




This AV-8B (162972) from Marine Attack Squadron (VMA)-231 saw combat during Operation Desert Storm in early 1991 and returned to Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Cherry Point, North Carolina, in the spring of 1991.



VMA-311 received its first night attack Harrier in May 1992. The assigned squadron tail code is "WL," but when assigned to a Marine Expeditionary Unit (MEU), it adopts that squadron's tail code but retains all markings associated with VMA-311 "Tomcats."
