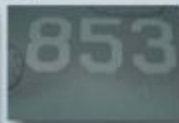

F-16C/D Peace Puma Program

On February 1, 2006, the Chilean Air Force received the first two of ten F-16C/D's as part of the Peace Puma program.

Over the next ten months, the Chilean Air Force received another eight aircraft. The total contract value of this purchase is \$347 million.

Included in the purchase are AIM-9, AIM-120 and JDAM munitions.

This aircraft purchase is significant in that it ends the 20-year ban on sales of high-tech weaponry to Latin America.

The purchase of these aircraft were facilitated by booming sales of copper in this Latin American country.

Chilean law stipulates that 10% of all copper sales go to funding the Chilean military forces.

These aircraft will replace current Mirage aircraft and will be based at the port city of Iquique.
