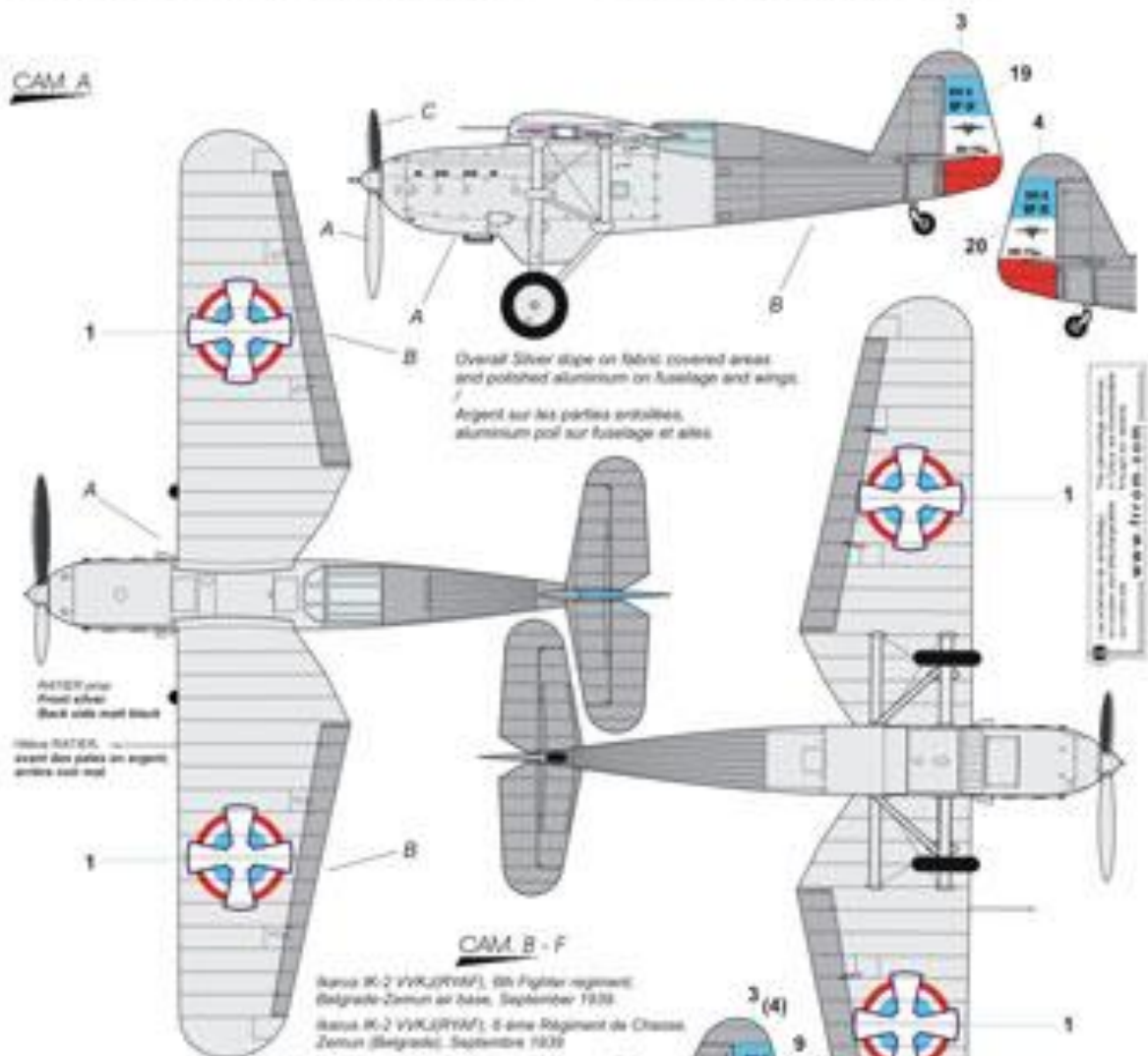

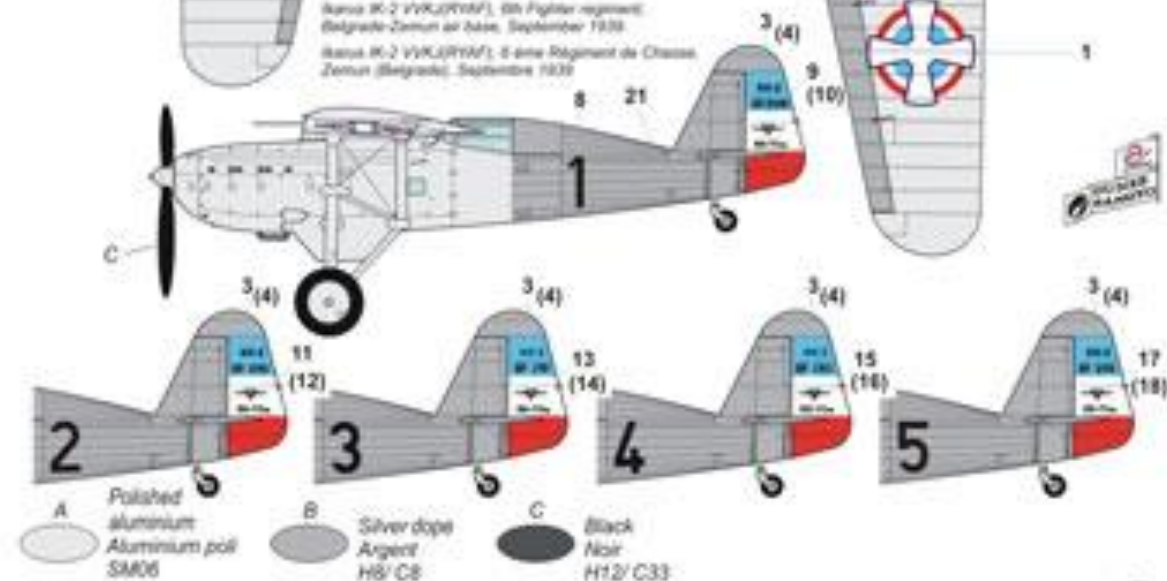

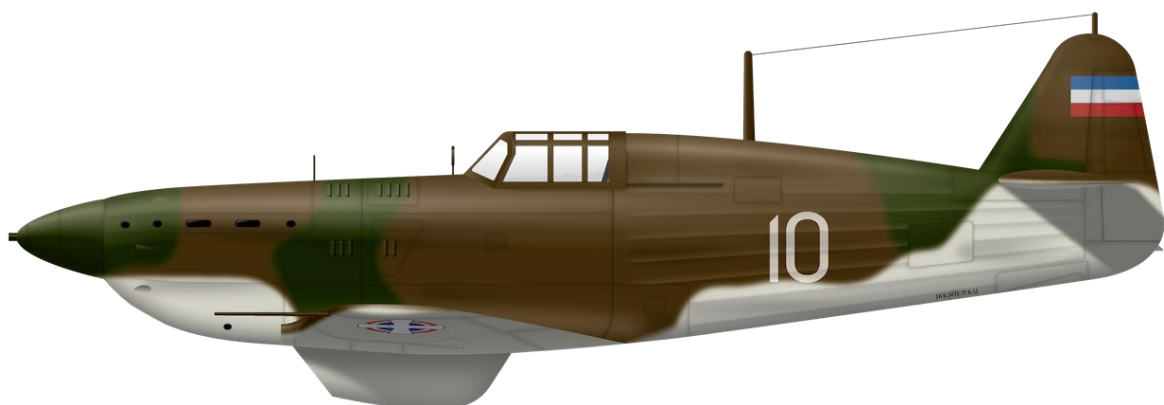

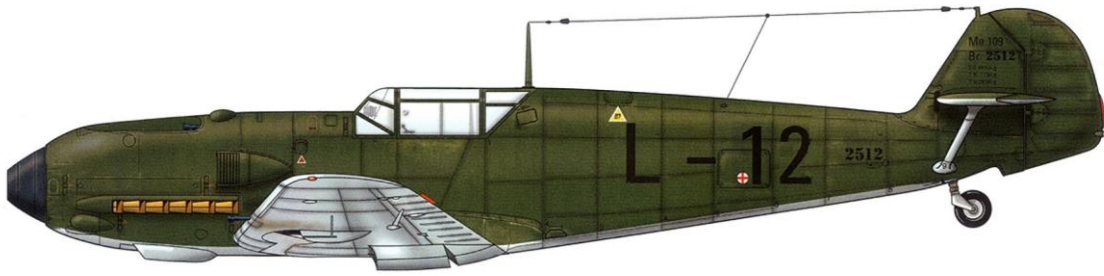


IK-2 in NDH service

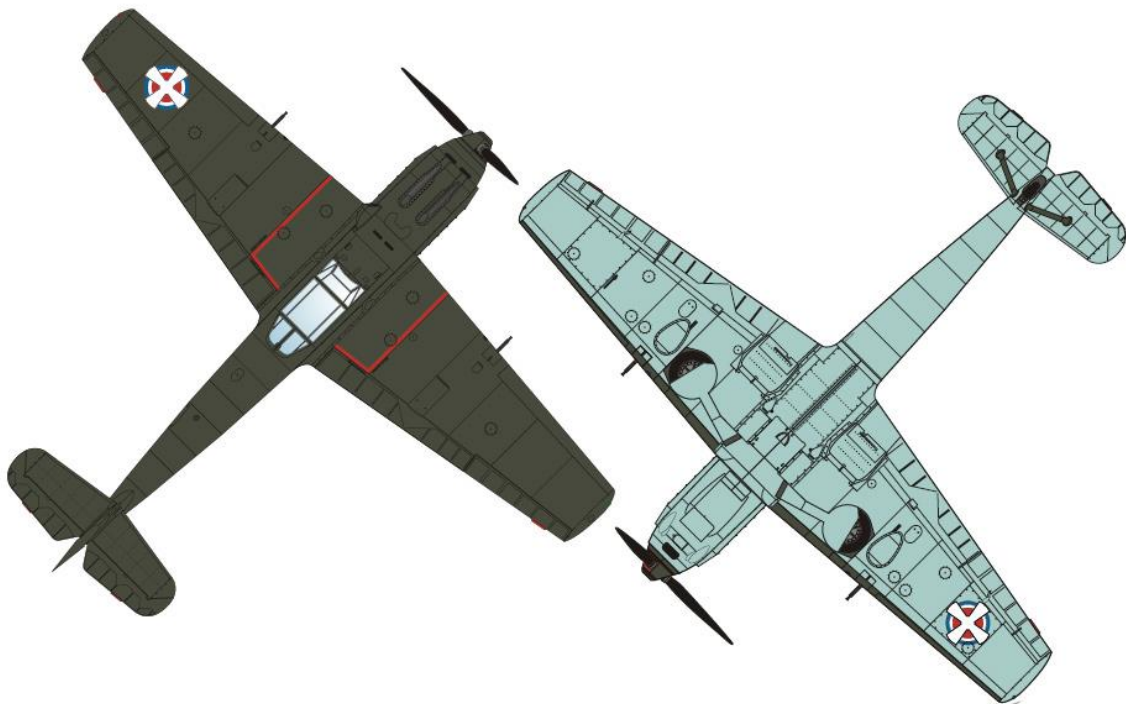


IK-3 161.Eskadrilla, 51.Grupa No.2159 Br.10 – April 1941

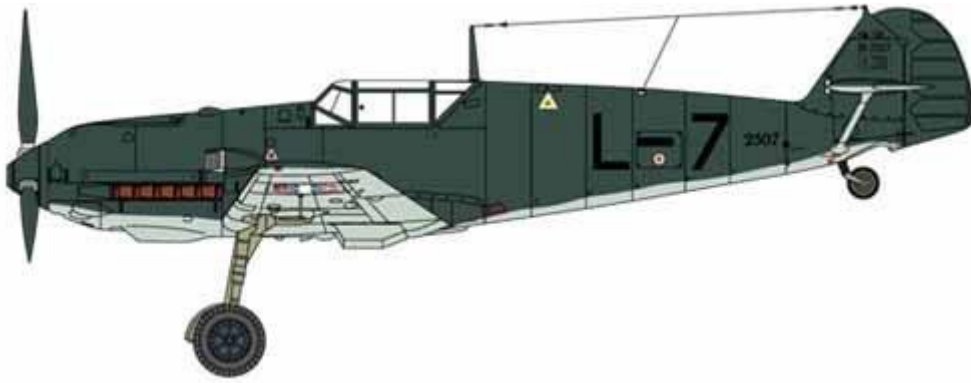

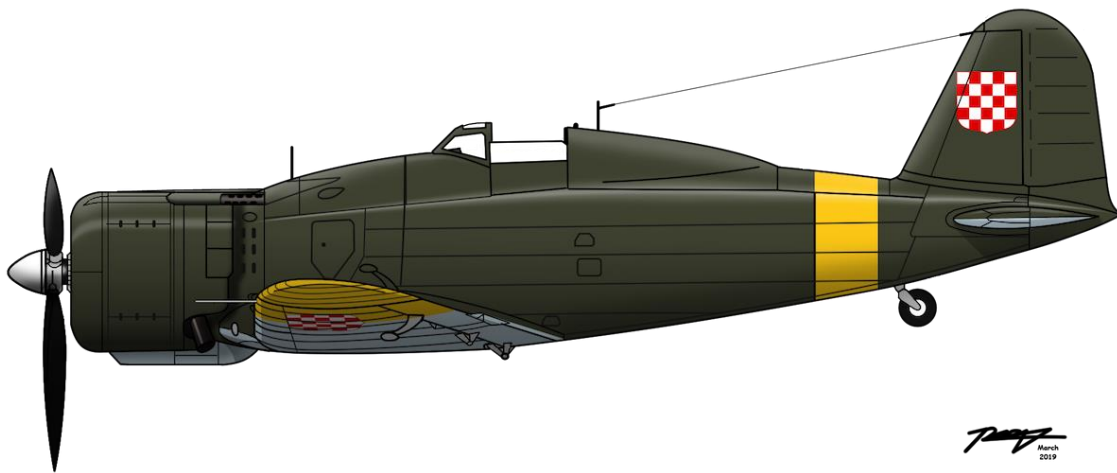
