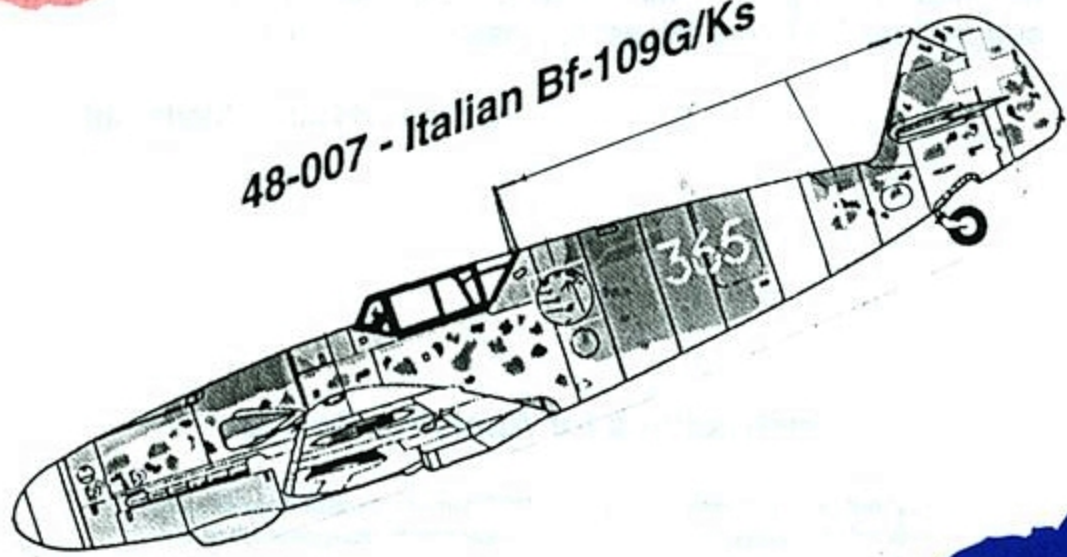

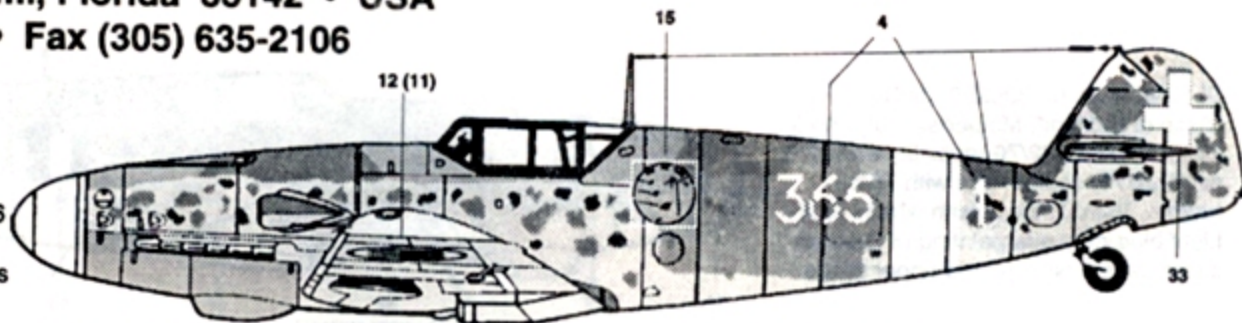

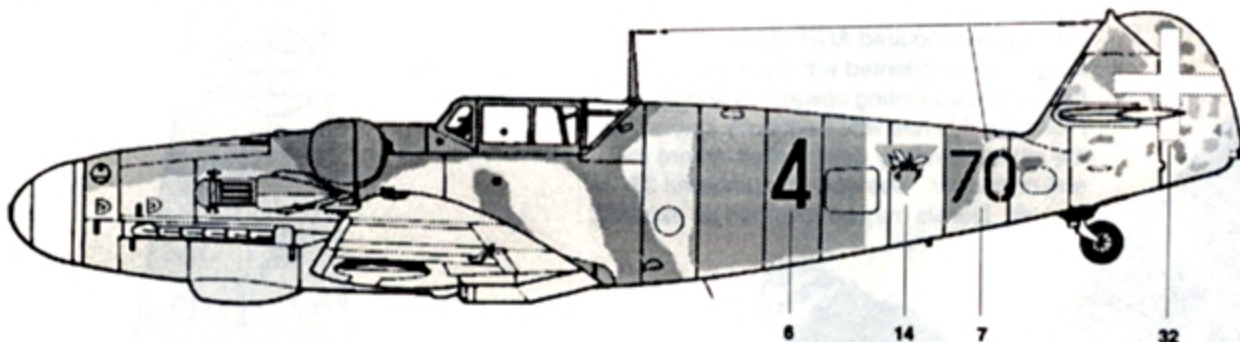

Bf-109G-4/R6, 365a Squadriglia, 150° Gruppo Autonomo Caccia Terrestre "Gigi Tre Osei", Regia Aeronautica Italiana, Siacca, Sicily, June 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with 70/02/74 mottling. German insignias and radio callsign letters overpainted with Italian *grigio-azzurro chiaro* (light blue-grey). Canopy frames RLM 66. Spinner, fuselage band, and upper and lower wingtips white. Lower cowl yellow. Code reads "1-365" on right side of fuselage.

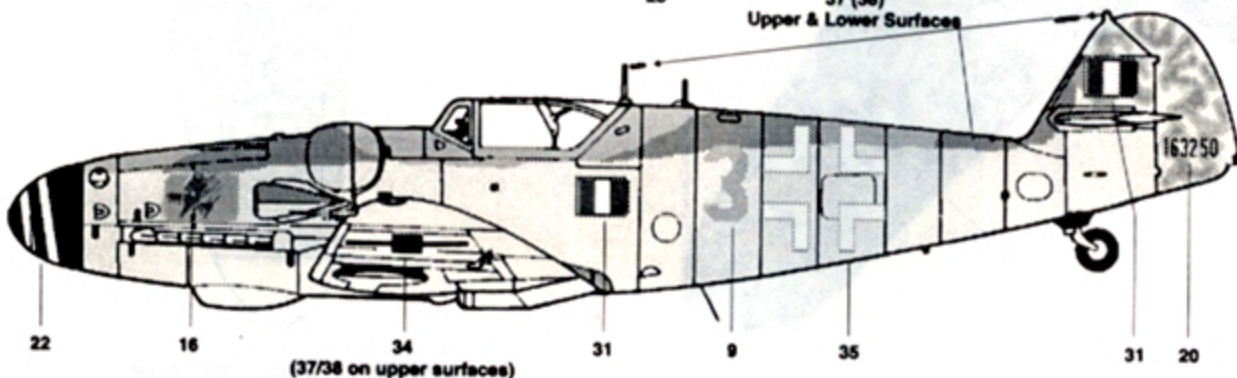
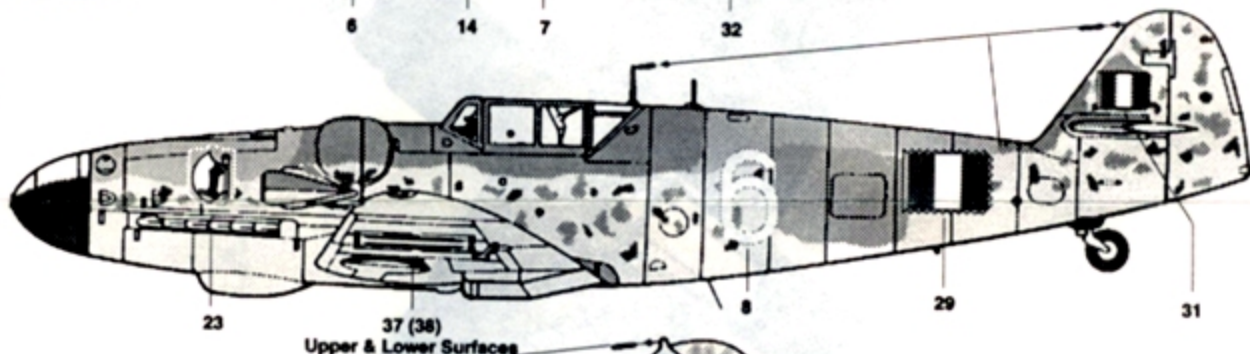


Additional markings are provided for a Bf-109G-4/R6, coded 364-5 and a Bf-109G-6/R6/trop, coded 365-15 of the 150° Gruppo. Both machines are essentially similar to 365-1 above, except that Bf-109G-4/R6 364-5 does not have a yellow lower cowl. By mixing and matching from the numbers provided, other 150° Gruppo machines may be modeled. Consult references for other variations.



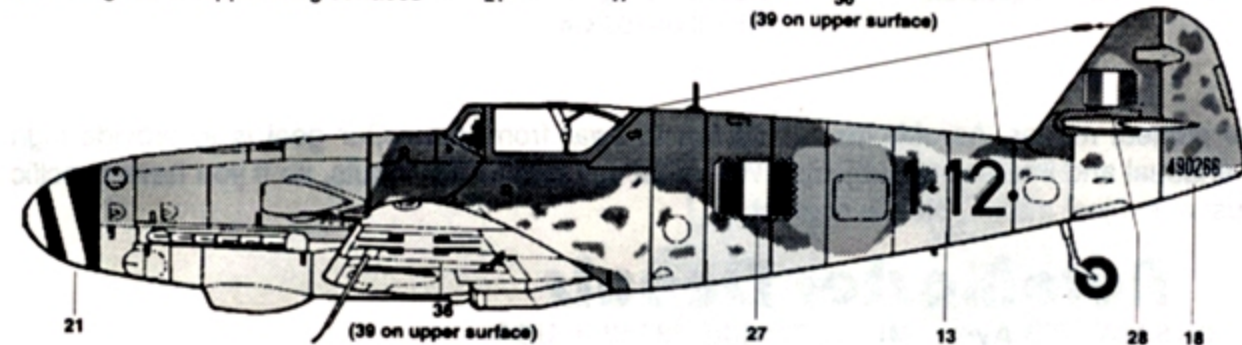
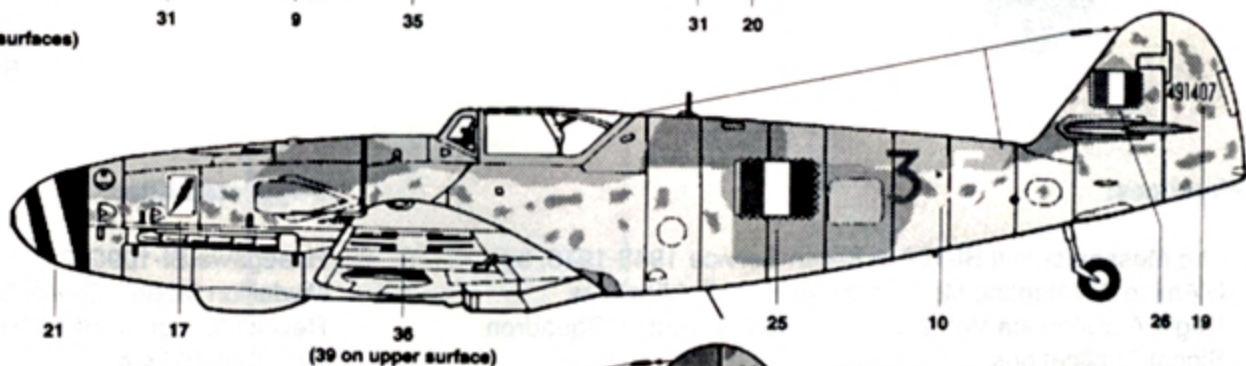
Bf-109G-6/R6/trop, 70^a Sq., 23° Gr., "Vespa Arrabbiata", Regia Aeronautica, Cerveteri, Italy, August 1943. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with German insignias overpainted in light blue-grey. Spinner and rear fuselage band white. No national insignias carried on wings.

Bf-109G-6/R3, 3a Sq., II° Gr. "Gamba di Ferro", Aeronautica Nazionale Repubblicana, Villafranca, Italy, July 1944. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with German insignias overpainted in light blue-grey. Spinner RLM 70 and white. **NOTE: Green section of flag is toward the front on all ANR aircraft**



Bf-109G-14, w. nr. 163250, 2° Sq., II° Gr., "Diavoli Rossi", Osoppo, Italy, November 1944. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with light blue-grey overpainting of swastika and former Luftwaffe unit insignia on cowl. ANR insignias on upper wings. Spinner black with white spiral.

Bf-109G-10/AS, w. nr. 491407, 3a Sq., I° Gr., "Asso di Bastoni", Malpensa, Italy, February 1945. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage with fuselage and upper wing German insignias overpainted in light blue-grey. Radio compartment hatch appears lighter, possibly natural metal. Spinner black with white spiral. ANR insignias on upper wing surfaces



Bf-109G-10, w. nr. 490266, 1^a Sq., I° Gr., flown by M.lo. Dino Forlani, Lonate Pozzolo, Italy, March, 1945. RLM 81/83/76 camouflage with 75/82 rudder. German insignias overpainted in light blue-grey. ANR insignias on upper wing surfaces. Spinner black with white spiral.
