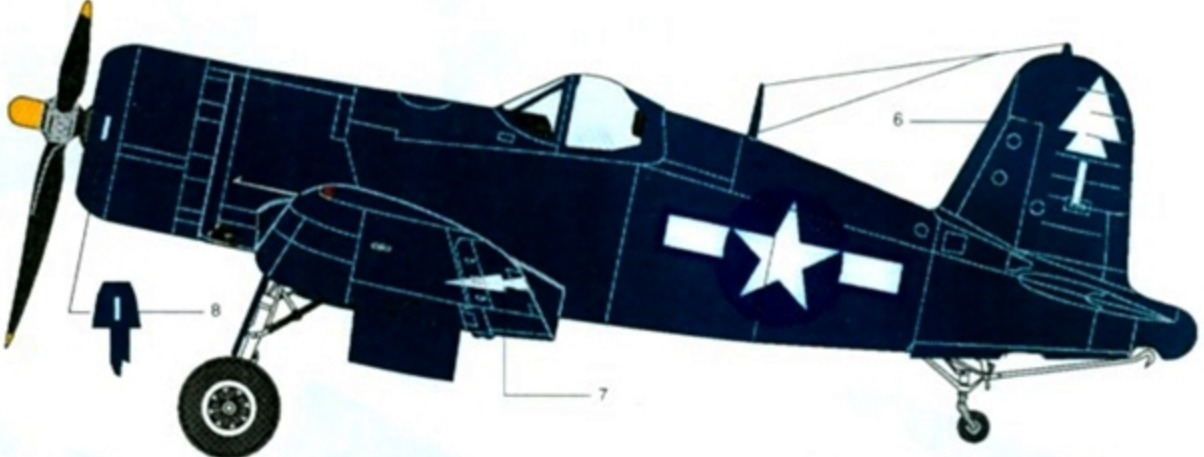

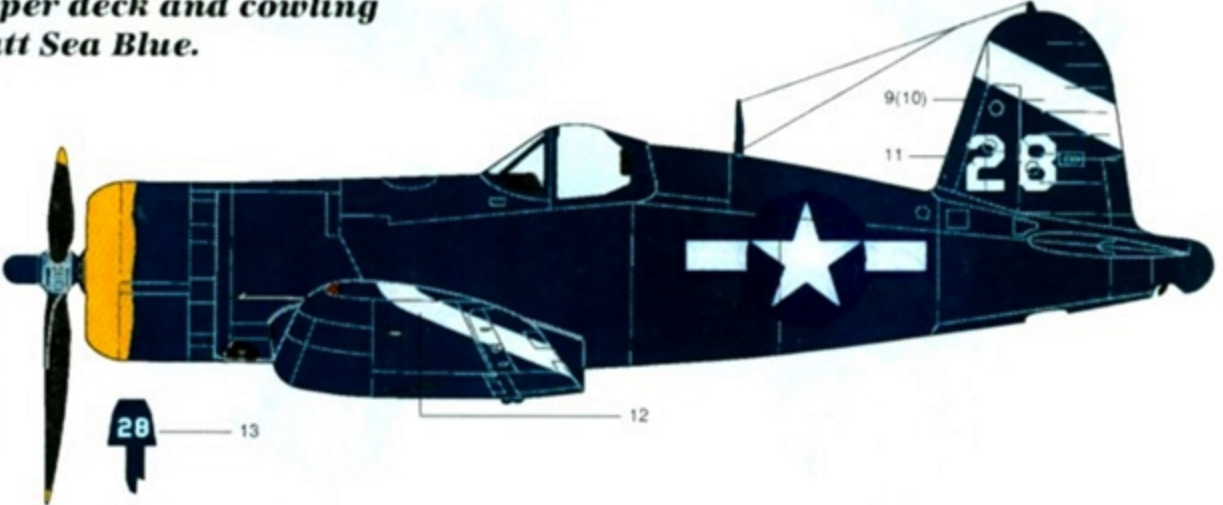
Another Tokyo "first strike" veteran, this F4U-1D of VMF-112 [USS Bennington (CV-20), Feb. 1945.] wore overall Glossy Sea Blue, black propellers with yellow tips and white individual aircraft number on each gear door. Yellow prop Hub. Flown by Major Herman Hanson.



At times, F4U's in Gloss Sea Blue scheme had the front upper deck and cowling sprayed in Matt Sea Blue.

F4U-1D, USS Hancock (CV-19), March 1945. Overall Glossy Sea Blue, crudely painted yellow nose and black propellers with yellow tips. Note position of individual aircraft number on each gear door.
