

Factory camouflage pattern for Bf-109E



Bf-109E-3 "Yellow 10" flown by Oblt. Heinz Bretnütz, Staffelkapitän 6./JG53, Mannheim-Sandhofen airbase, winter 1939/1940. The paint scheme consisted of RLM 70 (or 71) & 02 on the upper surfaces with perhaps another color RLM 62. RLM 65 on the lower surfaces. The spinner was RLM 70 with the foward edge painted RLM 04 Yellow.

BI-109E-1 flown by Oblt. Wilfried Balfanz, Stab

IJJG 53, Kirchberg im Hunsrück airfield, autumn 1939. References show the upper surface


camouflage to be an unusual combination of RLM

70/02/62 with the more common RLM 65 used on

the lower surfaces. It is quite possible that this is

incorrect and the patch of 'RLM 62' on the rear

fuselage was actually a fresher patch of RLM 02.

A/C #2

Bf-109F-2, W.Nr. 6674, flown be Hptm. Heinz Bretnütz, Gruppenkommandeur II./JG 53, St. Omer-Arques airbase, France, May 1941. The aircraft is equipped with a ZFR-4 telescopic sight in addition to the standard Revi sight. References report an unusual color combination of RLM 71& 02 for the upper surfaces and RLM 76 on the lower surfaces. The cowl, spinner and rudder were RLM 04, with the spinner and front part of the couling having an overspray of RLM 70. While no reference depicted the starboard rudder, it is assumed that the kill marks were repeated on that side.

A/C #4

Bf-109E-3 flown by Oblt. Wilfried Pufahl, Stab II./JG53, western Reich, May 1940. This aircraft was painted in the standard RLM 71/02 upper surface colors with RLM 65 lower surface colors. The forward cowl is RLM 02 with light patches of RLM 71 which gradually increase in intensity as

A/C #5

Bf-109F-2, Stab IIJJG 53, St. Omer-Arques airbase, Spring 1940. The upper surfaces were painted RLM 74/75 and the lower surfaces were RLM 76. The cowl, spinner and rudder were painted RLM 04, with the spinner and cowl having an overspray of RLM 71.
