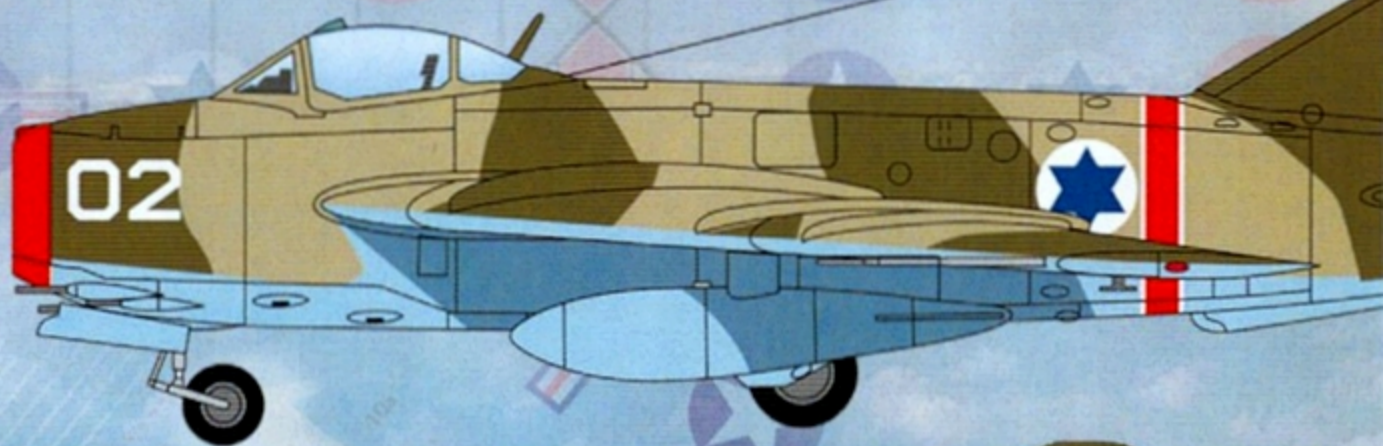

# MiG-17 Fresco

Walk Around No. 46

**This MiG-17 has served in the United States, Israeli, Syrian, and East German air forces**



"White 055" was used in Project Have Drill at Groom Lake Nevada by the U.S. Air Force and Navy from January to May 1969. USAF and USN pilots and technicians used "White 055" to evaluate the MiG-17's design and performance.

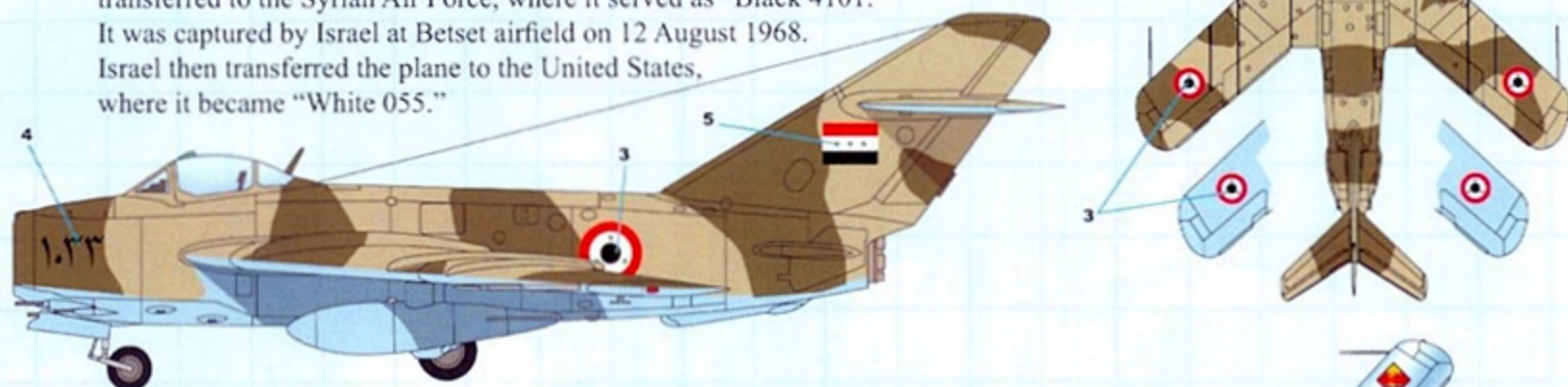


When MiG-17F serial number 1C-07-18 was captured in 1968, Israel painted it in Israeli markings before turning it over to the United States in 1969.

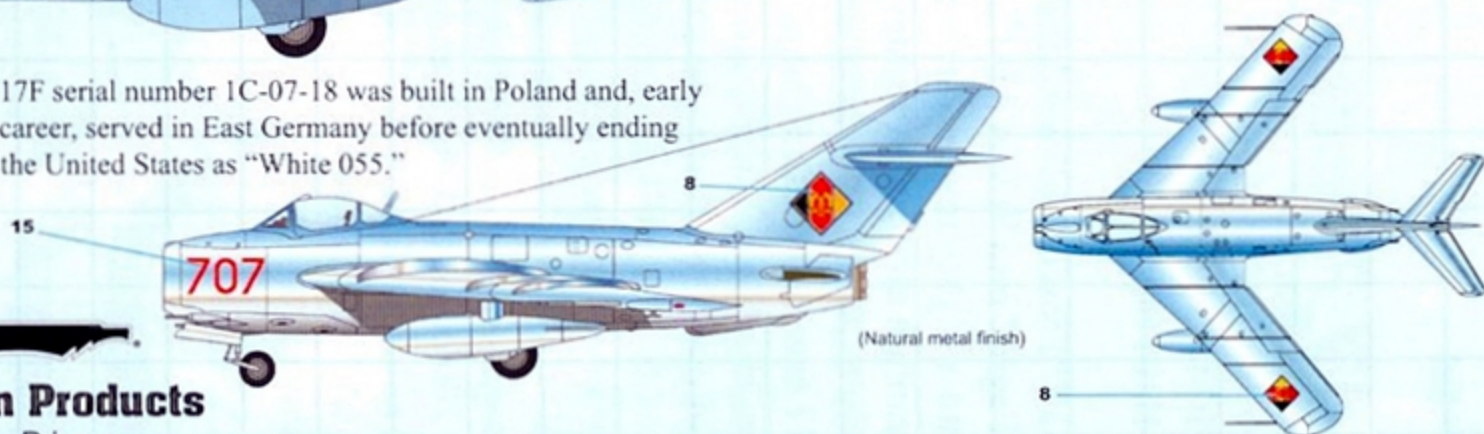


Note: To ensure compatibility with various kits, extra length has been added to the wing stripes that may require trimming – depending on the kit you use.

After serving in East Germany, MiG-17F serial number 1C-07-18 was transferred to the Syrian Air Force, where it served as "Black 4101." It was captured by Israel at Betset airfield on 12 August 1968. Israel then transferred the plane to the United States, where it became "White 055."



MiG-17F serial number 1C-07-18 was built in Poland and, early in its career, served in East Germany before eventually ending up in the United States as "White 055."
