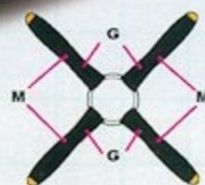

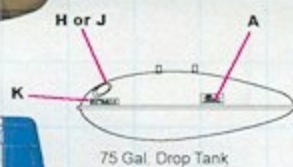


Propeller blades flat black with yellow tips.

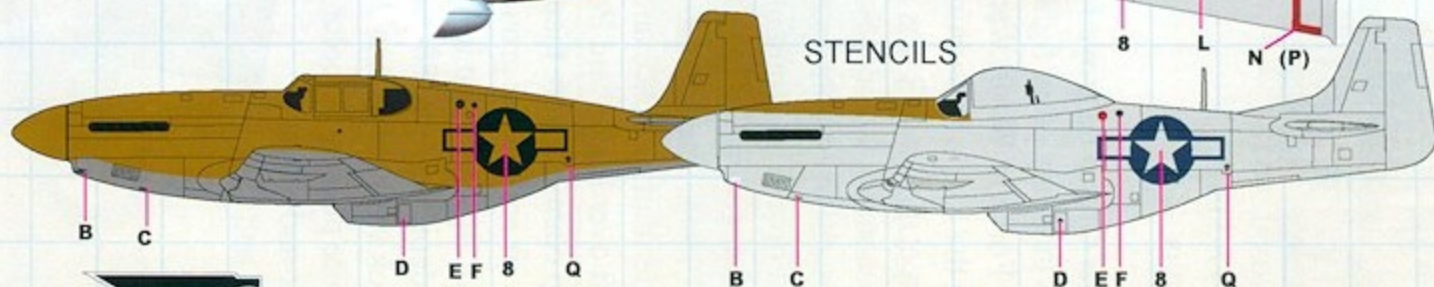
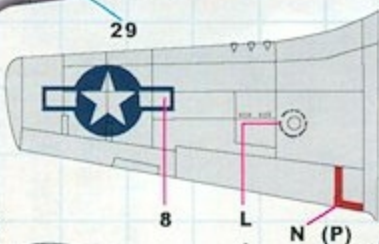
75 Gal. Drop Tank

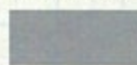

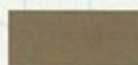

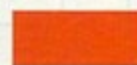
