



J 29F, 29672, blue Cesar F4 Frösön/Östersund. The a/c still had the former users badge on the nose, (yellow P at third squadron, F9).








Saab J 29E/F Tunnan


J 29 E & F Information

The J 29 Tunnan went through a couple of modifications over the years and the last two stages included modified outer section of the wing, -the E modification and upgraded engine, -the F modification. For many/some aircraft these two stages were covered at one major overhaul. The introduction of the "dog tooth" on the wing prevented side way air flow and improved handeling caracteristics in low speed. The leading edge was extended and the slat was removed. The installation of the afterburner to the RM2 (license built deHavilland Ghost) gave a major effect and thrust contribution. However, on the outside this also lead to a wider and slightly extended engine section on the F model.

J 29 E/F Tunnan was mostly seen in a bare metal scheme with nose band painted in the squadron colour. Black bands around the fuselage and the wings was widly used as excercise markings. It was less common to paint the vertical stabilizer and wing tips (Swe AF Olive Green 325) at the fighter wings.
