





B-24H (serial unknown), "My Achin' Back!!", 716th BS, 449th BG, 15th AF, Grottaglie, Italy, January 1945. Olive Drab and Neutral Gray camouflage with white, yellow and black outer vertical tail surfaces. Paint outside of tails white then apply decal. Yellow fuselage stripe. De-icer boots removed from all flying surfaces. Tail designs painted over boot areas, wing boot areas natural metal.





B-24H, 42-7755, "Screamin' Meemie II", 726th BS, 451st BG, Castellucio, Italy, July 1944. Olive Drab & Neutral Gray camouflage with red forward cowlings. All de-icer boots removed leaving natural metal leading edges on all flying surfaces.

B-24H-15-FO, 42-94785, "Struggle Buggy", 845th BS, 489th BG, 8th AF, Halesworth, England, August 1944. Flown by 1 Lt. Maynard Kisinger, this aircraft landed at Dubendorf, Switzerland on 11 August after being damaged by flak on a mission to Saarbrücken. Olive Drab & Neutral Gray camouflage. De-icer boots on all flying surfaces. Note ball turret removed and all national insignias greved-out.
