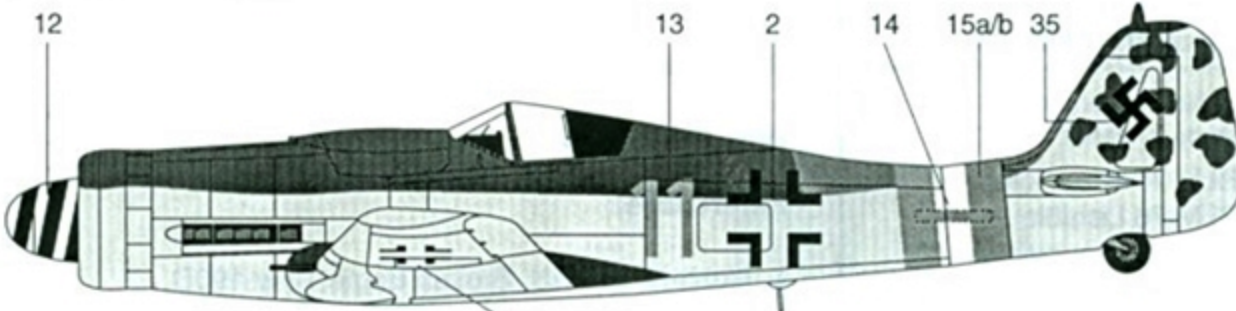

Standard scheme of  
RLM 82 Dunkelgrün and  
RLM 75 Grauviolet over  
RLM 76 Lichtblau —  
with heavy RLM 82 tail  
mottling and no fuselage  
mottling. Black spinner  
with short spiral.

Platte. Center bomb rack  
for SC250 Bomb. Focke-  
Wulf Fw-190D-9 of JG2,  
Spring, 1945. RLM 82  
Dunkelgrün fuselage and  
RLM 82 with RLM 75  
Grauviolet upper wings.  
RLM 76 Lichtblau beneath,  
heavy RLM 82 tail mottling  
and no fuselage mottling.  
Black spinner.

1945. Non-standard  
camouflage scheme of  
RLM 74 Graugrün and  
RLM 75 Grauviolet over  
RLM 76 Lichtblau —  
with RLM 82 Dunkelgrün  
and RLM 75 Grauviolet  
tail mottling. Home  
defense bands  
oversprayed in RLM 75.

Abandoned at  
Rommelshausen-  
Stockheim, Spring, 1945.  
RLM 82 Dunkelgrün and  
RLM 75 Grauviolet over  
RLM 76 Lichtblau — with  
RLM 82 mottling on the  
fin and rudder. Black  
spinner with white spiral..

Fw-190D-9 of II.JG301,  
Straubing, Bavaria,  
Spring, 1945. RLM 82  
Dunkelgrün and RLM 75  
Grauviolet over RLM 76  
Lichtblau — with no  
fuselage or fin-and-  
rudder mottling. Black  
spinner with white spiral.
