 Stuck. Aluminum with O.D.  
 anti-glare panels &  
 FS35109 mid-blue  
 empennage. C.E. 13' prop  
 with black blades & yellow  
 tips. Note 2" border  
 around rear fuselage  
 insignia bars.



above & right —  
 P-47N 44-87916, USAAF  
 73FS, 318FG, Pacific  
 Theater, 1945. Pilot is not  
 known. Aluminum with  
 O.D. anti-glare panels.  
 C.E. 13' prop with black  
 blades & yellow tips. Paint  
 tail Yellow before applying  
 black stripe decals 22-25.  
 Note a/c number on gear  
 doors.



above & right —  
 P-47N 44-87946, USAAF  
 73FS, 318FG, Pacific  
 Theater, 1945. Pilot was  
 Lt. Joe Cecci. Aluminum  
 with O.D. anti-glare panels.  
 C.E. 13' prop with black  
 blades & yellow tips. Top  
 half of fin is black — as is  
 the outer half (top and  
 bottom) of both horizontal  
 stabilizers.
