This MiG-21MF wears the standard Yugoslav pale gray air-superiority camouflage as well as the standard dark green intake shock cone, transponder filter fin aerial, and dielectric fin fairing. Note the overpainted tactical number on both nose sides. Note, too, the starboard drop tank's hand-painted "104." We do not know whether this was repeated on the port-side tank, so we have supplied two versions — just in case. Intake leading edge is aluminum.
