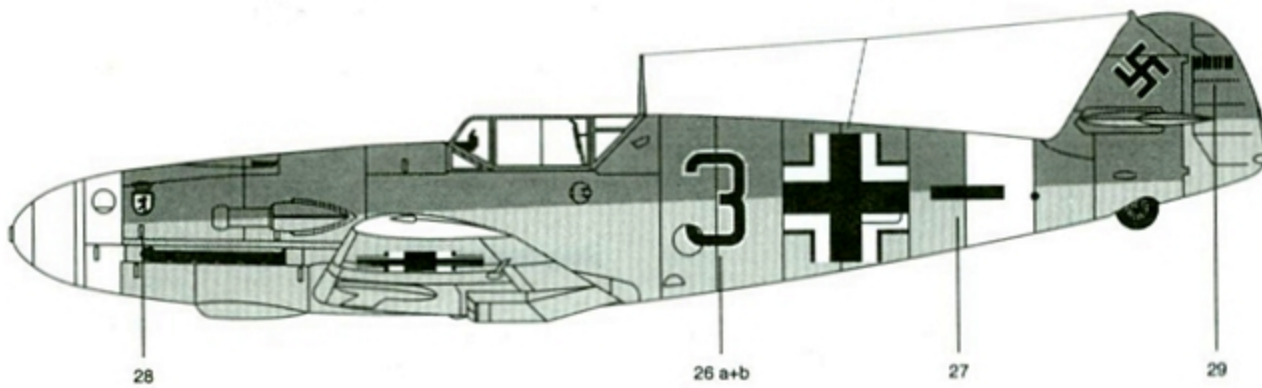

Kittyhawk Mk. III, probably EW421, No. 2 Sqn, RSAF, North Africa, 1942. Flown by CO of No. 2 Sqn, Maj. D.B. Hauptfleisch. RAF Dark Earth, Mid Stone and Azure Blue camouflage with red spinner. The digit "1" appears to be missing from the right side serial. Both serials over-painted by code letters. Orange centers for the roundels and fin flashes are provided, as some RSAF aircraft carried them. It is not known if this aircraft carried orange or dull red centers.



Tomahawk IIb, AN413, "Nan", No. 112 Sqn, RAF, Sidi Haneish, Egypt, 1941. Dark Earth, Mid Stone and Azure Blue camouflage with red spinner.

Hurricane Mk. IIb, BD930, No. 73 Sqn, RAF, North Africa, 1942. Dark Earth, Mid Stone and Azure Blue camouflage with red spinner.



Bf-109F-4/trop, 5./JG27, North Africa, June 1942. Flown by Oblt. Ernst Börngen. RLM 78/79 camouflage with white rear fuselage band, nose section, and lower wingtips. Use national insignias from AeroMaster Sheet 48-020.

Bf-109G-2/trop, 2./JG77, Gabes, Tunisia, 1943. RLM 78/79 camouflage with snake pattern of RLM 70 or Italian dark green over all upper and side surfaces. Green sprayed around markings. White spinner, fuselage band and upper and lower wingtips. Use national insignias from AeroMaster Sheet 48-020.
