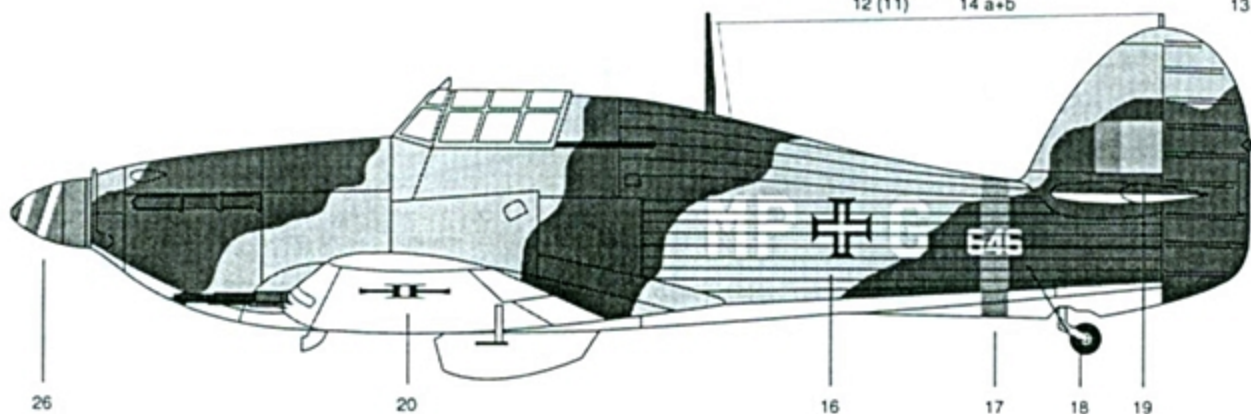
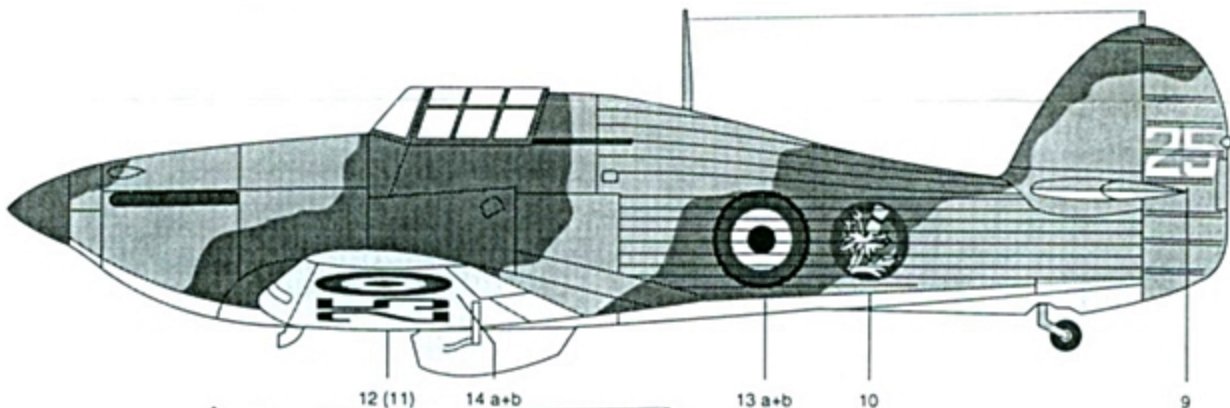

Sea Hurricane IIb, JS327, Operated by the Royal Navy with U.S. national insignias for Operation Torch, November, 1942. Extra Dark Sea Grey, Dark Slate Grey and Sky camouflage. Note overpainted British fin flash and dark and light camouflage colors reversed.



Hurricane IIb, BG707, Free French forces attached to the RAF, North Africa, 1942. RAF Dark Green, Dark Earth and Azure Blue camouflage. Large area of fuselage and vertical tail overpainted with Mid Stone. Spinner black. 49" Type B roundels on upper wing and 50" Type A on lower wing available on AeroMaster Sheet 48-026.

Hurricane I, H-25 of Escadrille 2, Belgian Air Force, 1940. RAF Dark Green and Dark Earth camouflage with silver painted lower surfaces. Note early pointed spinner.



Hurricane IIc, 646, Esquadilha MP, Portuguese Air Force, 1949. Dark Green, Ocean Grey and Medium Sea Grey camouflage. Spinner is green (match decal stripe). Fin flash has green forward. Camouflage colors reversed.

Hurricane IIc, 2013, Advanced Group, Persian Flying Training School, 1947. Dark Earth and Mid Stone upper surfaces with blue (possibly Azure) lower surfaces. Note reversed camouflage colors and also that 20mm cannons are not fitted.
