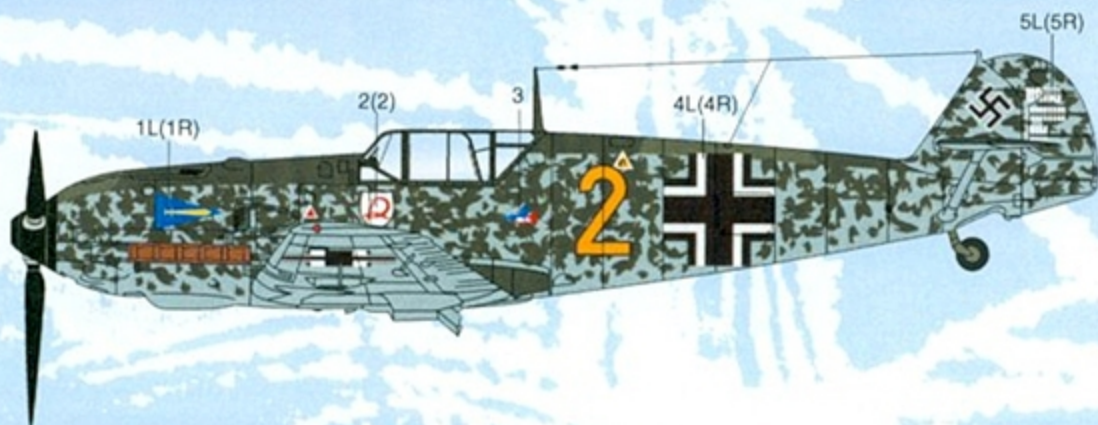

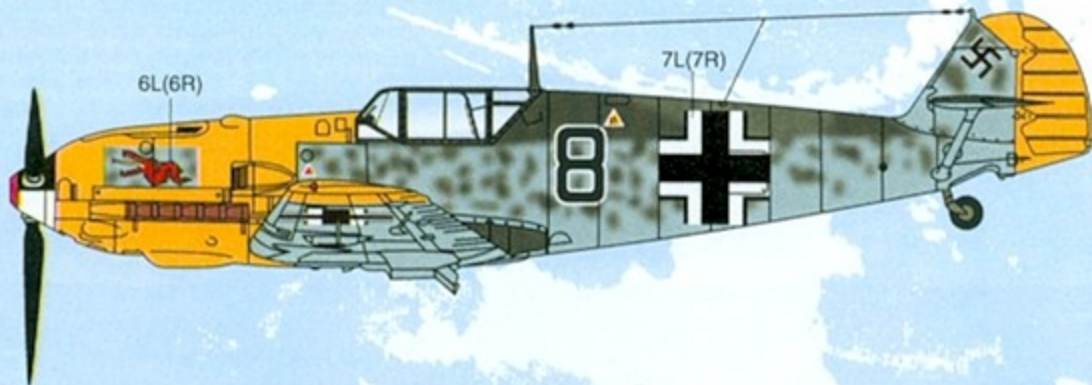

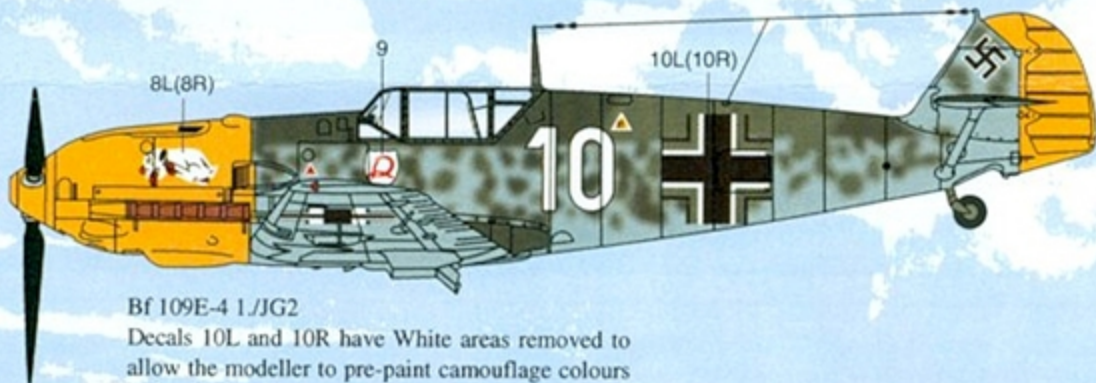
Bf 109E-4 'Yellow 2' 3/JG2
Oblt. Helmut Wick, Staffelfkapitan.
'Yellow 2' carries typical JG2 heavy stippling in RLM 71. Wick's personal 'Kingfisher' emblem is displayed below the cockpit together with his current victory tally of 22 Abschuss bars on the fin. Note also that the fuselage Balkenkreuz has had its white areas narrowed to reduce visibility.



Bf 109E-4 'Black 8' 2/JG3
Ofw. Bernhard Lampskemper
'Black 8' carried only light mottling of RLM 02 & 71. Note the 'painted around' Tatzelwurm emblem on the cowling and the black and white halved spinner, tipped with red. Lampskemper crash landed near Pevensey on 29 August 1940 after combat with RAF Spitfires.



Bf 109E-4 'White 10' 1/JG2
Carrying alternate heavy and light mottling of RLM 02 & 71, 'White 10' has also had the white areas of the Balkenkreuz overpainted in one of the camouflage colours to reduce its visibility. The 'Richthofen' Geschwader shield is displayed below the cockpit and the 1. Staffel, 'Bonzo Dog' emblem appears on the cowling.

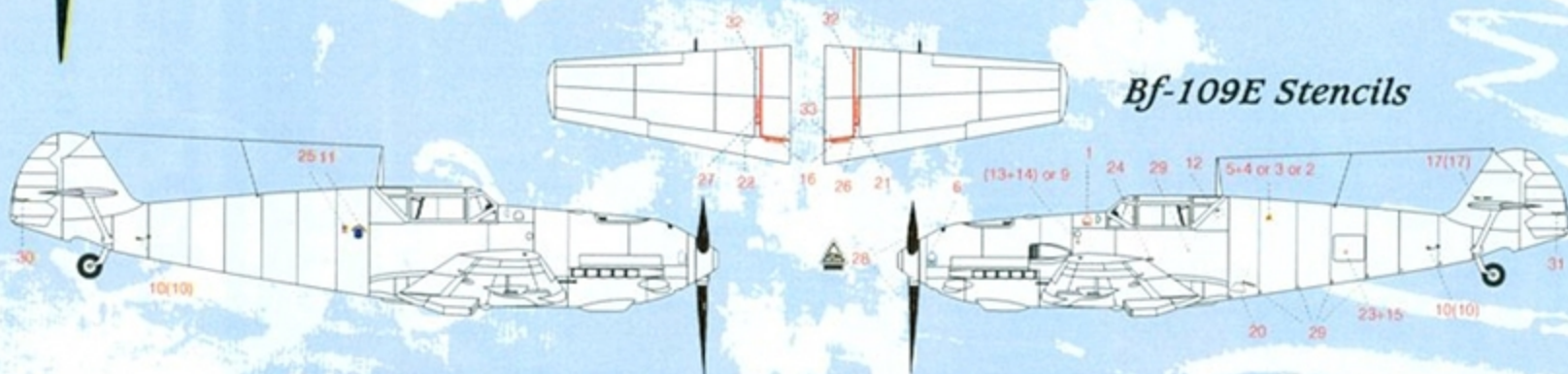


Bf 109E-4 1/JG2
Decals 10L and 10R have White areas removed to allow the modeller to pre-paint camouflage colours before laying the decal.

Bf 109E-4 'Black 6' 5/JG27
Fw. Erich Braun
Braun's aircraft was hit while in combat over Tonbridge, Kent. Fortunately he baled out and was made POW, but the aircraft was completely destroyed. 'Black 6' is shown with a lightly applied mottling of RLM 02 & 71 and carries the 'Berlin Bear' IIJG27 emblem and red Gruppe bar on the rear of the fuselage. A/C profile has been reconstructed using data and photos of other A/C of IIJG27
