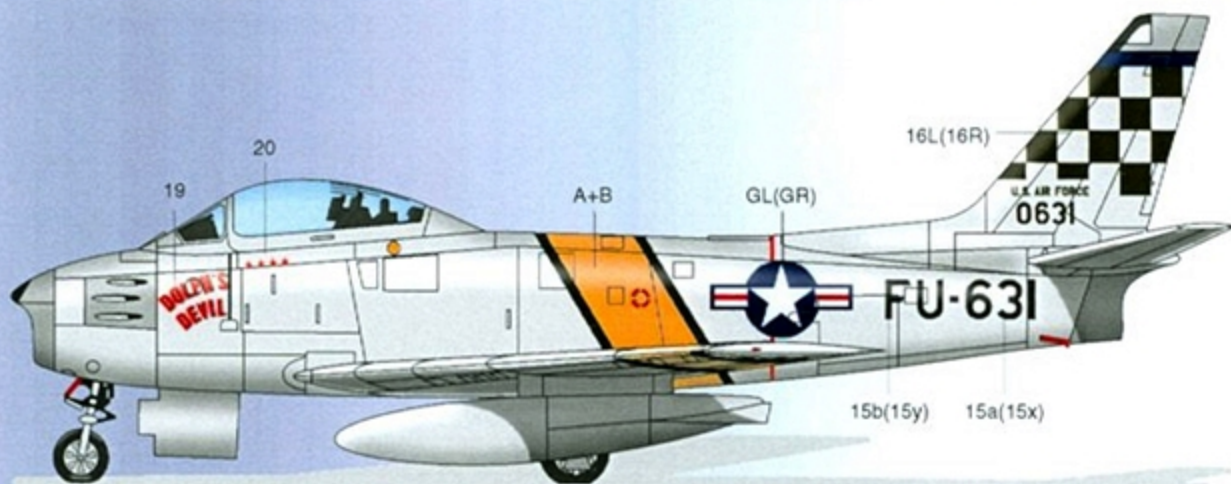

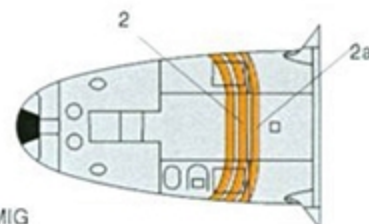
"MIG MAD MAVIS"

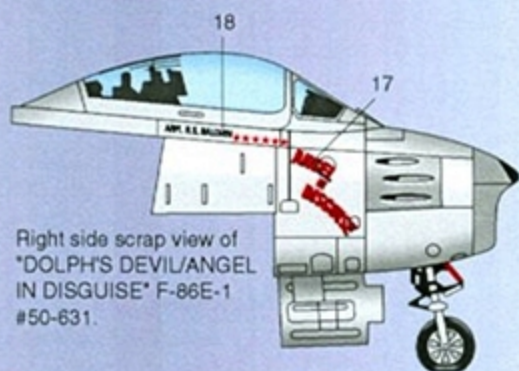


"MIG POISON/NORINE"

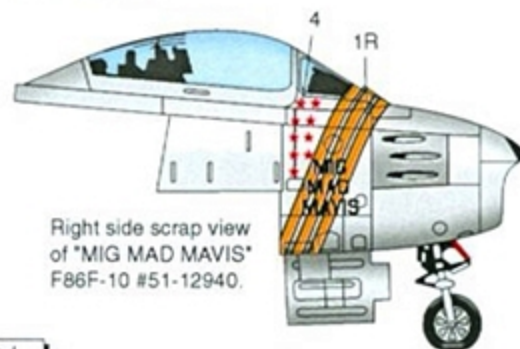
Underside scrap view of "MIG MAD MAVIS". Note forward and middle yellow stripes only, run across nose wheel door.
