


Westland built Seafire Mk.III, NN300, D-5 Zero. 807 Squadron, Commander George Baldwin, H.M.S. Hunter, Singapore 1945. Natural metal or Aluminum paint, with Black identification bands on wings and tail. Black anti-glare panel forward of cockpit. Spinner may have been Dark Red or Black. Possibly assisted in damaging a KI-43 over Sumatra, May 16 1945 while flown by S/L. L.E. Gardner.

Seafire Mk.LIII, PR146. Escadrille 54, de l'Aeronautique Navale, Carrier 'Arromanches', Indochina 1948. Still wearing RAF serial number. Upper wing, tail surfaces, and top fuselage Extra Dark Sea Gray. Lower wing and tail surfaces, main fuselage and spinner, Sky.







Seafire Mk.III, PX932. Escadrille 1.F. de l'Aeronautique Navale, Carrier 'Arromanches', Indochina 1948-49. Red spinner. Still retains standard F.A.A. wartime camouflage.

Seafire Mk.IIc, code believed to be C-A or S-A. Flown by Major Al Wright, 809 Squadron, HMS Stalker or H.M.S. Unicorn, Italy 1943. A/C possibly participated in "Operation Avalanche". Squadron codes could have been Insignia Red or Sky. We believe Red is the better choice. Both options supplied. If you prefer the Sky version, cut off the Red from the roundel. Standard F.A.A. wartime camouflage. Black or Red spinner. Only Seafire known to us to have worn a shark mouth.
