CANTEEN VEHICLE MARKINGS.

This sheet of transfers provides markings for the various types of canteen vehicles operated by the NAAFI, YMCA, CHURCH ARMY & SALVATION ARMY in support of British and Allied forces in the UK and British and Commonwealth forces around the world. As well as providing support throughout World War 2, these organisations continued to provide canteen refreshment vehicles for the military well into the 1980's

I well remember being in Germany on exercise in the late 1960's and following a night-time tactical move to a new location not knowing exactly where we were. The first vehicle to arrive that morning at 1000hrs was a Church Army canteen van who had know 2 weeks before where we were going to be.

There are no specific instructions as to the location of the markings on vehicles as the vehicle types used were so numerous and these organisations, unlike the military, had no laid down guidelines. As always, reference to photos of a specific vehicle will be helpful.

To apply the transfers, cut around the required pieces, immerse in lukewarm water for a few sections then apply to the required position on the model. Remove the excess water with a tissue.
