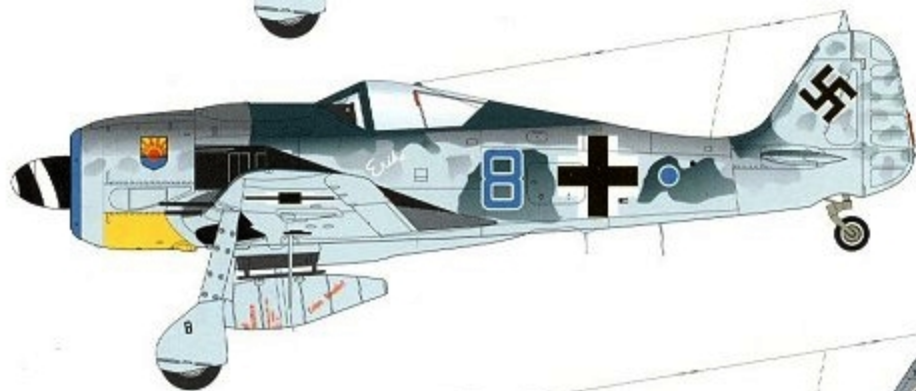

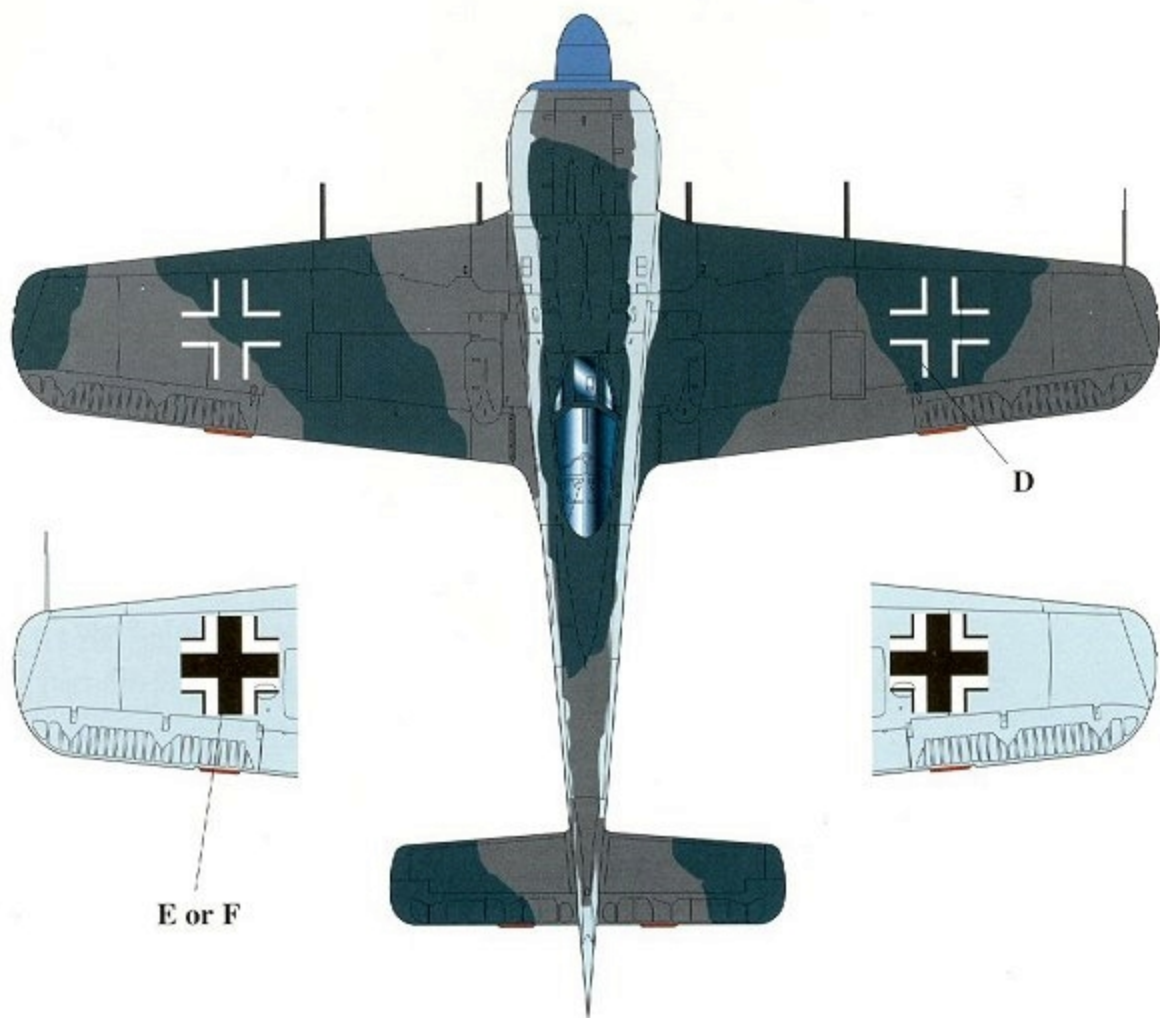

"Blue 13" Fw 190 A-8 W. Nr. Unknown Pilot: Unknown 12/JG 5 Spring 1945 Herdla Norway

Blown Canopy. Rare VDM 9 12153 metal propeller with external pitch control weights. (See drawing)

ETC 501 rack set up for carrying E2 steel drop tank.

Colors: Undersurfaces; 76 Light Blue; Uppersurfaces 75 Gray Violet; 74 Gray Green; 74/75 heavy mottling

"13" and IV. Gruppe circle Blue trimmed with White; cowl ring and spinner Blue with White spiral. Yellow under cowl.

Small Black "13" on gear doors. Prop Blades: 70 Black Green.

Whitewall tail wheel tire.

National Markings: Fuselage; B3 800 mm Black/White crosses, H2a Hakenkreuz

Wings; Upper B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B2 900 mm Black/White crosses.

"Blue 9" Fw 190 A-8 W. Nr. 350185 Pilot: Lt. Karl Heinz Koch 12/JG 5 Early 1945 Herdla Norway

ETC 501 rack equipped for carrying E2 steel drop tank. This aircraft crash landed 9 February 1945 and was heavily damaged.

Colors: Undersurfaces; 76 Light Blue; Uppersurfaces 75 Gray Violet; 74 Gray Green; 74/75 heavy mottling

"9" and IV. Gruppe circle Blue trimmed with White; Blue cowl ring. Spinner: Blue with White spiral. Prop Blades: 70 Black Green.

Small Black "9" on gear doors.

White rudder with 5 Black victory bars on both sides. JG 5 Eismeer badge on port side of motor cowl.

National Markings: Fuselage; B3 800 mm Black/White crosses, H2a Hakenkreuz

Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B3 900 mm Black/White crosses.

Stencilling: Factory Standard

"Blue 8" Fw 190 A-8 W. Nr. Unknown Pilot: Uffz. Dietrich 12/JG 5 Spring 1945 Herdla Norway

ETC 501 rack and drop tank.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces 75 Gray Violet; 74 Gray Green; 74/75 mottling especially heavy behind number "8" and IV. Gruppe circle.

"8" and IV. Gruppe circle Blue trimmed with White; Blue cowl ring. Possible Yellow undercowl.

JG 5 Eismeer badge on port side of motor cowl. *Erika* in White under cockpit on port side of fuselage.

Black Eagle wing design on side of fuselage. Small Black "8" on gear doors.

Spinner: Black/White spiral Prop Blades: 70 Black Green.

National Markings: Fuselage; B3 800 mm Black/White crosses, H2a Hakenkreuz

Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B3 900 mm Black/White crosses.

"White 10" Fw 190 A-8 W. Nr. 732197 Pilot: Fw. Rudolf Artner 9/JG 5 Spring 1945 Herdla Norway

No ETC 501 rack when photos taken.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet; 74 Gray Green; 74/75 mottling

"10" and cowl ring in White. Black/Yellow RV bands. 20 Black victory bars (15 American Stars, 5 Roundels).

Black spinner with White spiral. JG 5 Eismeer Badge on port side of motor cowl

Possibly Yellow under cowl. Prop Blades: 70 Black Green.

National Markings: Fuselage; B3 800 mm Black/White crosses, H2a Hakenkreuz

Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B3 900 mm Black/White crosses.

Stencilling: Factory Standard
