The P-40M-10-CU (KH-51) was the sole P-40 in service with the Finnish Air Force.



Tomahawk IIB (3817) belonged to the Turkish Air Force. Turkey operated 42 Tomahawk IIBs, the last being retired in 1946.



The Tomahawk IIB belonged to the Royal Egyptian Air Force. The REAF received as many as 24 Tomahawk IIBs.

While 16 should be the orientation of the right side marking, there is a possibility it is identical to the left side and decal 10 should be used



P-40N "White 46" was one of 980 P-40Ns that were shipped to the USSR under Lend-Lease.



The Soviet P-40M was assigned to the 191 IAP.

Please note that the In Action book identifies this as "Silver 23." The Russians did not use silver numbers on combat aircraft. The correct designation was "White 23."
