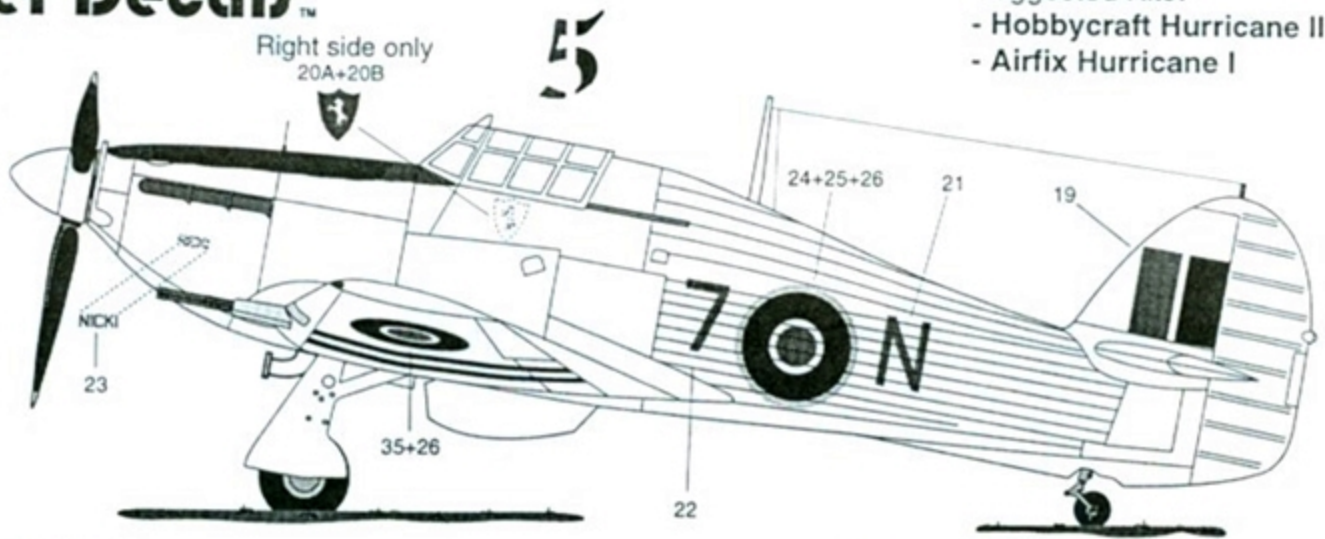

Sea hurricane II C of 835 FAA Sqdn. onboard HMS NAIRANA, while on escort duty on the North Atlantic, 1944. White overall, with Dark Sea Grey/Ocean Grey patches as antiglare panels. Remnants of D-Day stripes only under the wings. Black NICKI and Sqdn. Badge on right side as shown.

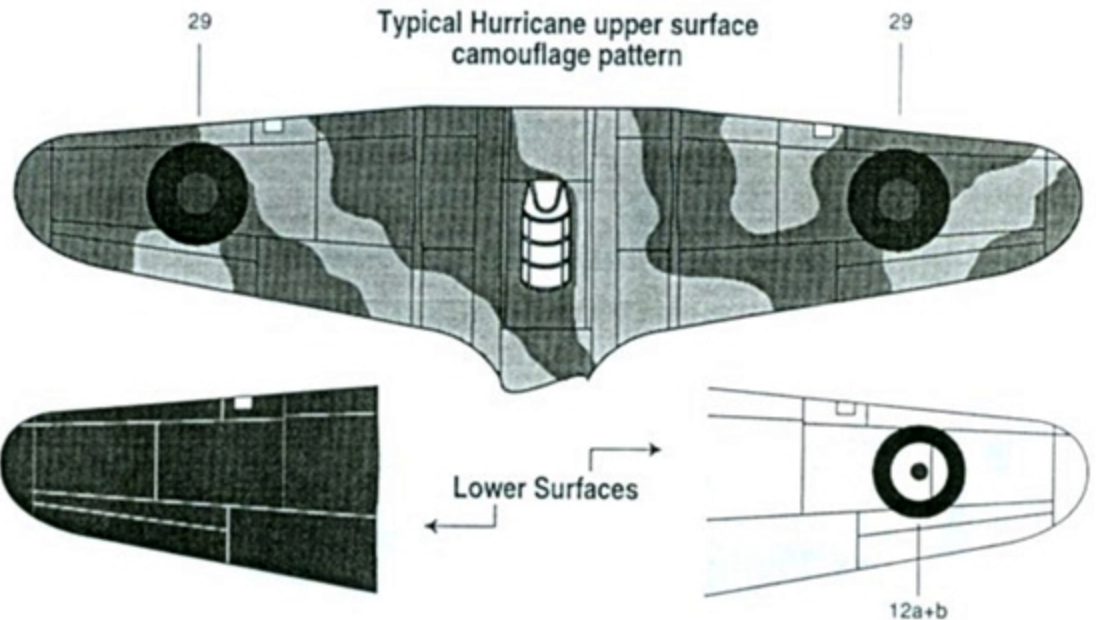


Hurricane Mk I Trop S/N P2638 North Africa Summer of 1941, belonging to 274 Squadron. Standard British desert camouflage of Dark Earth, Middle Stone and Azure Blue. Red spinner. Front nose and leading edges of wings have been repainted with a lighter shade of Sand and Green splotches, to simulate Italian A/C flying head on at low altitude.



Sea hurricane Mk I A, S/N P3090. Lee-On-Solent. Modified A scheme of Dark Slate Gray, Extra dark Sea Grey on Sky. Black spinner. Our sources depict this A/C with Azure Blue under surfaces, but we believe Sky to be more appropriate for the under surface scheme. Please consult the references and arrive at your own conclusions.

Hurricane Mk I S/N 2798 (over painted with black) No.87 Squadron, December 1940, Colerne U.K., flown by Sqdn. Leader Ian R. Glead. Overall Flat Black (night), with Red spinner and nose flash. A/C code "A" on left side seems to have peeled off. Right side unknown.



Hurricane Mk II C, S/N BE500, summer of 1942, Charny Down, U.K. Flown by Sqdn. Leader D. G. Smallwood, 87th Sqdn. Different A/C wearing the same code letters as the above A/C but without the nose flash, or rudder command pennant. Squadron leader Smallwood personal marking under the sliding canopy.
