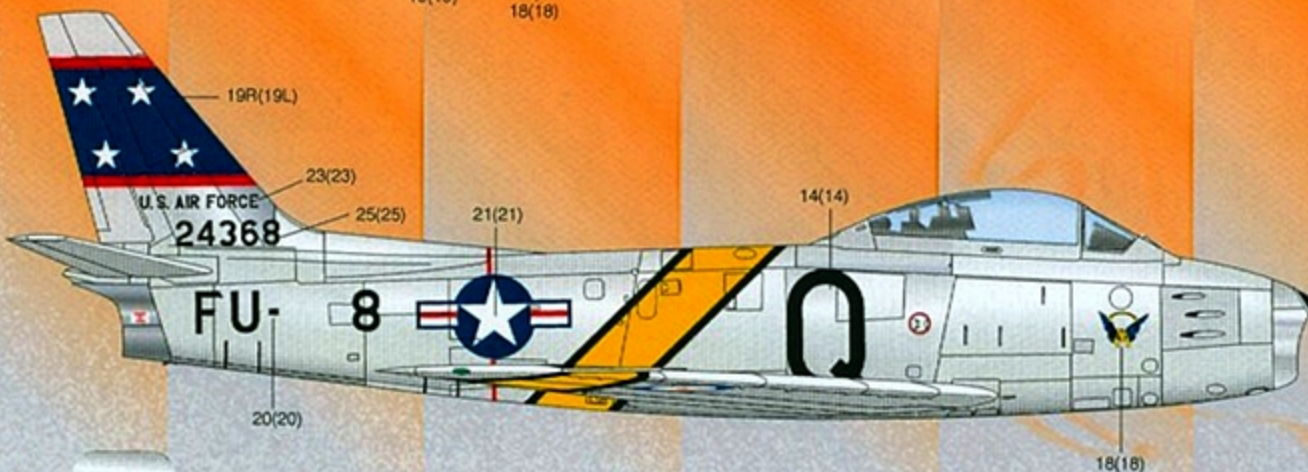
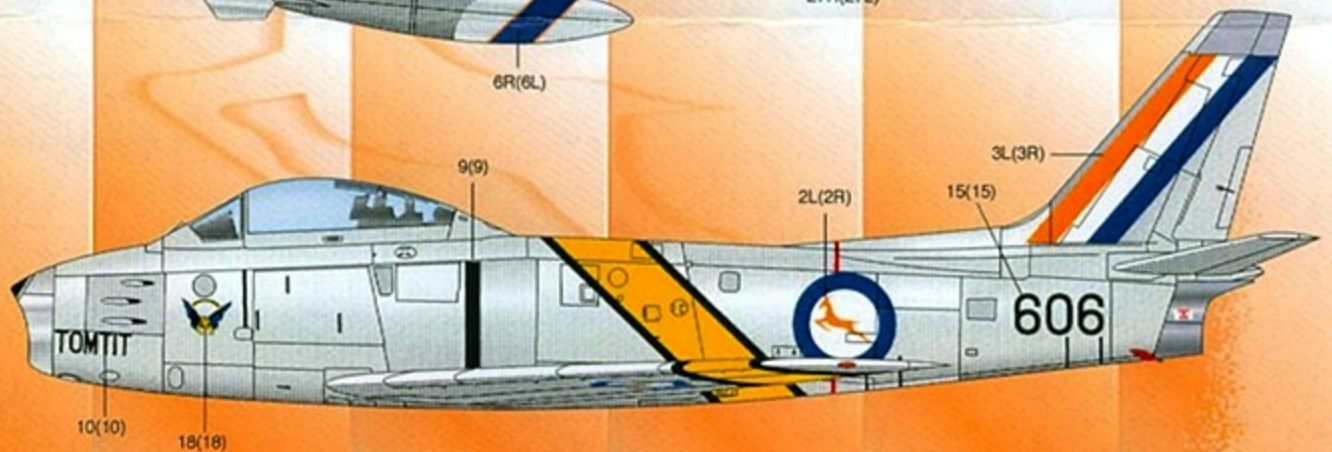


Canadair Sabre Mk.F6,

Nose caps

The fibreglass nose antenna fairing was usually painted Black or occasionally left unpainted. We therefore advise you to check your references regarding the colour.

Tail fin tips

The tailfin tips were usually painted Gray but on some F-86's they were Black or occasionally a lighter Gray. Again we advise you to check your references regarding the colour.
