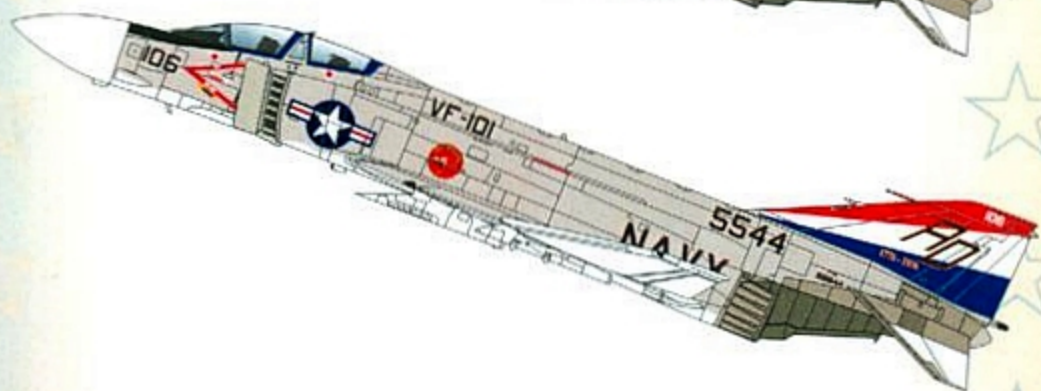

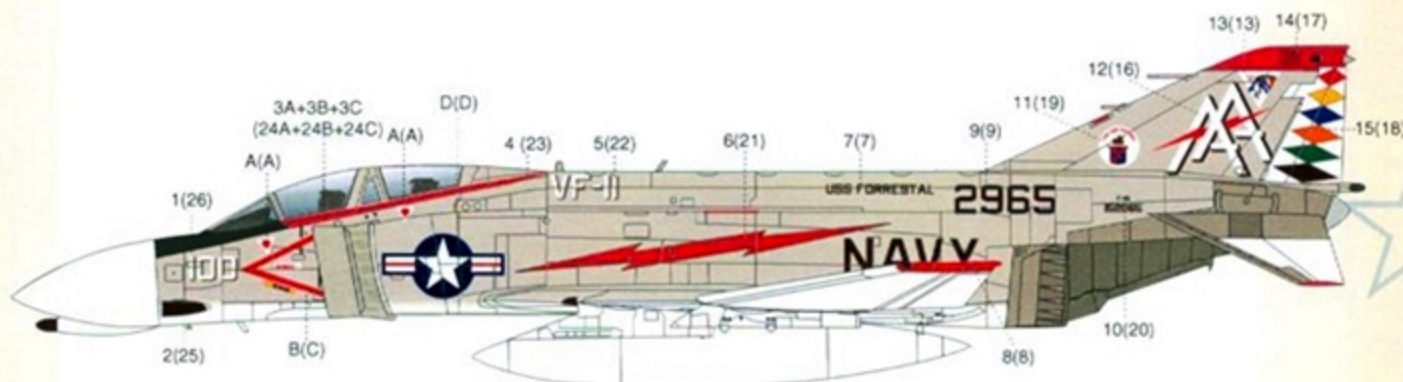

Suggested Kit: Hasegawa 1/48 Phantom Phamily

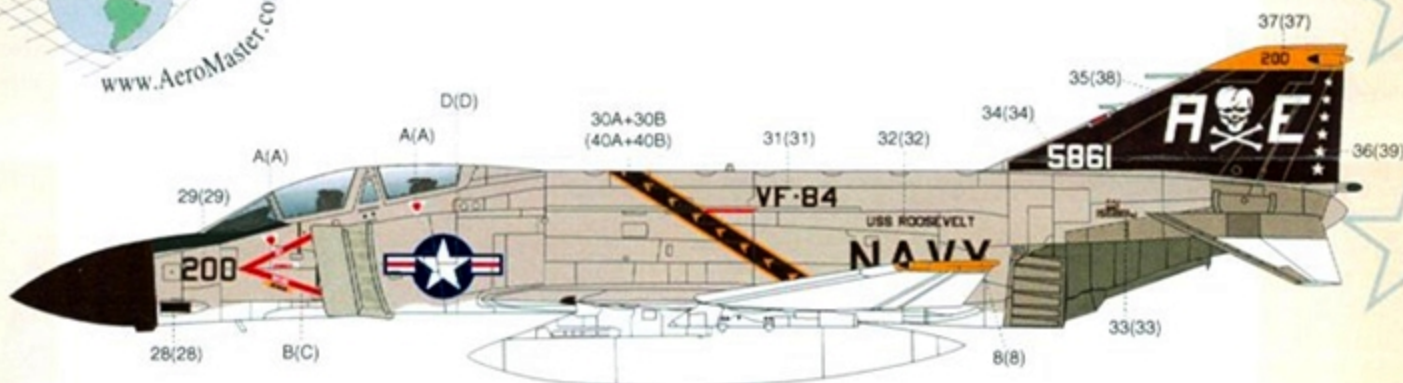


F-4B Phantom BuNo. 152965. Air Wing 17's CAG bird from VF-11 Red Rippers aboard USS Forrestal (CVA-59) in May, 1973. Finished in Non-Specular Gull Gray FS36440 upper surfaces and Gloss White FS17875 undersurfaces, landing gear, and control surfaces. Inlet, wing and tail surface leading edges have aluminum corroguard nish. Flat Black FS37038 antiglare panel. White radome. Wing and horizontal tail tip sections painted Red; use thin Black decal stripe provided for inboard cheat lines on wing tips only. Large national insignia on wings. Note slatted horizontal tails, tail ECM fairing, and IR housing under the nose radome with Black tip. Note the Cherry Point triangle on the right side serial presentation. Gull Gray fuselage wing walks. Photo ref 2 page 6.

F-4J Phantom BuNo. 155861. Assigned to VF-84 and own by Commander Carrier Air Wing Six aboard USS Franklin D. Roosevelt (CVA-42) in 1970. Painted Non-Specular Gull Gray FS36440 with Gloss White FS17875 undersurfaces, landing gear, and control surfaces. Flat Black FS37038 antiglare panel. Inlet, wing and tail surface leading edges in aluminum corroguard nish. Note that USN Phantoms did not have the triangular plates on the horizontal tails which were applied to USAF models only. Also note tail ECM fairing and ECM antenna. Paint tail Gloss Black and fin cap Gloss Yellow FS13785 before applying decals. Wingtip sections painted Gloss Yellow, no cheat lines. Large size wing national insignia. Gull Gray fuselage wing walks. Photo ref 2 page 26.



F-4J Phantom BuNo. 155544. Bicentennial bird as flown by VF-101 and based at NAS Oceana, VA, July 1976. Non-Specular Gull Gray FS36440 upper surfaces with Gloss White FS17875 undersurfaces, landing gear, and control surfaces. Antiglare panel Flat Black. Canopy frames finished in same Blue as tail markings. Inlet, wing and tail surface leading edges in aluminum corroguard nish. 30-inch size national insignia carried on wings. Note tail ECM antenna fairing and RIO's Blue-painted rear view mirror. Photo ref 2 page 30.
