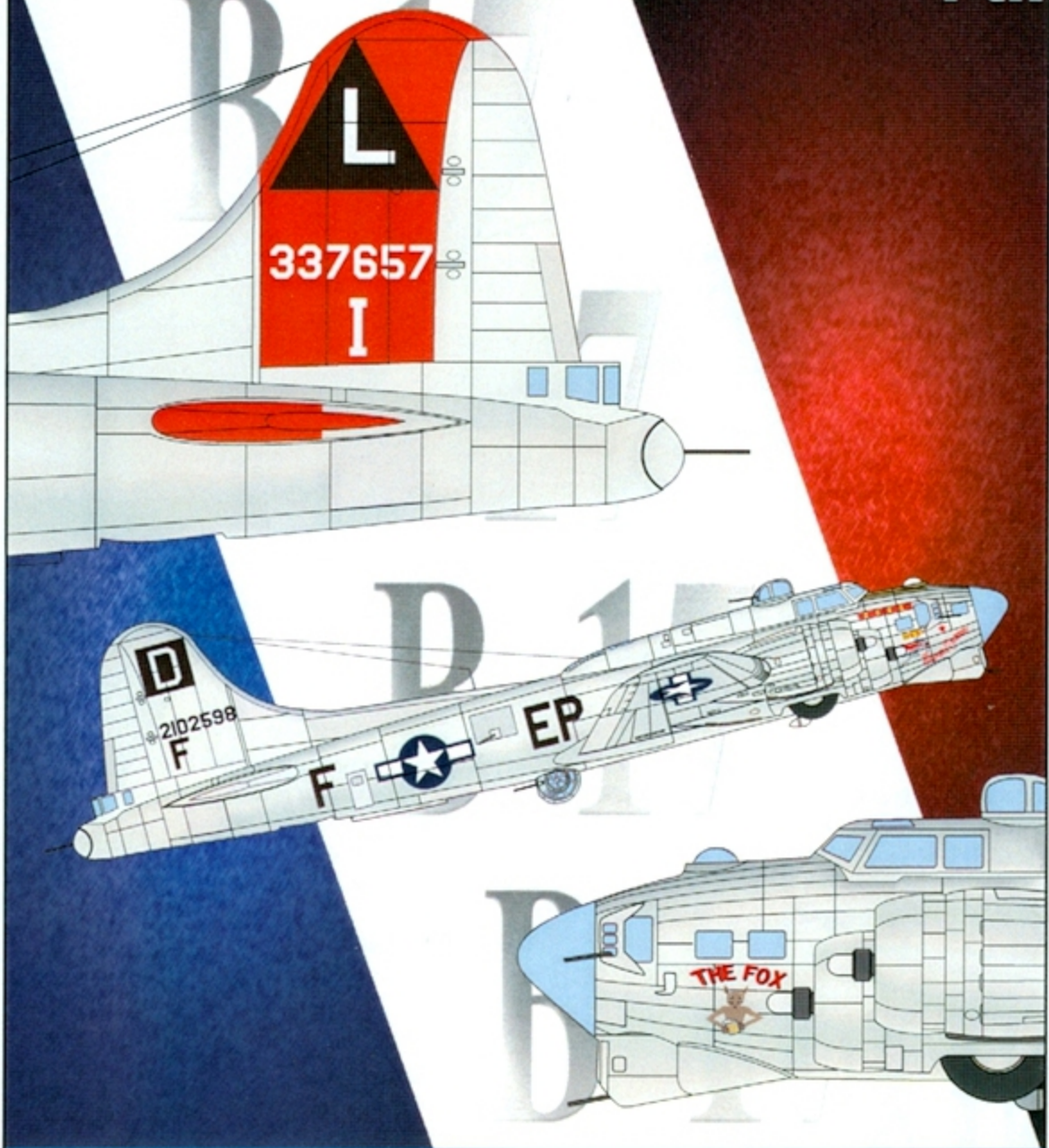

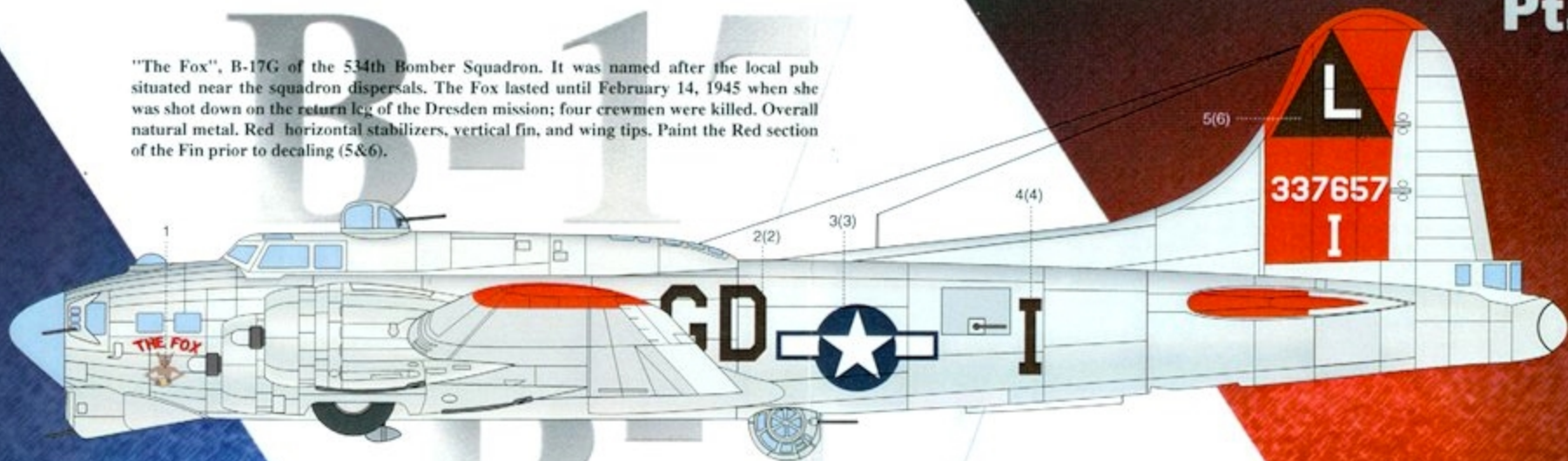

"The Fox", B-17G of the 534th Bomber Squadron. It was named after the local pub situated near the squadron dispersals. The Fox lasted until February 14, 1945 when she was shot down on the return leg of the Dresden mission; four crewmen were killed. Overall natural metal. Red horizontal stabilizers, vertical fin, and wing tips. Paint the Red section of the Fin prior to decaling (5&6).



Note:
Notice the asymmetric positioning of the fuselage codes & insignia due to the staggered waist guns.

"Super Rabbit", B-17G-55-BO flew with 100th Group's 351st Squadron. Overall natural metal with Olive Drab anti-glare panels.
