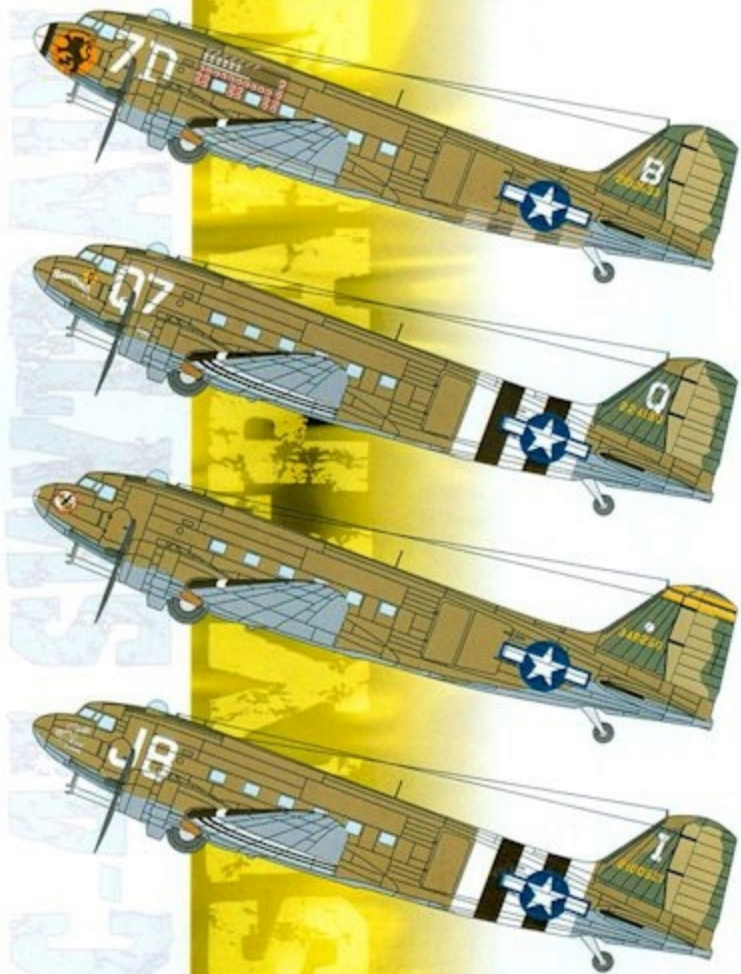

A/C 1

1-C-47A, Honeybun III, a well faded and highly decorated a/c of the 80 TCS/436 TCG, Berkshire, UK, 1945. Notice D-Day bands have been repainted all around and only a light trace remains visible. This a/c went on to serve during the Berlin Airlift. Modelers must paint background for mission tally a darker shade of OD. This model could be a painters delight.

A/C 2

2-C-47A, Sugar Puss, a fully marked bird of the 90TCS/438 TCG from Berkshire, 7 June, 1944. This a/c was severely damaged and saved only by the heroism of the crew, who even spiced severed fuel lines while in flight.!!!!!! This a/c ended its life in Peru after the war.

A/C 3

3-C-47A, very std camouflage applied to this a/c of the 312 FS/327 AT in France, 1945. This a/c was flown by the uncle of our friend Lonnie Berry, Don Berry, who recently passed away in Florida. Our thanks for his service.

A/C 4

4-Another D-Day a/c, this time a C-47A named "Kilroy is Here" from the 92 TCS/439 TCG, at Devon, UK, June 6, 1944. Standard camouflage with full D-Day markings.
