


Fokker E.V, 157/18 (wk. no. 2824), flown by Jasta 6, at Bernes, August, 1918. Scheme is standard Fokker Dark Olive-Green dope with 4-color Lozenge fabric on appropriate surfaces. Tail is White. Horizontal tail surfaces and wheel hubs must be painted White before applying decals.

Fokker E.V, 132/18 (wk. no. 2773), as flown by No. 1 Squadron, Canadian Air Force as part of Armistice reparations, at Romilles, January, 1919. Scheme is standard Fokker Dark Olive-Green dope with 4-color Lozenge fabric. White band is 140 cm wide and wraps around entire fuselage. Tail and vertical stabilizer are White. See note on wing crosses on next page.
