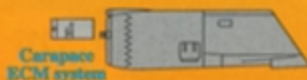

Decals 1 and 6 have an extra border, which needs to be folded around the leading edge before placing decals 2 and 7. For best results place the additional strips (*b) under these tail decals, covering the tail base cut below the rudder.

All Belgian F-16As are equipped with an extended tail housing. This is not to store a parachute (like the Netherlands and Norway), but is used to hold the Carapace ECM system.

Note about the different radome colours:
 All F-16s have radome with a special rubber-paint coating that easily absorbs dirt from the (polluted) air. Their colour varies from Medium Grey (when they are new) to Dark Grey (when they get old and 'dirty').

FA-106 has also a browner front canopy than FA-94
 Check pictures at www.airliners.net (also for the 'right' mix of the radome's grey).

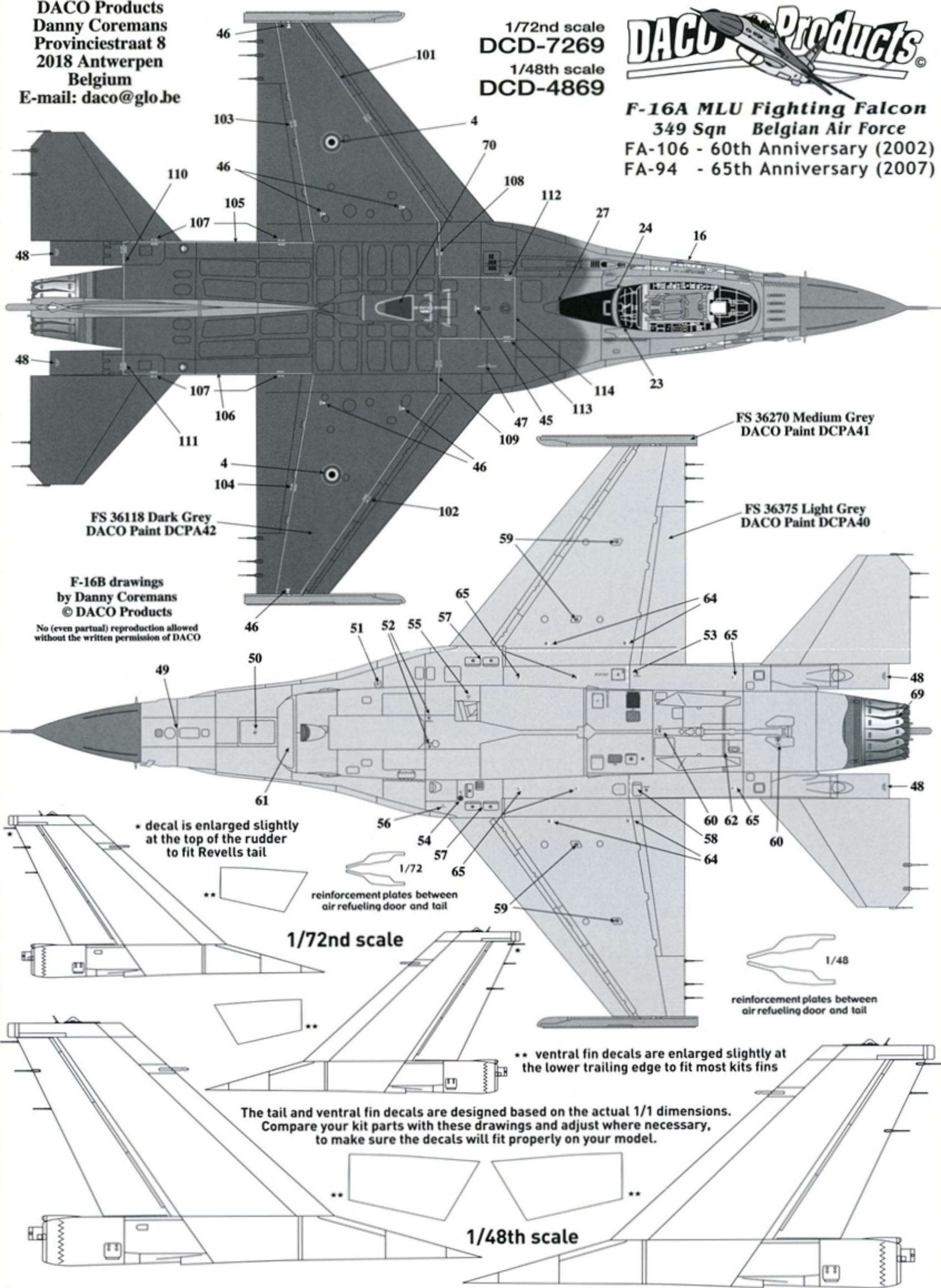
