1 P-40K flown by Maj. Edward M. Nollmeyer, commander of the 26th F.S, 51st F.G. in Karachi, India. Earth and Green 42 over Lt. Gray.

2 P-40E flown by Capt. William J. Hennon of the 7th F.S., 49th F.G. References show this Warhawk to be painted Medium Green over Neutral Gray.

3 P-36A was flown by 2nd Lt. Harry Brown, 47th P.S. Brown was able to get airborne over Pearl Harbor on December 7th, 1941 and shot down 2 Kate bombers. This P-36 carried the standard O.D. and Neutral Gray colors. Although not an Ace, but scoring two of the earliest USAAC victories, Lt. Brown must be included in this series of Curtiss Aces.

4 P-40E flown by Lt. Bill Day of the 49th F.G. The standard O.D. and Neutral Gray camouflage appears to have been overpainted in the field with a sand color.
