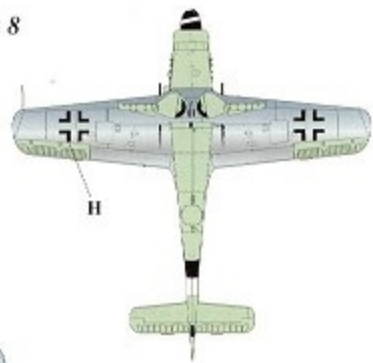




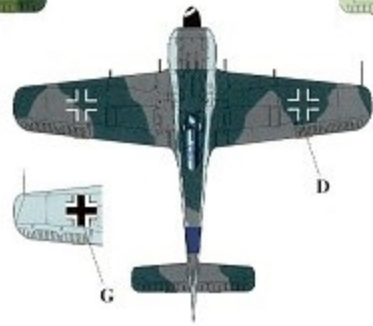
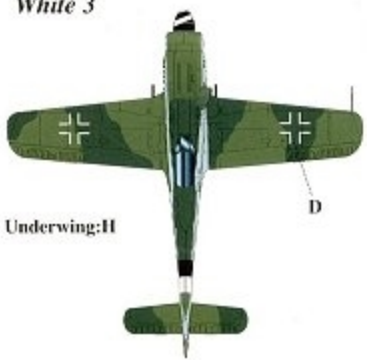
Scrap view of GG



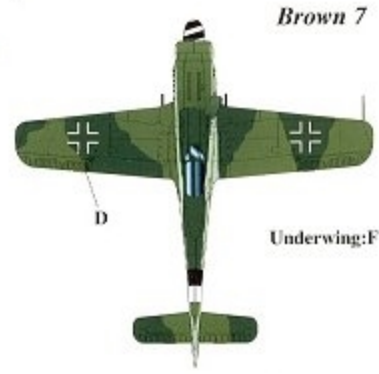

**"Yellow 2" Fw 190 A-8/R 2**    W. Nr. not known    Pilot: unknown    9/JG 54 (III. Gruppe)    May 1944    Blesheim Germany

Heavily chipped paint; A-7 type Pitot tube, pieced together cowling.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 74 Gray Green, Heavy Mottling 75/74.

Spinner: Black/White spiral    Prop Blades: 70 Black Green    RVD band: 24 Blue

III. Gruppe Vertical Bar & '2' appear to be Pale Yellow

III. Gruppe Emblem inset in JG 54 Green Hearts Emblem (both sides) slightly tilted in Green Heart

**National Markings:** Fuselage; 800 mm Black/White crosses

Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - 900 mm Black/White/Black crosses

**Stencilling:** Standard factory. Drop tank full stencilling.

**"White 3" Fw 190 D-9**    W. Nr. 500572    Pilot: unknown    5/JG 26 (II. Gruppe)    5 May 1945    Logumkloster Denmark

Unusual W. Nr. placement. Forced landing on 5 May 1945.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 82 Bright Green, 83 Dark Green, Rudder & fin extension piece overpainted 82 Bright Green

Spinner: Black/White spiral    Electrical plug: Red    RVD bands: Black/White with unusual White vertical stripe

**National Markings:** Fuselage; B4 800 mm Black crosses, Hakenkreuz 420 mm

Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B4 900 mm Black crosses or possibly B16 900 mm Black crosses

**Stencilling:** Minimal: visible is rear portion of Red dash rudder lock.

**"Brown 7" Fw 190 D-9**    W. Nr. 601445    Pilot: unknown    7/JG 26 (II. Gruppe)    5 May 1945    Lister Norway

No loop antenna.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces, Green-Blue, Rudder appears to be Light blue. Uppersurfaces, 82 Bright Green, 83 Dark Green, Heavily mottled 82/83.

Spinner: Black/White spiral typical 7. Staffel    Prop blades: 70 Black Green    RVD bands: Black/White

Electrical plug: Red    Bare metal around flare hole    ETC 504: Dark Gray

**National Markings:** Fuselage; typical 600 & 601 series, small 600 mm crosses, Hakenkreuz H3 420 mm

Wings: Upper - 910 mm White crosses, Lower - 900 mm solid Black crosses

**Stencilling:** Most stencilling overpainted

**"Black 8" Fw 190 D-9**    W. Nr. 210968    Pilot: Uffz. Karl Fröb    2/JG 26 (I. Gruppe)    17 April 1945    Schwerin Lake Germany

Early canopy, closed fuselage jack hole, white wall tail wheel, small bulge on gun cowl.

**Colors:** Undersurfaces, Green-Blue, Wing partially natural metal, gear door, aileron: Green-blue. Uppersurfaces, 82 Bright Green, 83 Dark Green, mottling 82/83. No 81 Brown Violet found.

Spinner: Black/White spiral    Prop blades: 70 Black Green    RVD bands: Black/White    Latch buttons: Red

"Black 8" unusual, probably hand brushed    Exhaust panel: Black    Landing gear legs: Light Gray

Machine excavated November 1990 - color markings well preserved.

**National Markings:** Fuselage; B4 800 mm Black crosses, Hakenkreuz H3 420 mm

Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B4 900 mm Black crosses

**Stencilling:** Some stencilling standard. Oil servicing data on motor cowling mostly Red hand brushed.
