## RAF ROUNDELS SPITFIRE & HURRICANE

This sheet provides roundels and fin flashes for Spitfires and Hurricanes from the mid-1940 Battle of Britain period through mid-1942. The red centers and yellow roundels are printed separately to allow perfect color registration. Applications are as follows:

- A: Spitfire upper wing Type B 55"
- B: Hurricane upper wing Type B 49"
- C: Lower wing Type A 25"
- D: Lower wing Type A 30"
- E: Lower wing Type A 35"
- F: Lower wing Type A 40"
- G: Lower wing Type A 50"
- H: Lower wing Type A1 50"
- J: Fuselage Type A1 35" (with 5" and 7" center spots)
- K: Fuselage Type A1 49"

Fin flashes are provided in 5", 6", 7", and 9" color widths. Spitfires generally used 5", 6", or 7", while Hurricanes could use any of these, or the 9". Many Hurricanes also used 9" Blue and White bands with the entire forward part of the fin in Red. Sheet C contains B roundels in 40", 35", 25" and 15" should you be modelling a Phoney war A/C.

The Yellow-Green gas detection patches applied to many RAF aircraft during this period are also provided in 18" circular and 18" & 24" square shapes.
