

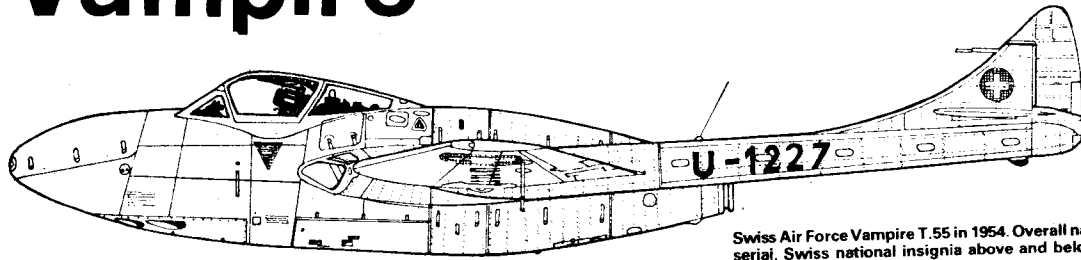

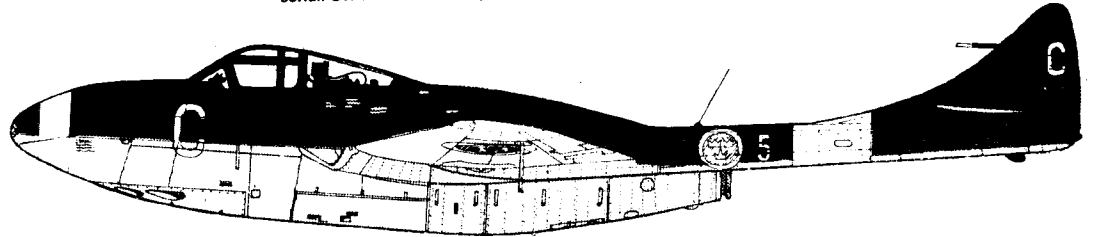

Swedish Air Force T.55 of F.5, Ljungbyhed. Upper surfaces dark green, lower surfaces light grey. Codes and numeral, yellow with dayglo pink nose and tail bands and wing tips.

Replace complete fuselage and booms by AIRMODEL parts.
Add outer tailplane parts.

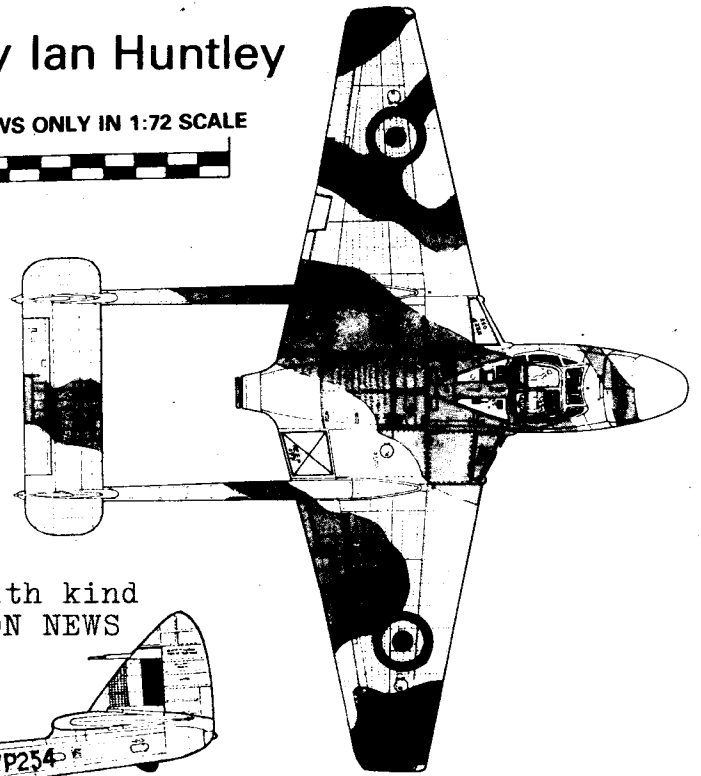
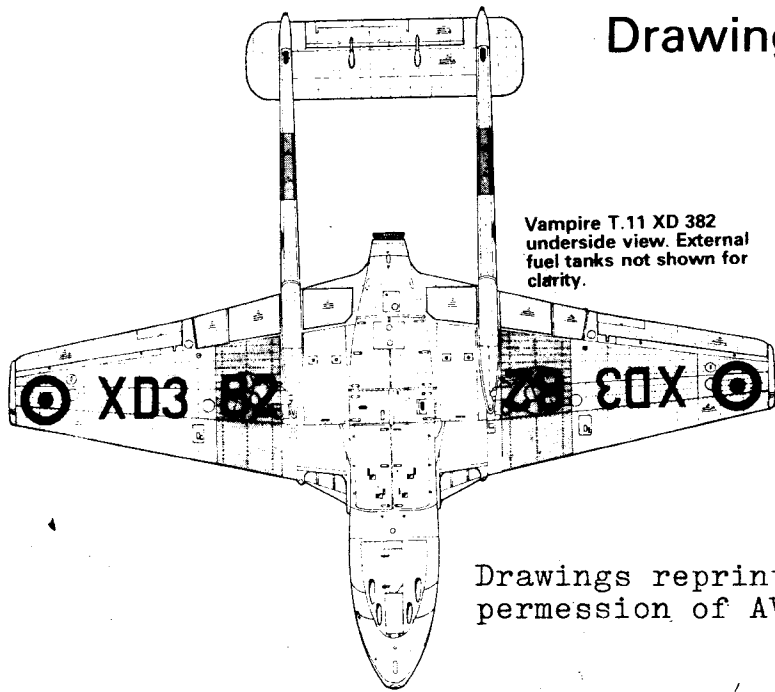

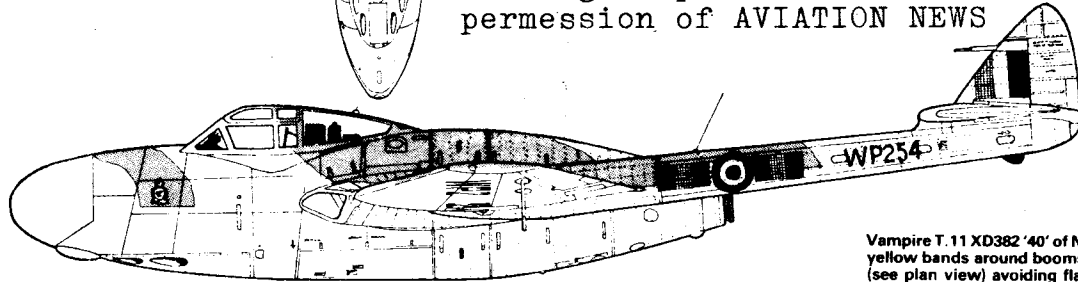
SIDE VIEWS ONLY IN 1:72 SCALE

clarity.

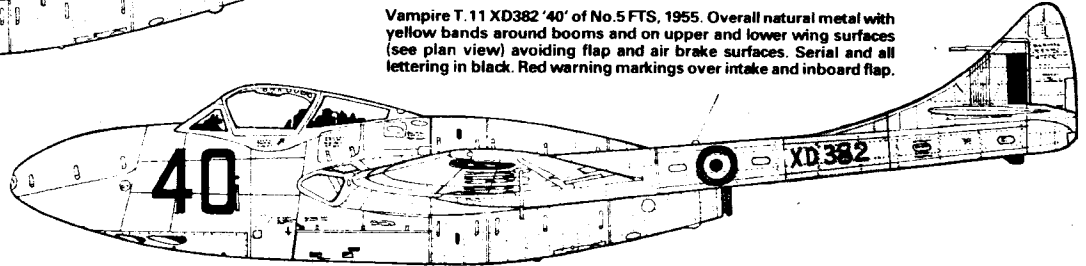

green and medium sea grey. Lower surfaces medium sea
grey. Roundels in six positions. Red, blue, red squadron
insignia on either side of boom roundel. White letter 'D'
on nosewheel door. Red warning panels over intake and
inboard flap at trailing edge. Serials below wings and on
booms in black. Radome a slightly yellowish grey.

yellow bands around booms and on upper and lower wing surfaces
(see plan view) avoiding flap and air brake surfaces. Serial and all
lettering in black. Red warning markings over intake and inboard flap.
