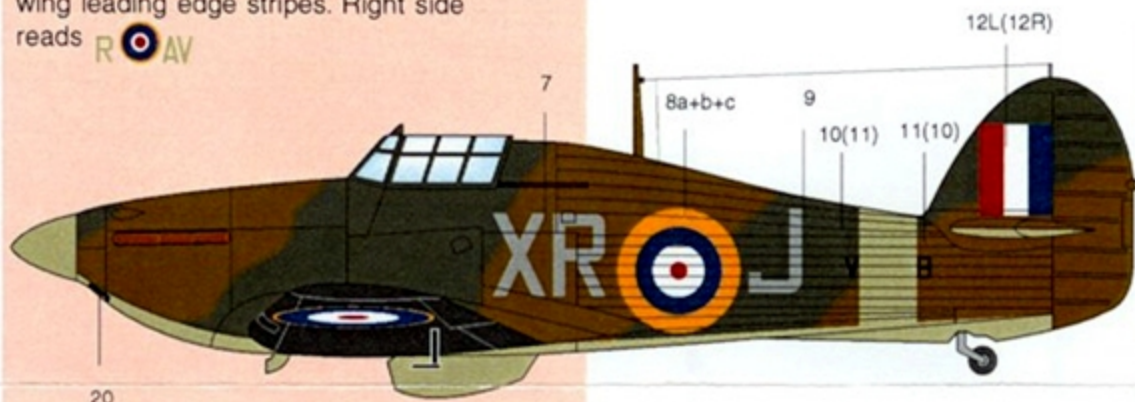


121 Eagle Squadron Spitfire VB SN BM 590, 1941-42. Note non standard roundel and fin flash! We have a side picture showing a non standard roundel and fin flash, but we cannot see the bottom wing roundel, therefore we are supplying you both regular and abnormal center dots for wing. Our choice would be the non standard one! But the ultimate decision is yours. Ocean Gray/Dk. Green/Med Sea Gray with Sky spinner and fuselage band. Yellow ID wing leading edge stripes. Right side reads **R**  **AV**




71 Eagle Squadron Hurricane IA S/N V7608, Summer 1941, Kirton-on-Lindsay. Note Black on Sky and Sky on Black stripes on wheel doors. Fuselage band covers the serial number. Right side reads **XR**  **J**

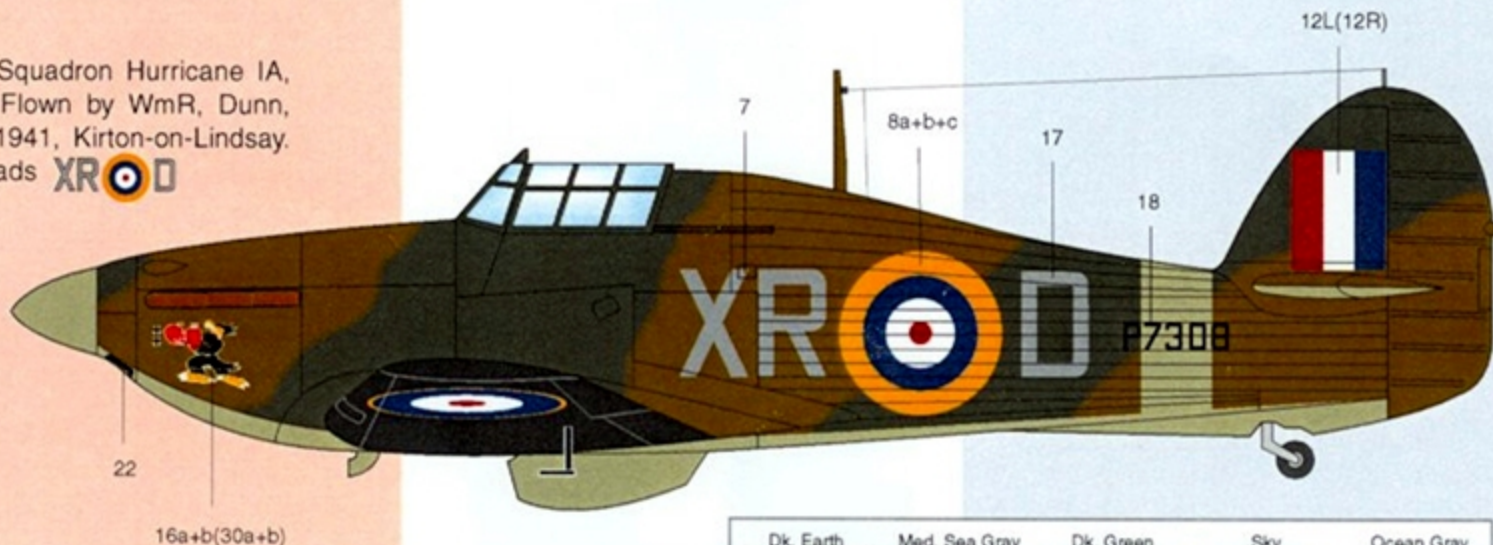


All these Hurricane were camouflaged: Dk. Green / Dk. Earth with Sky lower surfaces and 18" Sky band. Left wing bottom was Black to the center line of the A/C. It is very important to properly measure the band to 18 inches when painting it and to position it in the proper place, otherwise the right side codes will not fit. See other page for instructions.
