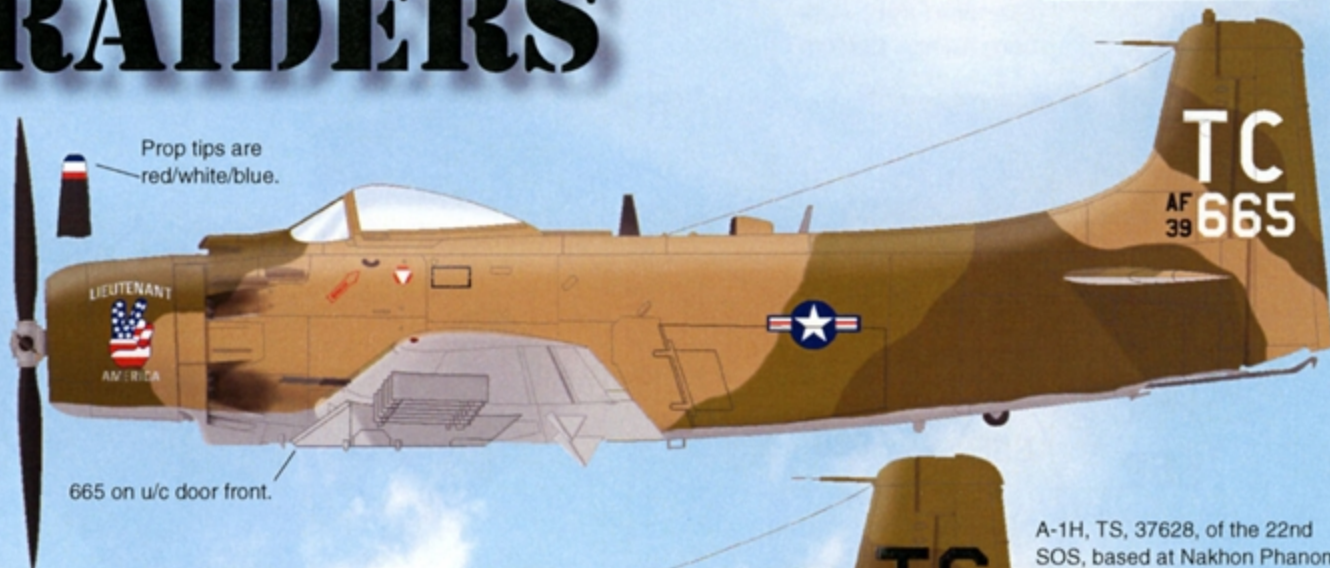
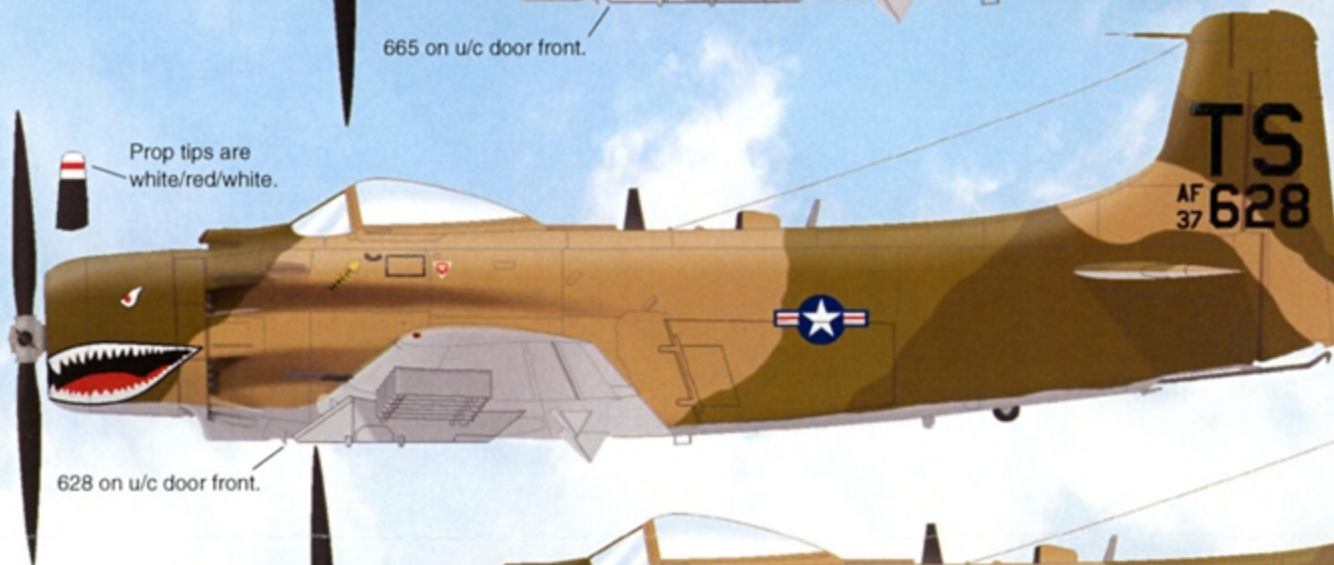

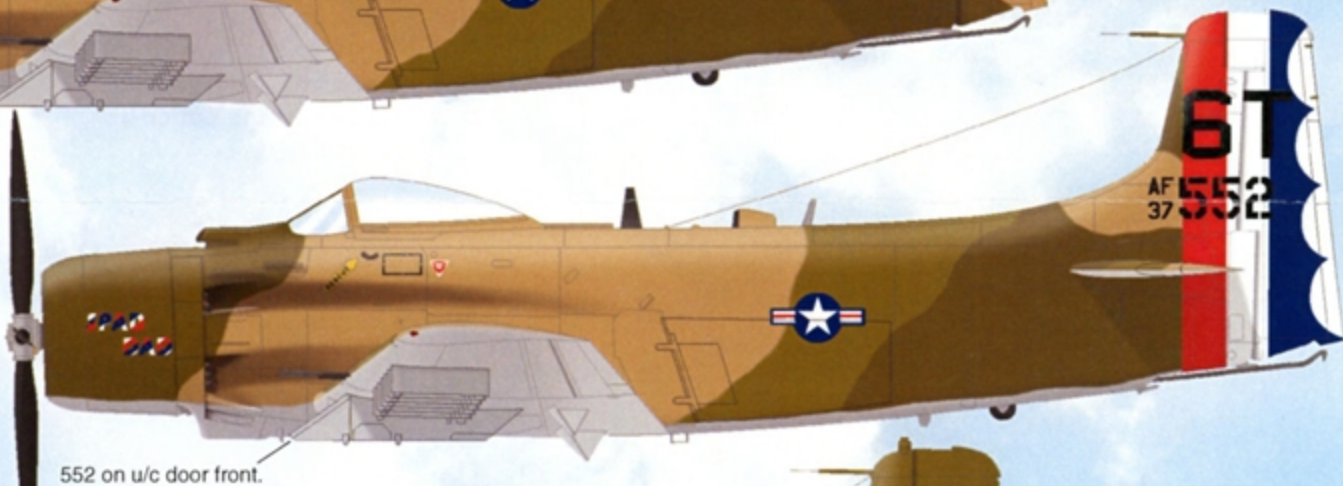

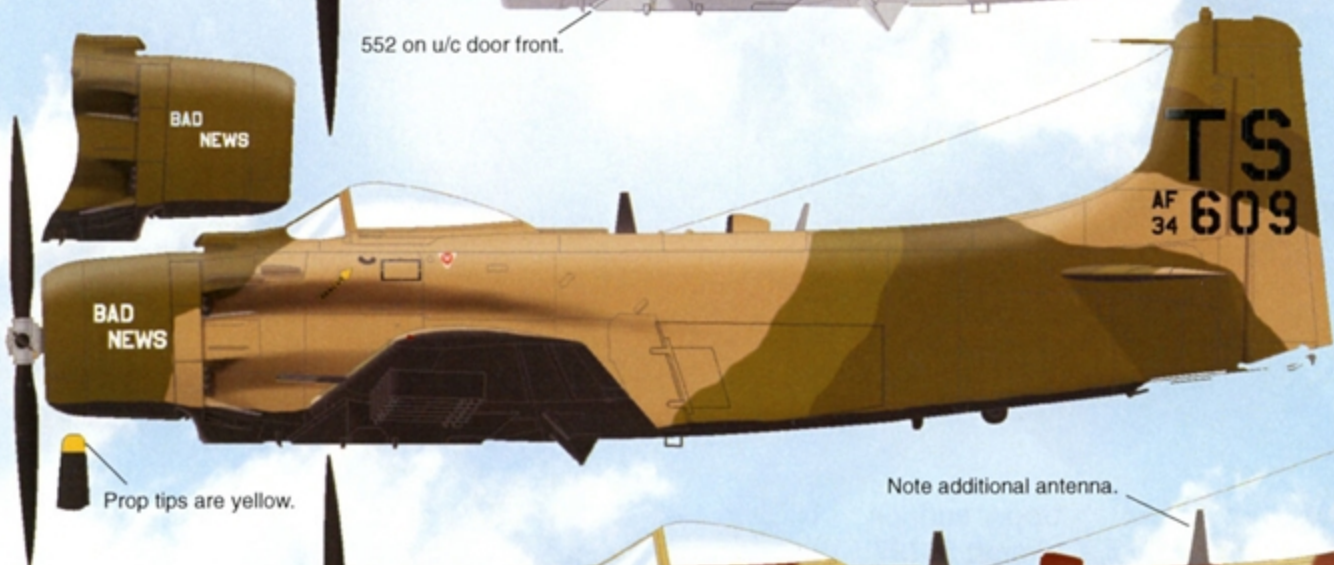

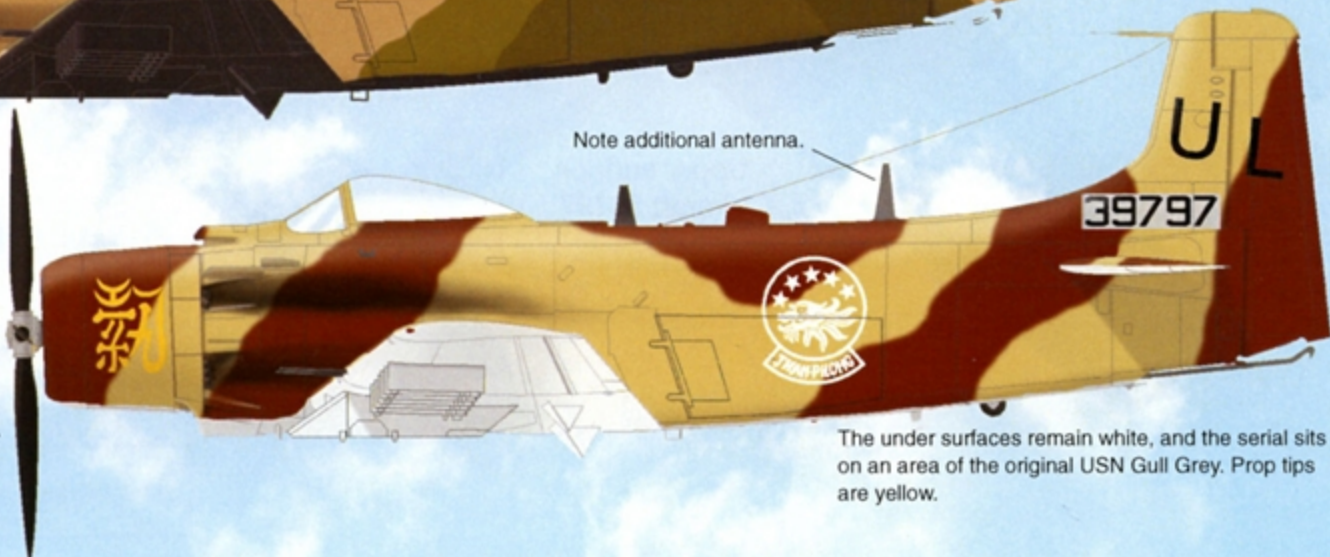

A-1H, 37552, of the 22nd SOS, Nakhon Phanom, Thailand. Aircraft is in standard finish as above, but with black under surfaces. Prop tips are yellow.



A-1H, 39797, of the 83rd Special Operations Group, VNAF, Ton Son Nhut air base, 1966. This former USN aircraft has a camouflage consisting of a light tan (approx FS33711) and a dark reddish brown (approx FS.30111). Prop tips are yellow.



The under surfaces remain white, and the serial sits on an area of the original USN Gull Grey. Prop tips are yellow.
