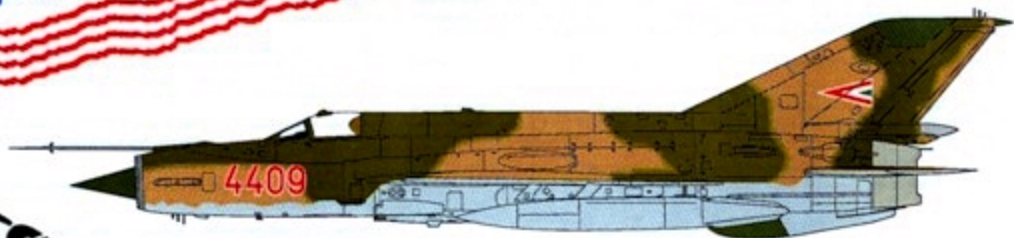

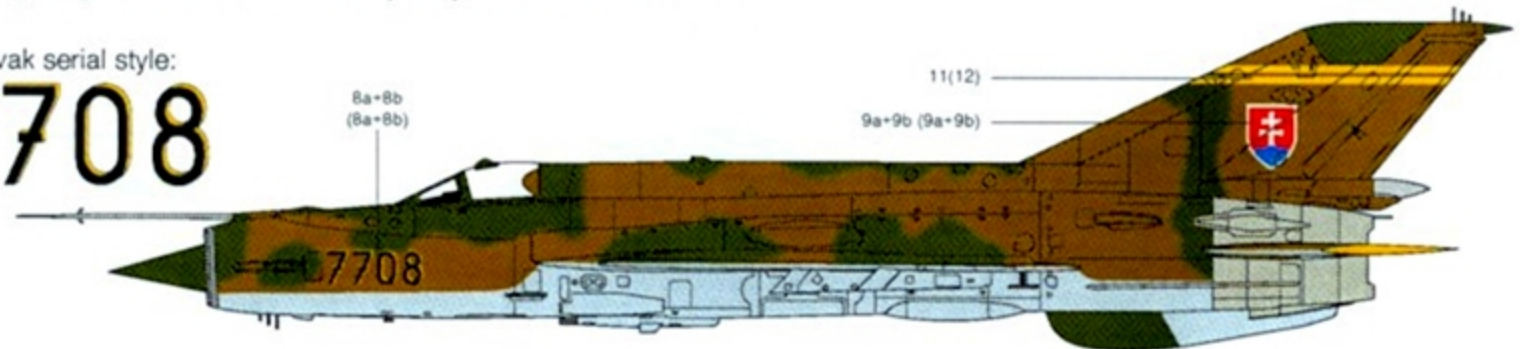


MiG-21's: New World Fishbeds



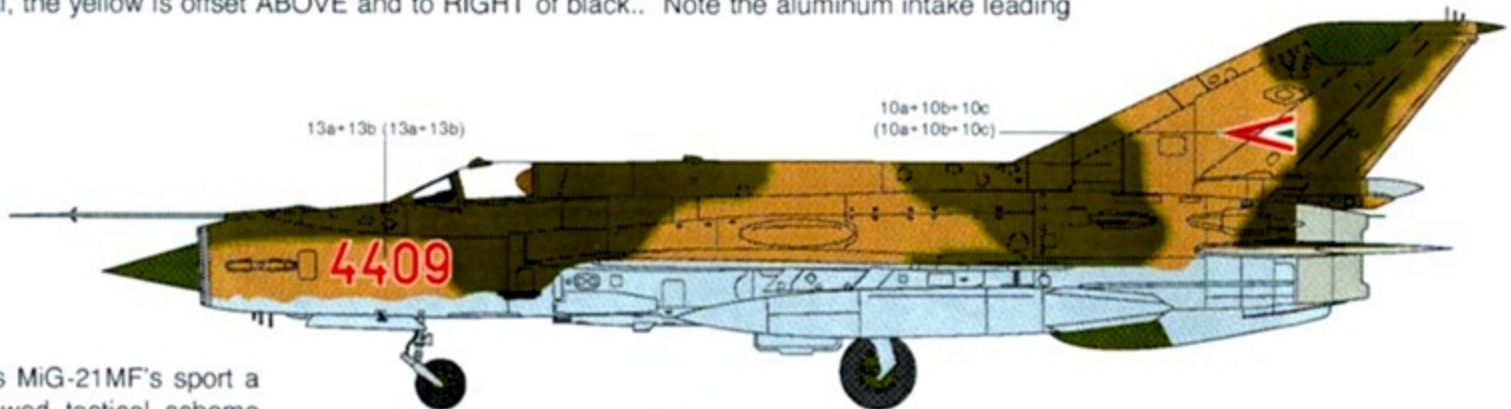

A/C #1

When photographed in late 1994, this Slovakian MiG-21MF wore the standard Czech tactical scheme of dark green and mid-brown over light gray — as well as standard detail coloring. For the nose serial, the yellow is offset ABOVE and to RIGHT of black.. Note the aluminum intake leading edge.



A/C #2

Hungary's MiG-21MF's sport a home-brewed tactical scheme of dark green and tan over pale blue-gray. Standard detail colors and aluminum intake rings.

A/C #3

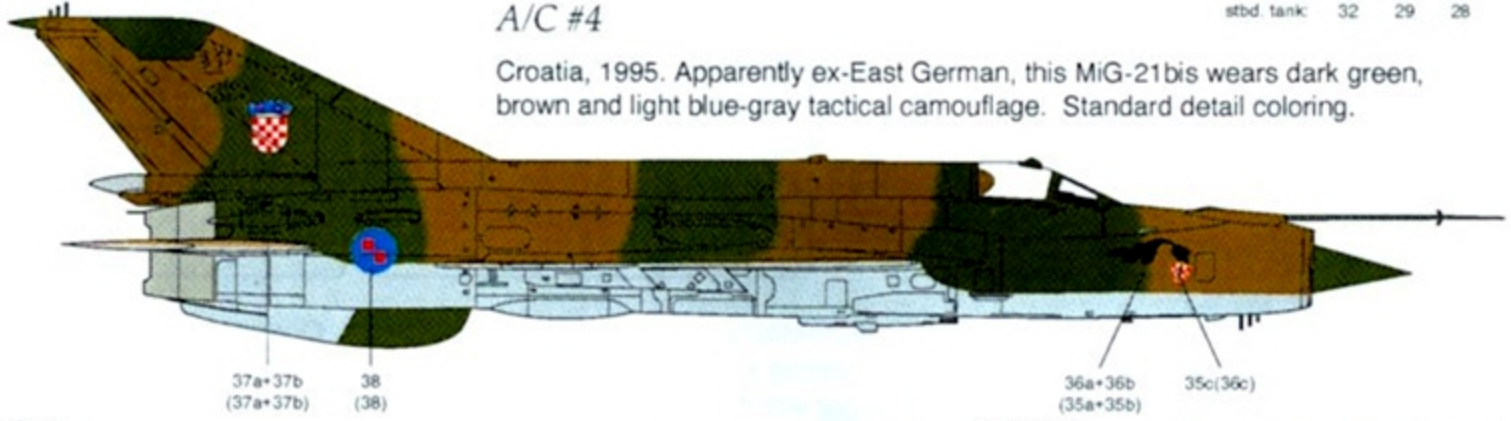
Commemorating the disbandment of JG1 in Dec. 1990, this unified German MiG-21MF's (ex- "Red 510") wore the old East zone tactical scheme of dark green and brown over light blue-gray. Standard detail coloring and dark green wheel hubs.

A/C #4

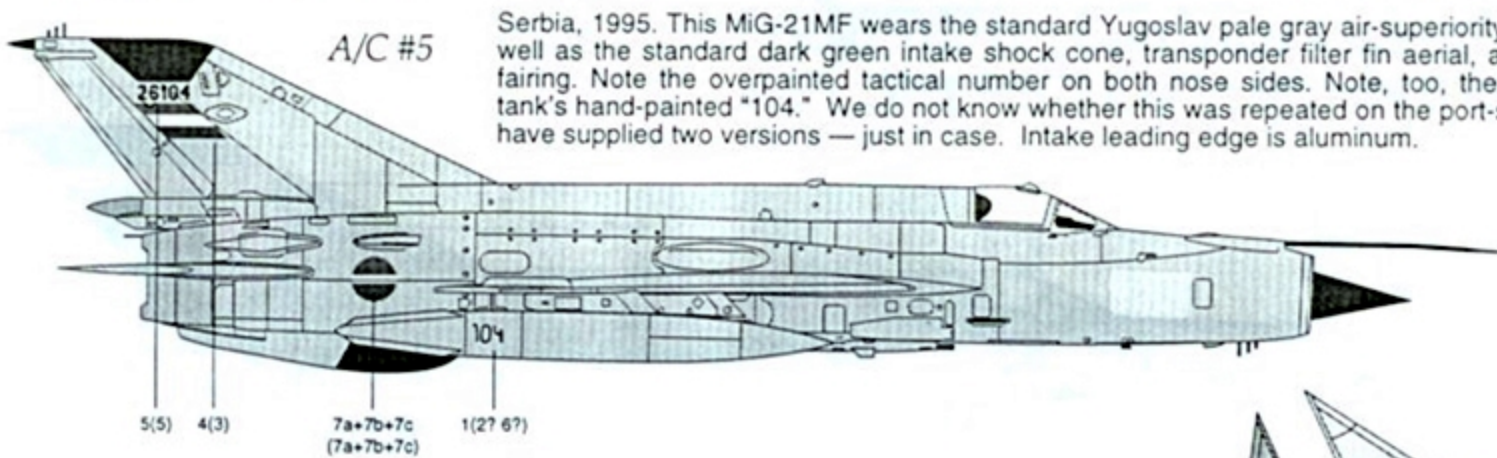
Croatia, 1995. Apparently ex-East German, this MiG-21bis wears dark green, brown and light blue-gray tactical camouflage. Standard detail coloring.



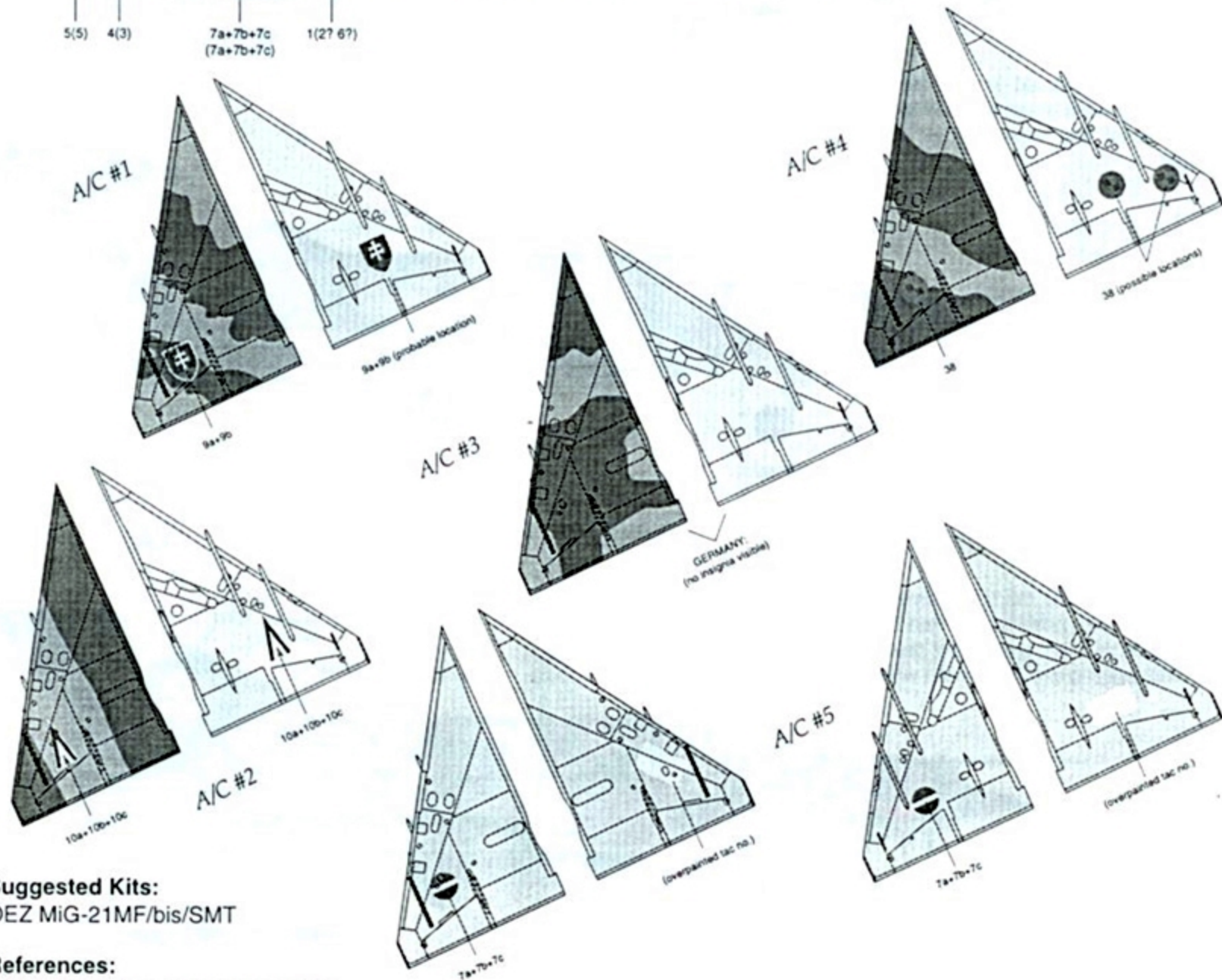

Serbia, 1995. This MiG-21MF wears the standard Yugoslav pale gray air-superiority camouflage as well as the standard dark green intake shock cone, transponder filter fin aerial, and dielectric fin fairing. Note the overpainted tactical number on both nose sides. Note, too, the starboard drop tank's hand-painted "104." We do not know whether this was repeated on the port-side tank, so we have supplied two versions — just in case. Intake leading edge is aluminum.
