Suggested Kit: Revell/Monogram B-26 Marauder

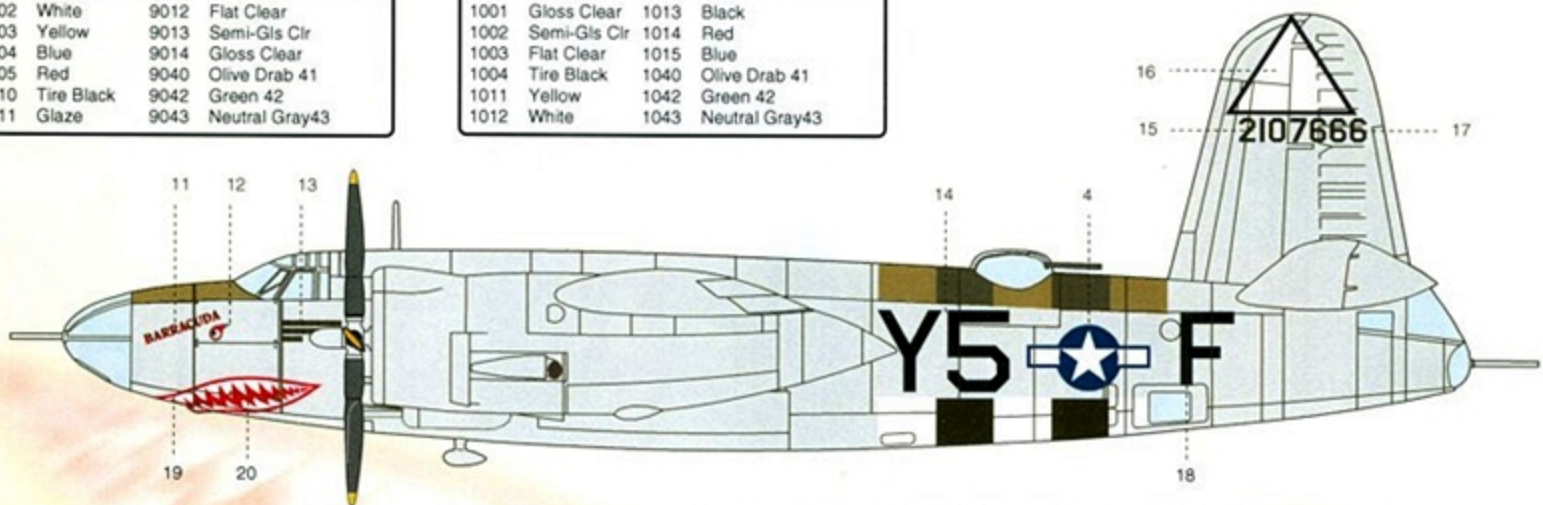


A/C 1: B-26B-45. This A/C, camouflaged in standard Olive Drab and Neutral Gray, flew with the 575th Bw/391st BG during 1944. Notice the Green 46 splotching on upper wing, stabilizer and fin/rudder as well as the extremely heavy paint chipping. A photo of their A/C showing the extensive chipping can be seen on page 48 of reference one. A/C wore D-Day stripes after June 6, 1944.

A/C 2: A veteran of over 75 missions with the 495th BS, 344th BG this Natural Metal B-26C-45, Barracuda wears fuselage D-Day stripes, with Olive Drab overpainting the upper White section. At the time of our depiction it had the wing bands removed altogether. During and for a time after D-Day, wing bands were present on this A/C. Photo on page 67 of reference one. Apply left sharkmouth (part 19) edging nose wheel door. Apply right sharkmouth (part 25) edging nose wheel door. Make sure they meet at the center line of the A/C in front of the nose wheel bay. Apply parts 20 and 24 to the left and right nose wheel doors. Assemble doors when dry.
