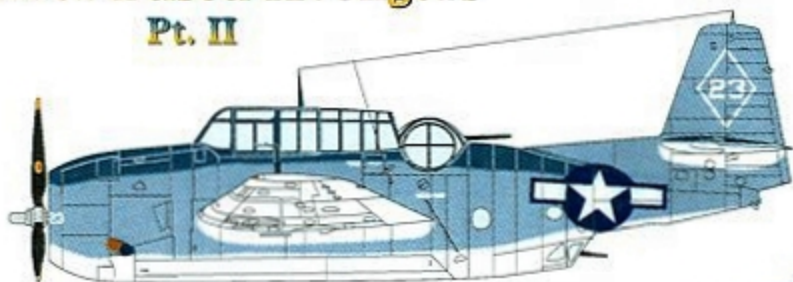

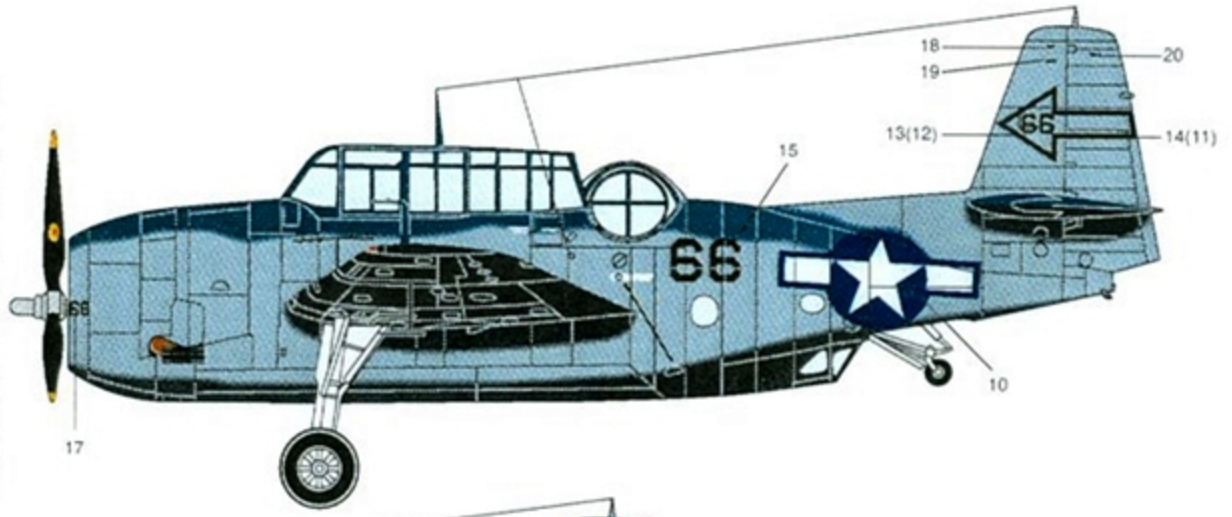

Carrier Based Avengers Pt. II 48-290

TBM-3 of VT(N)-90, USS ENTERPRISE (CV-6), March 8, 1945. This Avenger seems to have been painted Non-Specular Sea Blue and Intermediate Blue over Black or Non-Specular Sea Blue for night intruder missions. This is our interpretation of the photo that appears on pg. 34 of reference 2. This A/C was definitely not painted in the standard tri-color scheme during this time period. Note flame dampener, Yagi antenna, and removed rear armament.

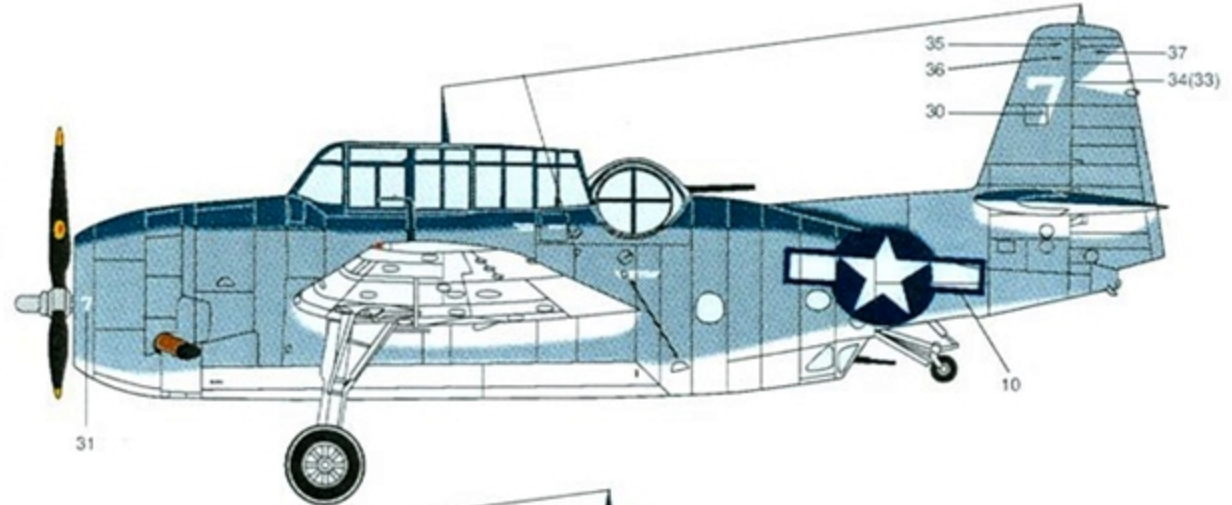

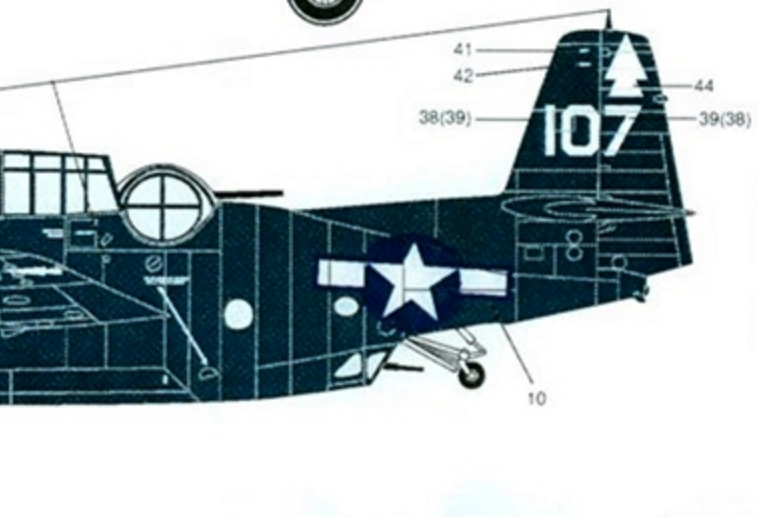

TBM-3 of VC-92, CVE-72, 1945. This Avenger has the standard tri-color scheme applied to it. The upper wing national insignia appears to have only been applied in White, no Insignia Blue disc. If the more common insignia is desired, modellers should feel free to substitute decal 10 for 29.
