fin tip.



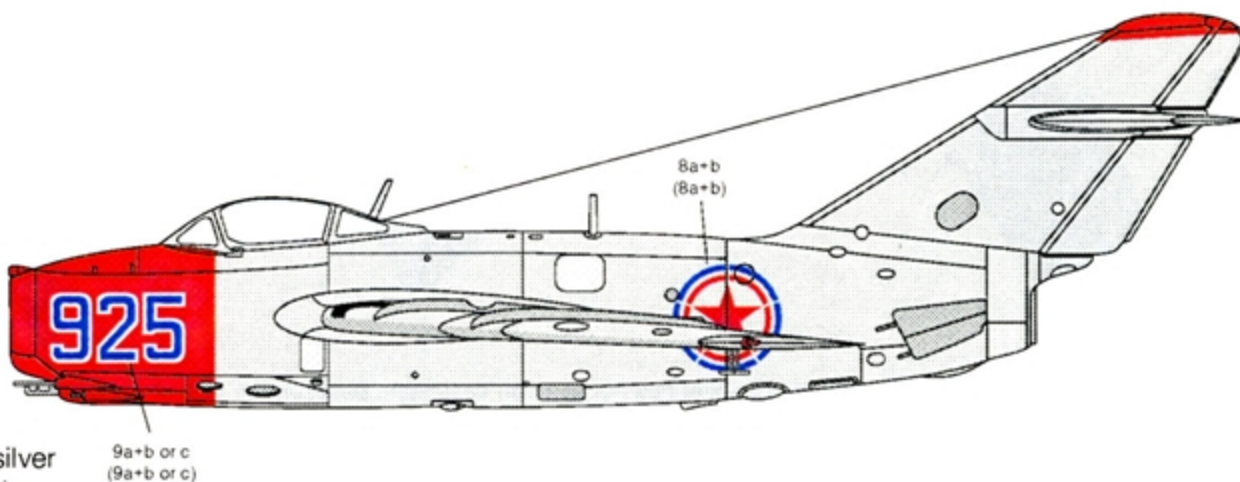

Light Blue.



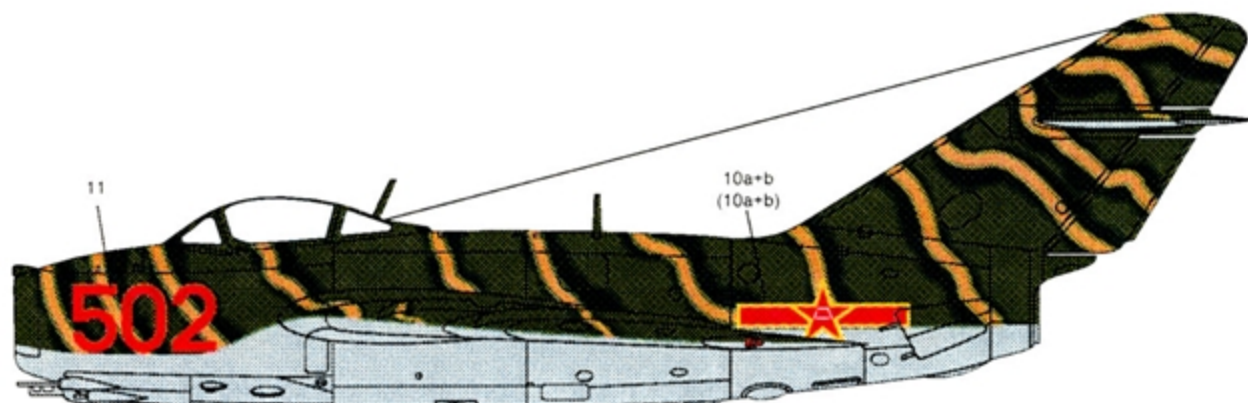
## A/C #3

silver. Both are supplied.



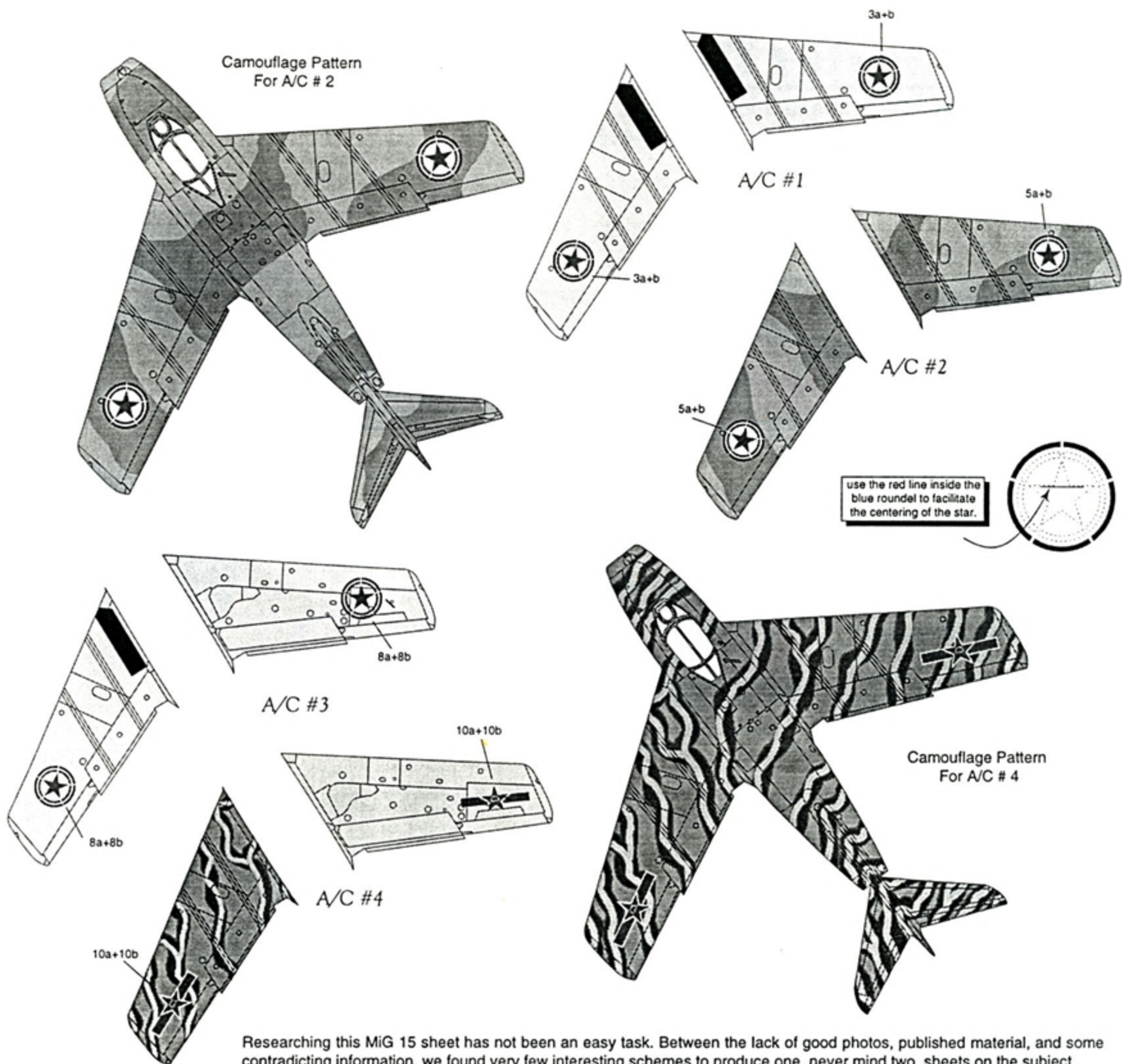
