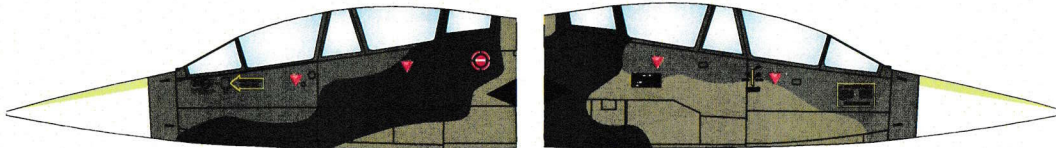
Example 1 - Factory applied symbols
(typical for early Starfighters of European air forces)



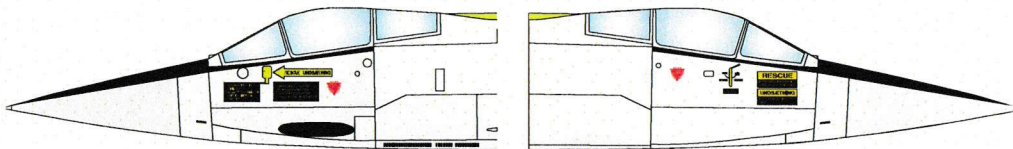
Example 2 - F-104G of German Air Force in Norm 62 camouflage



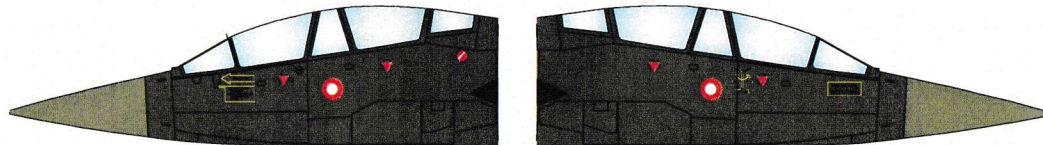

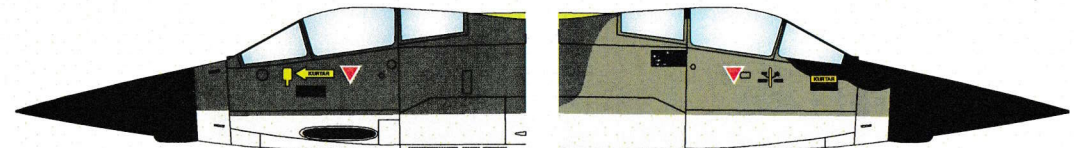
