

F-4B Phantom BuNo. 152292. The Black Barons of VMFA-321 were assigned to the Marine Air Reserve Training Detachment at Andrews AFB, Maryland. Gloss Gull Gray FS16440 upper surfaces with Gloss White FS17875 undersides, control surfaces, radome, landing gear, and wheel wells. The tip of the IR sensor under the nose was Radome Tan. Fuselage/wing walk areas painted Medium Gray. Bicentennial markings were to VMFA-321 Phantoms in July of 1975, replacing the earlier black and white scheme. Note tail ECM fairing and RIO's rear view mirror.

Paint upper fuselage and vertical tail Gloss Medium Blue FS15102 before applying star decals #11, 12 and 13. See plan

Non-Specular Gull Gray FS36440 overall with Gloss White FS17875 landing gear and wheel wells. International Orange FS12197 nose radome, wing tips, and tail surfaces, Flat Black antiglare panel. Fuselage/wing walk areas painted Medium Gray. No rear seat installed. Note tail ECM antenna fairings on tail and inlet trunks, added antennas. IR sensor on nose modified to carry camera for recording missile firings.
