

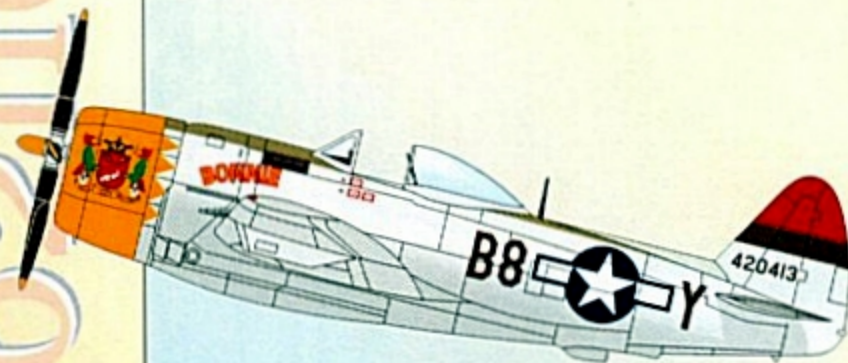
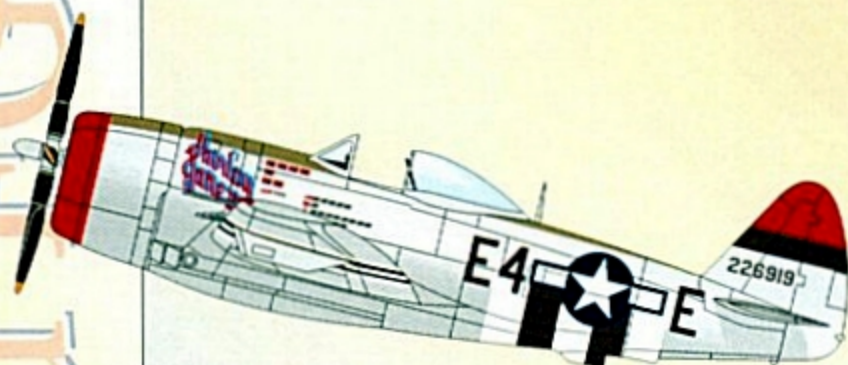
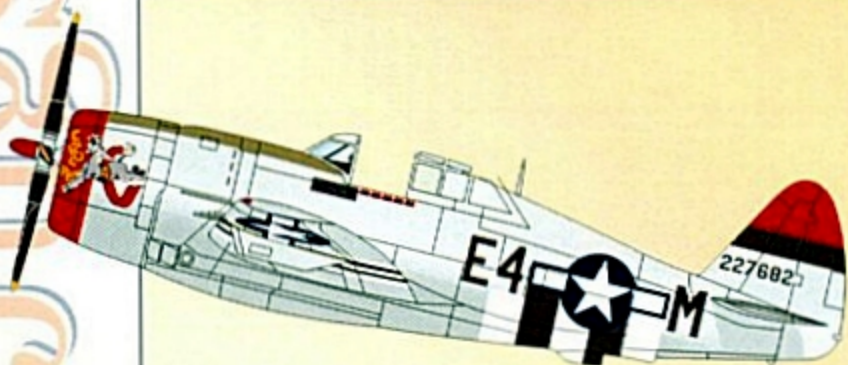

horizontal tail surfaces. Red fin cap,
nose band, and prop hub. Early 12"
Curtiss Electric prop. Note near
view mirror.

Locale & Date Remen, France (A-27), August 1944.

Camouflage & Markings Natural Metal overall with Olive
Drab anti-glare paint. D-Day stripes
on lower fuselage and under wings.
Black ETO ID bands on vertical and
horizontal tail surfaces. Black ETO
ID bands on vertical and horizontal
tail surfaces. Red nose band and tip
of vertical tail. 13" Curtiss Electric
Asymmetric prop.

Locale & Date Kayres, France (A-82) in early 1945.

Camouflage & Markings Natural Metal overall with Olive
Drab anti-glare paint. Black ETO ID
bands on vertical and horizontal tail
surfaces. Yellow cow flaps, prop hub, and
diamonds on cow flaps. Wheel hubs
may have also been yellow. Tip of
vertical tail painted red. Note
painted swastikas. Note dorsal fin.
13" Curtiss Electric Asymmetric prop.
