As an option for the TC tail code, first paint the upper section of the vertical fin/rudder Tan. Using the provided TC template (make sure to cut outside the shaded area), transfer the code to masking tape, cut them off and place them where you want your black letters to go. Apply the camouflage as usual. Remove the tape and apply the black decal codes.







Notice the extra amount of antennas and beacons that these a/c carried. We have tried to be as accurate as possible while depicting size, shape, position.
