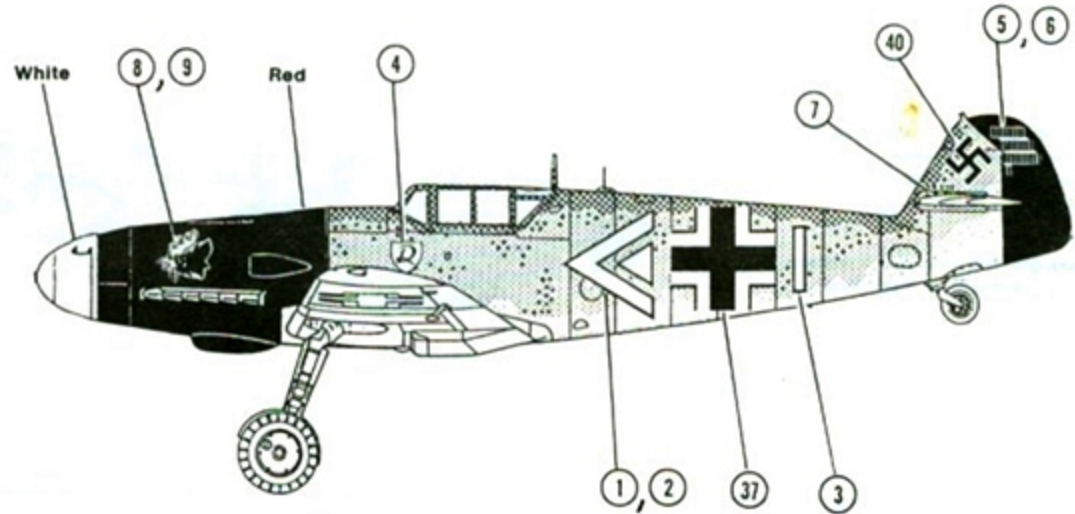

Red: Cowling and rudder

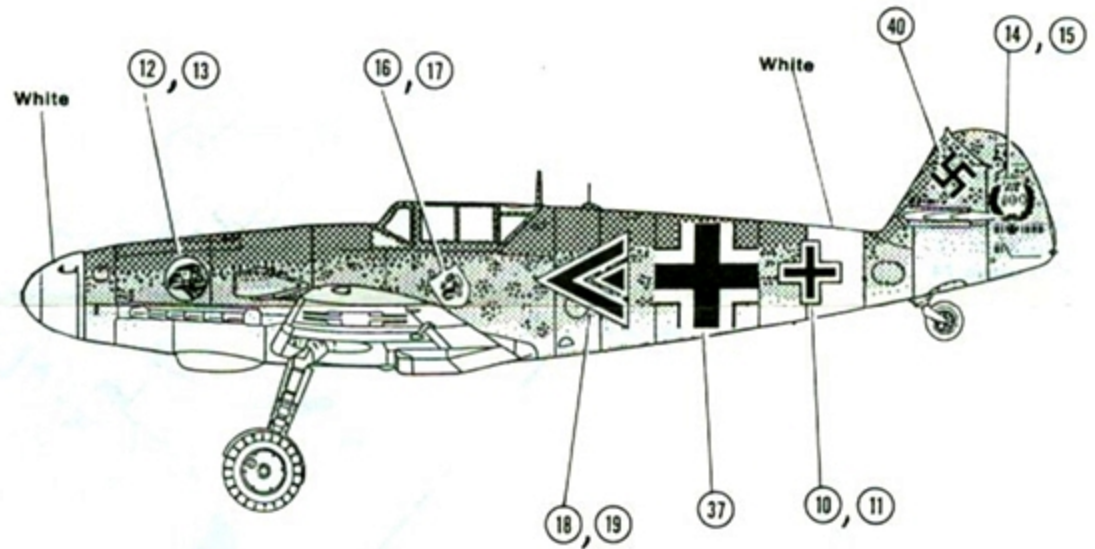
White: Spinner

with gray-violet mottle over it. blue

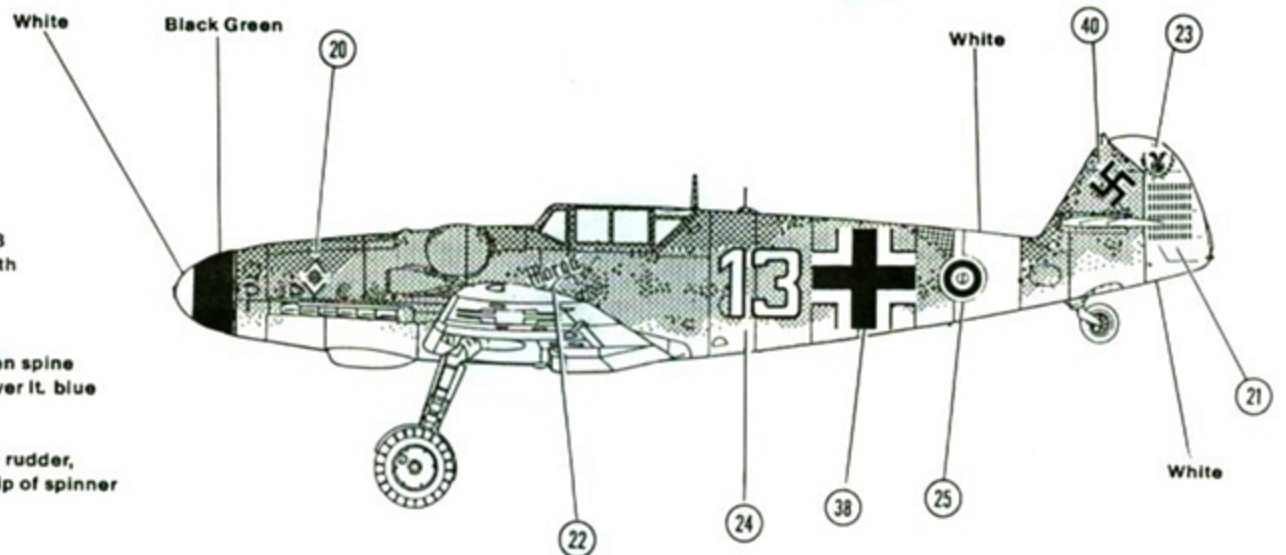
White: Spinner and fuselage band

with medium green mottle over it. blue

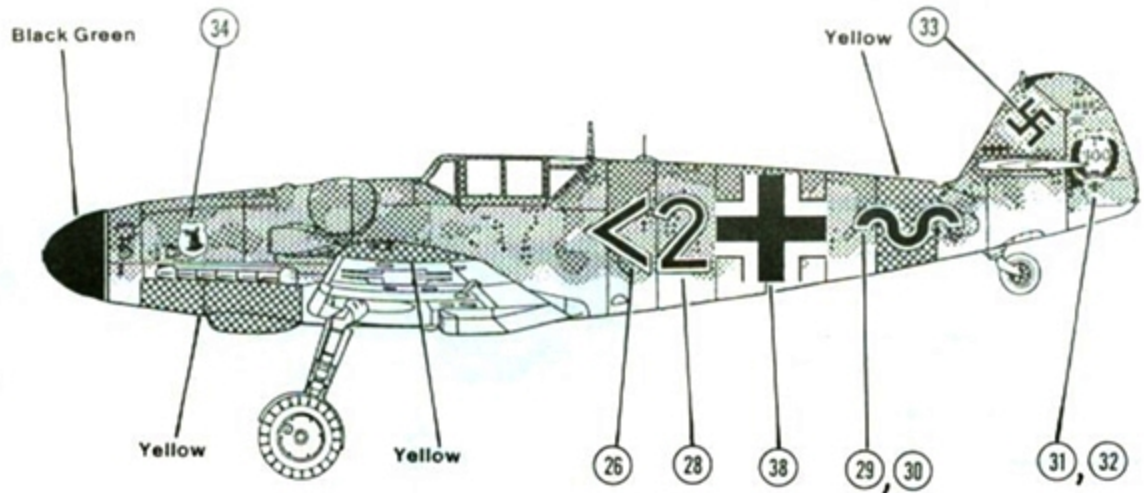
White: Underside wing tips, rudder,
