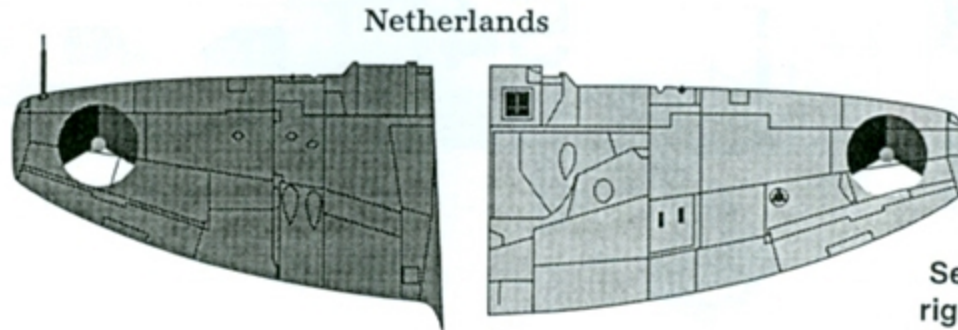

- 1** Sea Fury FB. 11, No. 541, Fuerza Aerea del Ejercito de Cuba (Cuban Army Air Force), Base Militar Columbia, La Habana, Cuba, 1957. Overall natural metal with black anti-glare panel. Forward cowl ring and spinner yellow. Tail hook was removed while in service.



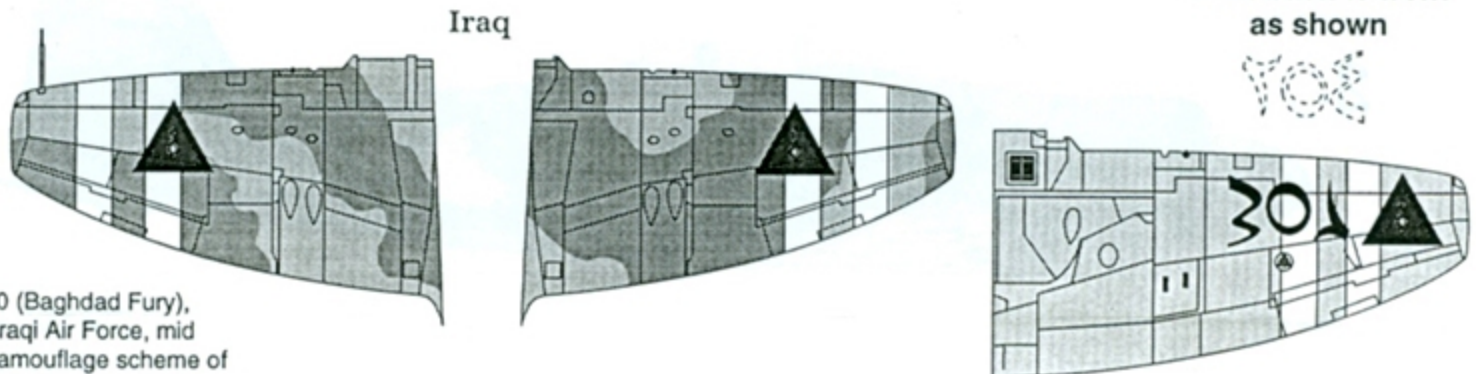
- 2** Sea Fury FB. 51, No. 10-2, No. 860 Squadron, Royal Netherlands Navy, 1950. Extra Dark Sea Grey with Light Gray (exact shade unknown) lower surfaces and spinner.



Serial on lower right wing reads from back to front as shown



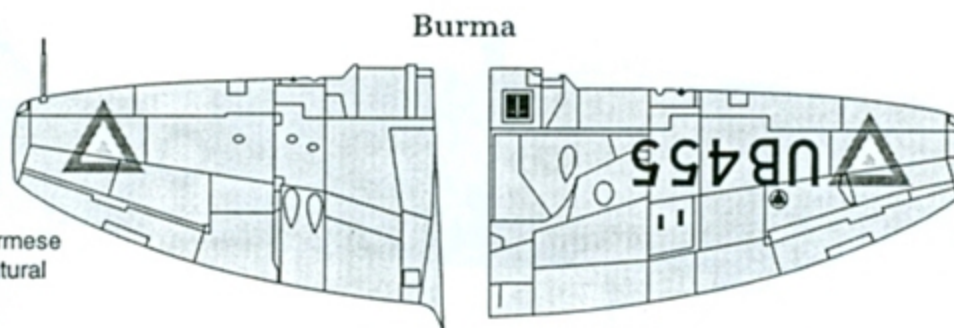
- 3** Sea Fury Mk. 60 (Baghdad Fury), No.254, Royal Iraqi Air Force, mid 1950s. British camouflage scheme of Dark Earth and Mid Stone, with Azure Blue lower surfaces and spinner. Note lack of tail hook and extended rudder unique to the Mk. 60.
