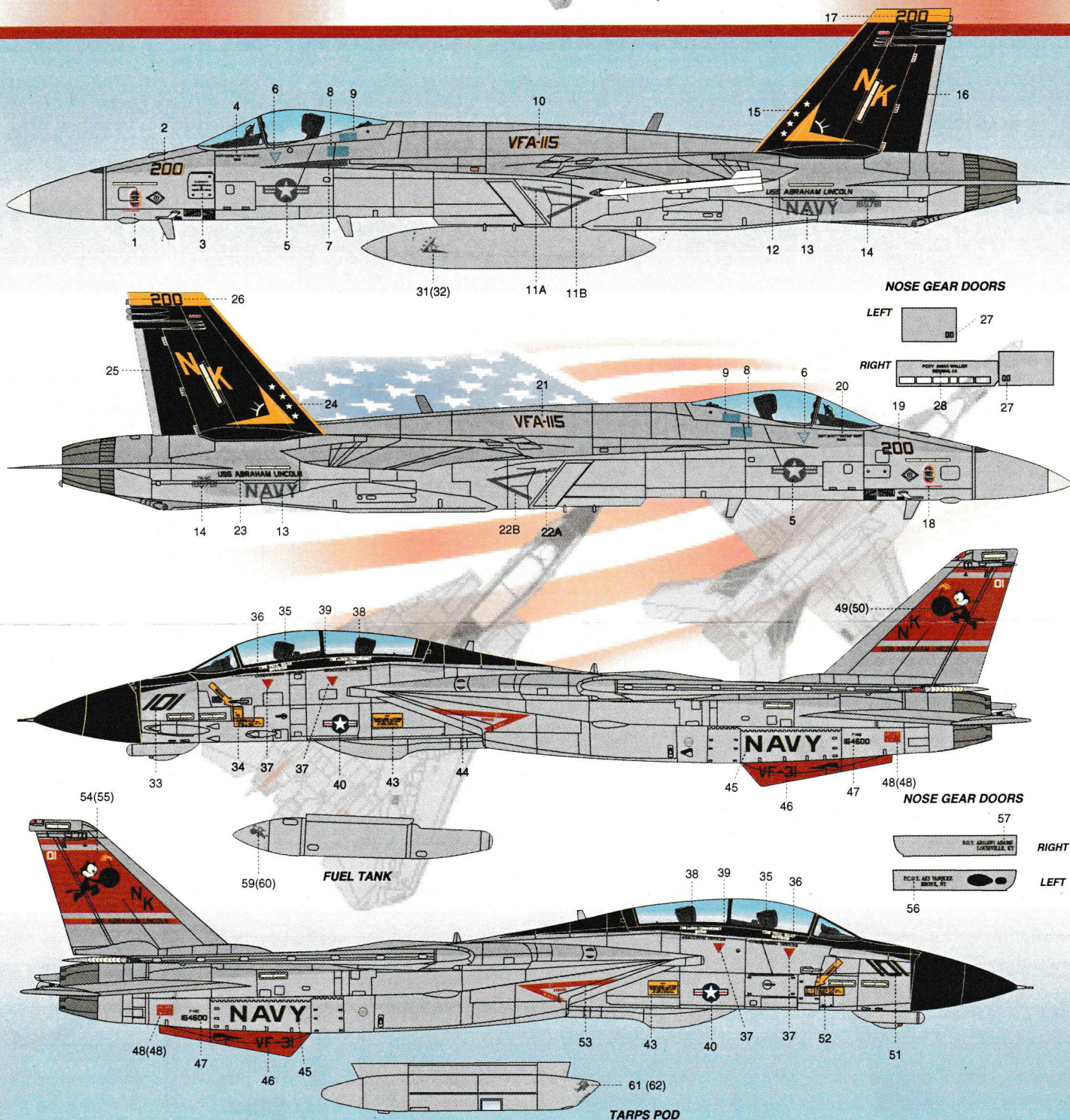

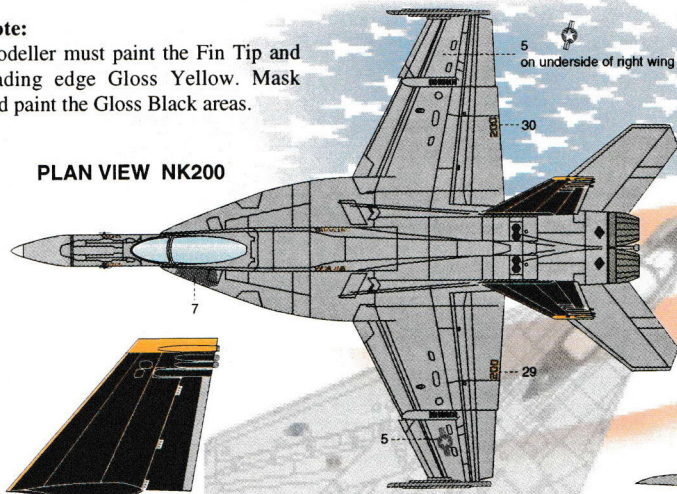

Modeller must paint the Fin Tip and leading edge Gloss Yellow. Mask and paint the Gloss Black areas.

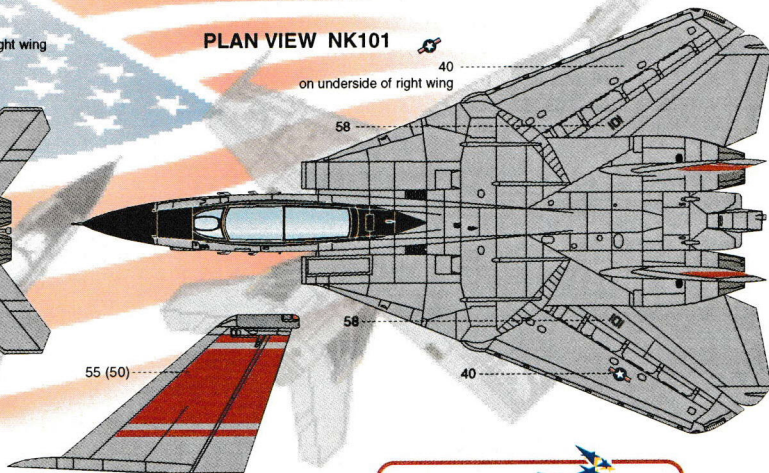
PLAN VIEW NK200
