
## NORTH AMERICAN MUSTANG MARK 1 ROYAL CANADIAN AIR FORCE



414 SQUADRON, 1942 F/O HOLLIS H. HILLS



IN MID 1942, THREE R.C.A.F. SQUADRONS (400, 414 AND 430) WERE ISSUED WITH MUSTANG 1 AIRCRAFT. THE ROLE OF THE SQUADRONS WAS TO PHOTOGRAPH AND CONDUCT LOW LEVEL ATTACKS ON GERMAN INSTALLATIONS IN FRANCE.

THE ALLISON POWERED, MARK 1 MUSTANG HAD A .50 CAL. BROWNING ON EACH SIDE OF THE ENGINE. EACH WING CONTAINED A .50 INBOARD OF TWO .30 CAL. BROWNING MACHINE GUNS. 620 MUSTANG 1'S HAD BEEN DELIVERED TO BRITIAN BY JULY OF 1942...

THE ENCLOSED DECALS REPRESENT A MUSTANG 1, OF 414 SQUADRON, ROYAL CANADIAN AIR FORCE. FLOWN BY F/O HOLLIS H. "HOLLY" HILLS. ON AUGUST 19, 1942, THIS AIRCRAFT PARTICIPATED IN THE DIEPPE RAID.

ON HIS SECOND SORTIE, HILLS SHOT DOWN A FOCKE-WULF 190A. THIS WAS HIS FIRST VICTORY AND THE FIRST ENEMY AIRCRAFT DESTROYED BY A MUSTANG.

IT IS INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT AT LEAST SIXTY ALLISON POWERED MUSTANGS WERE STILL IN R.A.F SERVICE AT THE END OF HOSTILITIES.
