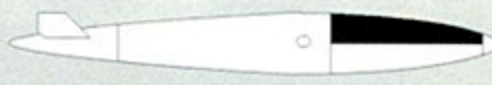
A/C 1: A1-H Flown by L. CDR. H.G. Zimmerman off the USS Intrepid. VA-176 L.CDR. Zimmerman scored a MiG 17 Kill while flying this A/C during a Rescap mission for a downed flyer, on Sept 10, 1966. Lt. Gull Gray over Gloss White with Flat Black prop hub, antiglare panel and wing walks. Polished metal cowl lip, and corrugard (Dk. Steel color) wing leading edge. Front prop tips White/Red/White, rear blades are Yellow.

A/C 2: Another MiG 17 killer, this time from VA-25 flying off the U.S.S. Midway on 6/20/65. A/C flown by Lt. J.G. Andy Hingsberger and Lt. Clint Johnson. Sorry, but we do not know which pilot was flying the A/C at the time of the encounter. Colors as per A/C 1. Fin tip is Black.

A/C 3: A1-H "SPAD DAD" of 6th S.O.S. Detachment at F.O.L. Alpha Alpha (DA NANG), Vietnam. Flown by Col. Sam Berman, C.O. of 633rd S.O.W., March 1970. A/C wears S.E.A. four tone camouflage with Gloss White Blue and Red fin/Rudder markings. Flat Black prop hub & blades. Notice different antenna set up and fin beacon. Front of cowl and cowl flaps seem to be badly chipped.



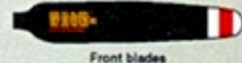
