**1** P-47D-22-RE 42-26250 Turtle No. 9 assigned to the 509th FS, 405th FG, 9th AF. Based at St. Dizier, France in the Winter of 1944. Pilot unknown. Natural Metal Finish with Dark Olive antiglare panel. Red cowl band, canopy frames and tail stripes identified the 509th FS. Codes on right side read G • G9. Note Malcolm hood and Hamilton Standard prop. Notice uncommon demarcation line on cowling colors.

P-47D-30-RA 44-20566 of the 356th FS, 354th FG, 9th AF in November, 1944. Based at Rosières-en-Haye, France. Pilot unknown. Natural Metal Finish with Dark Olive antiglare panel. Black ETO ID stripes on tail surfaces. White forward cowl with Blue band and White stars identified the 356th FS. Codes on right side read D • AJ. 13-foot diameter Curtiss Electric prop. **2**

**3** P-47D-22-RE 42-20641 Doogan assigned to the 22nd FS, 36th FG, 9th AF and based at LeCulot, Belgium in December, 1944. Pilot unknown. Natural Metal Finish with Dark Olive antiglare panel. Stars and Bars under both wings. Fuselage invasion stripes only. Black ETO ID stripes on tail surfaces. The Yellow rudder identified the 36th FG; the Red nose the 22nd FS. Canopy frames in OD, possibly Red. Red and White candy-striped antenna mast. Codes on right side read A • 3T. Hamilton Standard prop.

P-47D-30-RA 44-33183 Jammer Janie flown by Lt. John A. Russborn of the 81st FS, 50th FG, 9th AF. Based at Giebelstadt, Germany in April of 1945. Natural Metal Finish with Dark Olive anti-glare panel. Stars and Bars carried under both wings. 50th FG Red cowl front and tail stripes; no distinctive squadron markings. Codes on right side read R • 2N. 13-foot diameter Curtiss Electric prop. **4**

**J** P-47D-26-RA 42-28368 Margie Mc flown by Lt. Monty Davis, 405th FS, 371st FG, 9th AF. Metz, France, February 1945. Natural Metal Finish with Dark Olive antiglare panel. Fuselage invasion stripes only. Black ETO ID stripes on tail surfaces. Blue prop hub and cowl identified the 405th FS. Codes on right side read K • 8N. Note oversized fuselage star. 13-foot diameter Curtiss Electric prop.
