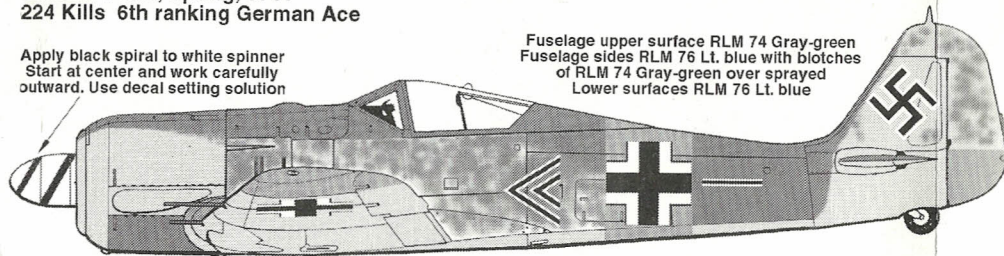

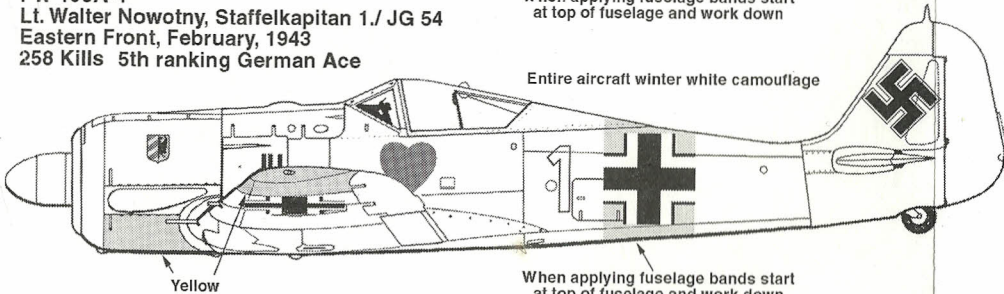
Apply black spiral to white spinner

Lower cowl RLM 70 Black-green Wing tip, fuselage band and lower portion of rudder RLM 04 yellow

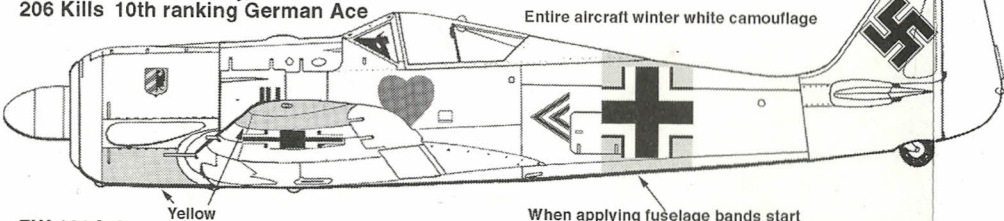

 206 Kills 10th ranking German Ace

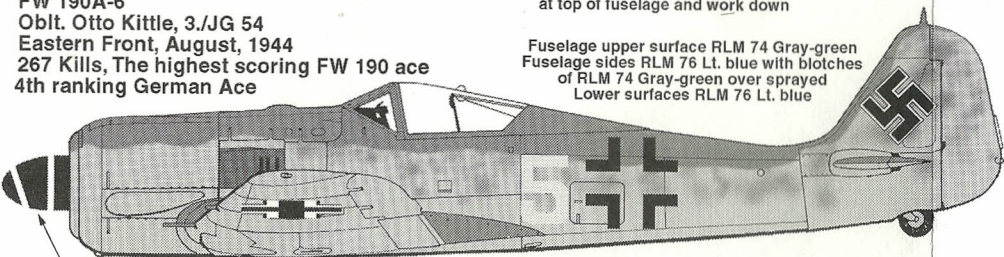
Entire aircraft winter white camouflage

 at top of fuselage and work down

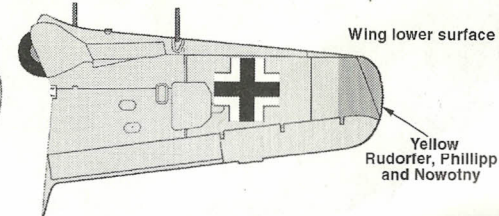
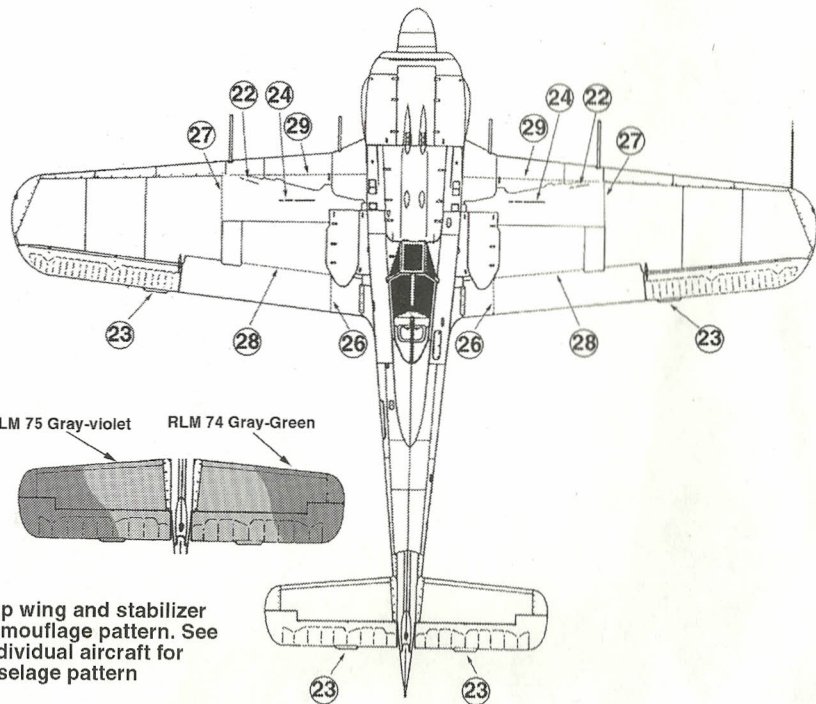
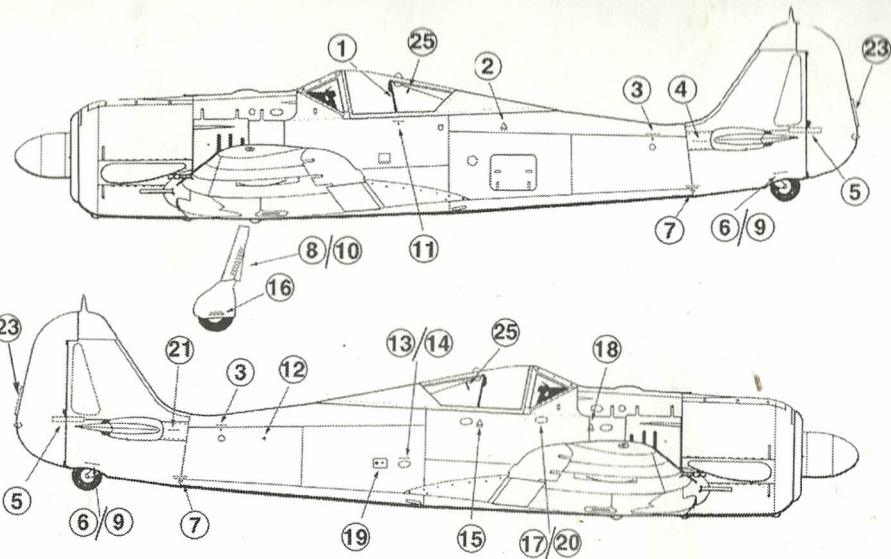
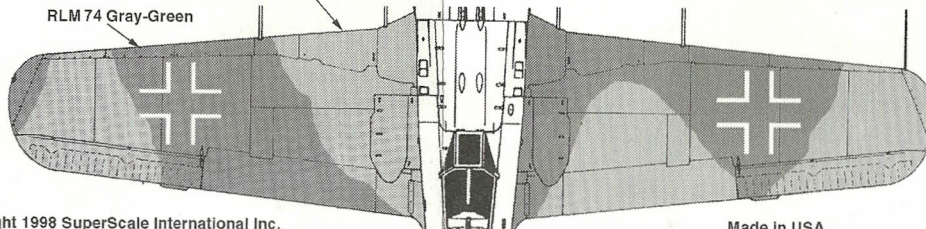
Fuselage upper surface RLM 74 Gray-green

 Lower surfaces RLM 76 Lt. blue



Apply white spiral to black spinner.

 outward. Use decal setting solution.
